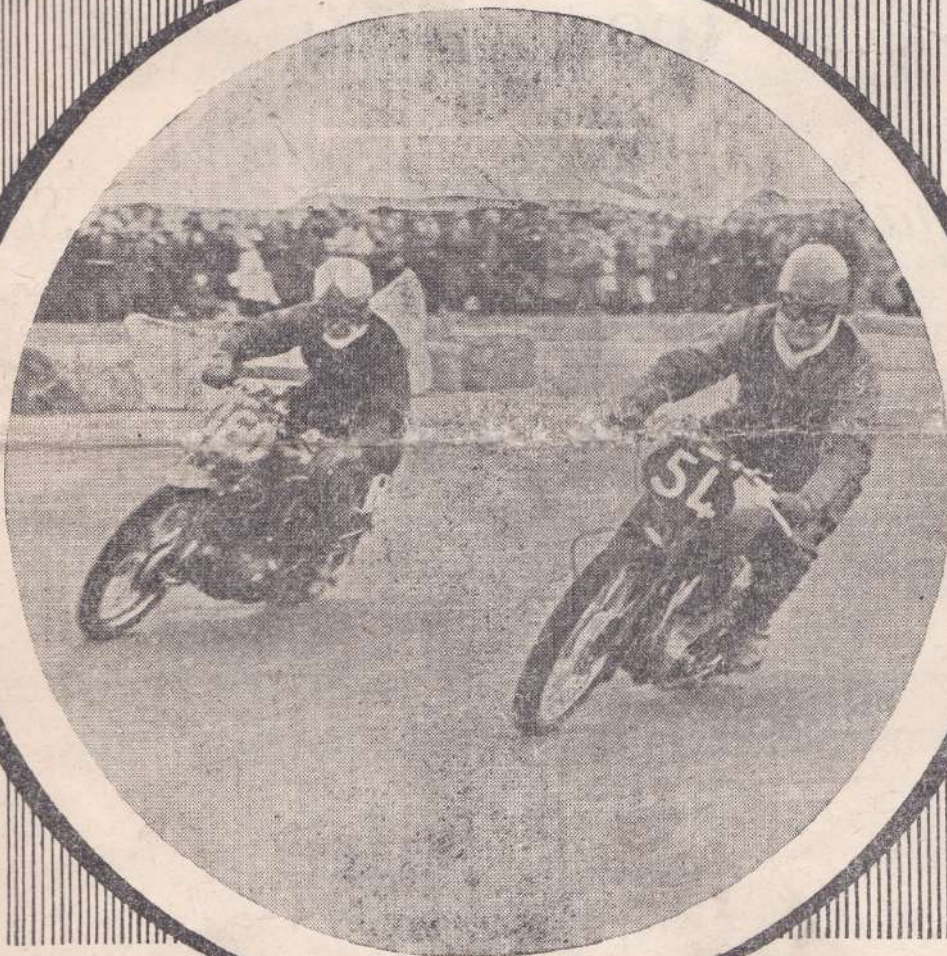

STARTING: On the recommendation of the A.C.U., starts from the Grid will be 30ft. nearer the Paddock. In all races starts will be by push start from the Grid.


