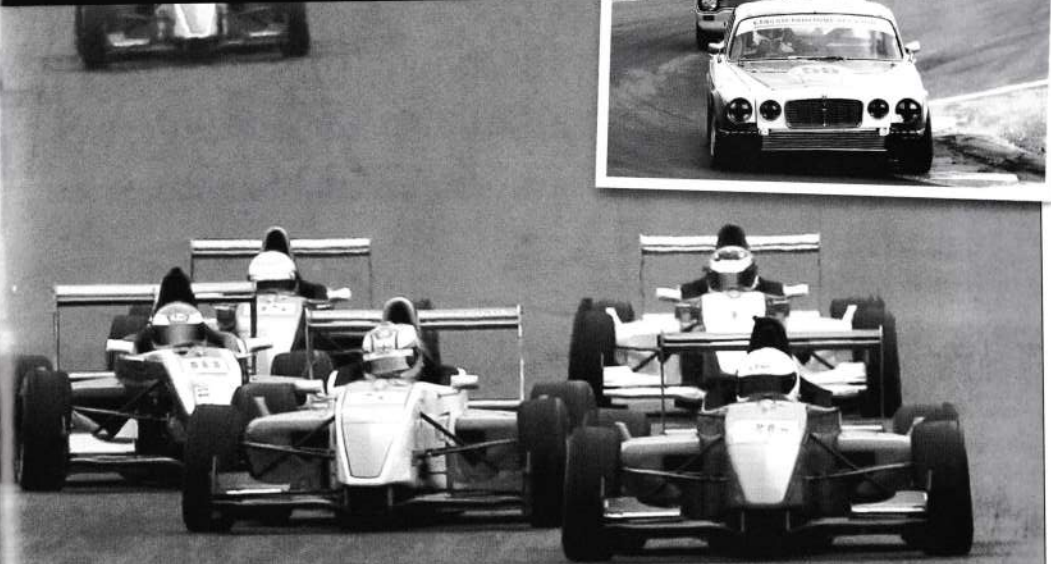
# PACKED!

**T**op of the bill are rounds three and four of the Protyre Formula Renault BARC Championship for the rapid 2-litre Renault-powered single-seater racing cars. While the main Formula Renault UK Championship is a permanent support race to the British Touring Car Championship, the BARC series offers young drivers the chance to race these very quick slicks and wings cars at a lesser level of expenditure. That makes the BARC series a great place to learn about Formula Renault before moving up to the UK Championship. This weekend's races mark the second event of the six-weekend, 12-race season, which culminates with a guest slot on the final BTCC event of the season at Silverstone in October. The season started at Donington Park over Easter and, after this weekend, also takes in double-headers at Oulton Park, Croft and Thruxton. From the season opener at Donington Park it was James Thorp who emerged with a handy points' lead after finishing a close second to Josh Webster in the first race and then went one better to score his

first win in the later race. With Webster failing to finish the second race, former Palmer Audi racer Kieran Vernon took second place with the consistent Steve Durrant and Archie Hamilton well in contention.

After five wins from five races, Garrie Whittaker is riding high in the Kumho BMW Championship and the Nottingham racer comes to Brands aiming to make it a magnificent seven to further strengthen his grip on the overall title race. But Whittaker's early season dominance does not mean that this is a walk over, for Ian Crisp, Colin Wells and David Kempton are all serious rivals. Meanwhile, in the classes for less powerful cars, Paul Bellamy is matching Whittaker win for win so far to lay firm foundations for his own overall title bid.

Sunday will be very busy for Whittaker and his BMW M3 for, as well as the pair of BMW races, he will also have a qualifying session and race for the Sub Zero/Wolf Classic Thunder



With a crowded 18-race programme on the Indy circuit here at Brands Hatch, this weekend's British Automobile Racing Club National Championship race meeting promises plenty of exciting racing for a fine array of categories.

Championship and by the end of the day Whittaker will have completed over 75 laps of the Indy circuit. At the head of the Classic Thunder points after three races is Neil Philpotts in his Mitsubishi Starion.

Lots more racing saloon car action comes across the complete range of categories from the Classic Touring Car Racing Club. Double-headers are for the SVG Motorsport Pre '93 Touring Car Championship and the Thermex Classic Saloons/Historic Touring Car Championship. Brothers Andy and Allan Davies have set the early season pace in the Pre '93 ranks with their BMW M3s, while Roger Stanford's Lotus Cortina is the benchmark in the races for the pre '66 machinery. Single races for the Pro-Driver Blue Oval Saloon Series, the Autoglym Post Historic Touring Car Championship and the Hammerite Racing Classic Group 1 Touring Car Championship complete the CTCRC element of the weekend.

Six of the weekend's races are for cars from

the McMillan Motorsport Caterham Graduate Championship, with three double-headers for this fabulously popular championship. After earlier double-headers at Silverstone and Snetterton, the current men to beat are John Parker (Classic class), Ian Anderson (Sigma class), Reece Somerfield (Super class) and Myles Packman (Mega class).
