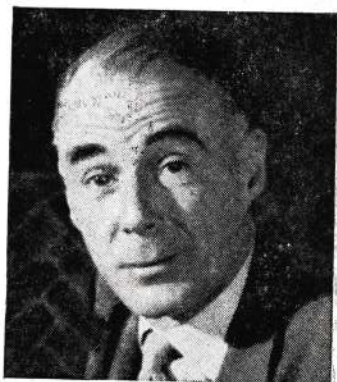

# MoS<sub>2</sub> AND ALL THAT

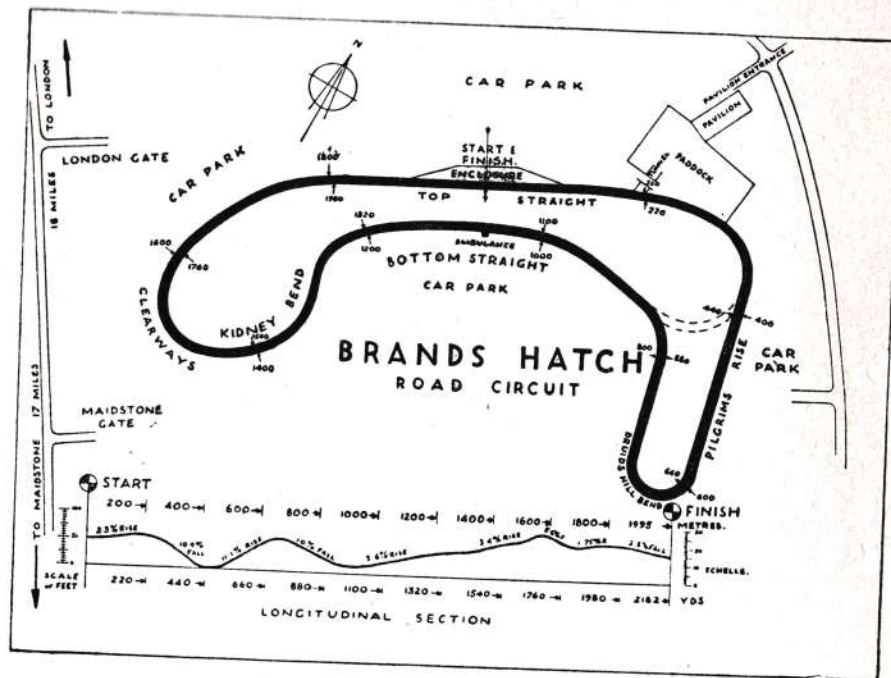
