(Suzuki), Trevor Mellor James (Norton), Nation Brian (Suzuki), Whitham Morrison (Honda), Ian Simpson (Suzuki) and "Capt" Mark Phillips (Yamaha) amongst others, have brought along an assortment of different engine capacity machines, and although the run is only billed as a demo, don't be too surprised if speeds are more akin to racing.

Classic Stars

TWO of motorcycle racing's greatest legends, John Surtees and Derek Minter, return to Brands Hatch on July 15/16 when they star in the Classic Motor Cycle Superprix.

The event is a must for all Classic bike enthusiasts and initial plans for the two-day meeting include a 20-race per day format and two very special high-speed demonstration events. The latter have been organised by John Surtees and his friends who will ride multi-cylinder four-stroke racers from the Classic

period, including MV Agustas, Gileras, Hondas and Benellis.

Ex- World Champion Surtees, Hugh Anderson and Phil Read will lead the demonstration while Derek Minter, one of the world's most famous road racers of the 1960s will ride an ex-Ray Petty Norton.

Taking part alongside will be the popular Roger Marshall, Donnie McCleod, Stuart Graham and many more wellknown faces from the world of motor cycle racing.

Hook, Line and Sinker

TWENTY-seven year old Mark Whiting will be looking to repeat his opening round success today when he lines up on his Yamaha 350 in the Duckhams Champion of Brands Class B solo events.

The young Ashford lorry driver took four wins out of a possible five to extend an early lead in the points championship, and after an impressive string of results in 1988, is already displaying all the hallmarks of a future champion.

lected the Dave Potter trophy awarded to the best rider and took the runner's-up spot in the 1988 National Championship behind Glen Williams.

Last season saw Whiting at the centre of many a close contest with eventual Champion of Brands winner, Tim Bourne and Jon Higgens, and Mark is now looking forward to fresh challenges. His achievements last season are perhaps all the more remarkable when you take into

Mark began racing in 1980 when he competed in local grass-track events but quickly moved into road racing which was more to his liking on a Clubmans 250TZD. His career continued to flourish and following some much sponsorship appreciated from Dodds Removals of Ashford, George Dodds, and the South East Oil Company, Mark began to hit form. In 1987 and 1988 he rode his 350TZ Yamaha into second place in the local championships and clinched the 1988 350 KRC title. He also colaccount the fact that although his Yamaha is only two years old, development work on the bike was halted in 1980. "Incredibly it still gives the 250 a good run for its money," Mark says.

Next year Whiting is hoping his sponsors will provide him with enough funds to but a brand new 250 with which to tackle the national series. In the meantime however, Mark will be out to stake his claim on this year's Duckhams Champion of Brands title.

Diary dates

FORTHCOMING Brands Hatch motorcycle attractions include bumper action for all classes at the Championship Race meeting on April 22, while on May 1 the Solo and Sidecar riders prepare to do battle in the MCN British Championships. Later the same month, the bikes play a major part in the annual Bank Holiday Race Camp

spectacular. Backed by Duckhams Oils, this unique two-day meeting caters for all the family and combines the thrill of car and bike racing with an opportunity to camp in the parkland estate of the famous Kent race track. The motorcycle action takes place on May 28, but why not make it a complete Brands Hatch Whitsun weekend?

Sponsors aplenty

A HOST of new sponsors have added their names to this year's BMCRC championships, most notably SEB Plumbing and Heating Supplies who are sponsoring the 347-1300cc Sidecar Championship series. This is SEB's first venture into the motorcycle racing arena but thanks to the efforts of former sidecar racer, Steve Collett and SEB's Eddie Bell who are sharing

the costs of the company, the Grays-based outfit is set to enjoy a new and we hope, successful association with the sport.

Other sponsors include Mobike of Bromley who back the heavy metal solo Open and Production classes, while local West Kingsdown motorcycle tuning specialists, Stan Stephens, put up the trophies in the 250cc Production series. Another new sponsor to the sport is Lionel Blanks of Brennal Glass who has kindly offered to support the 250cc Production series in recogniton of son Paul's efforts during 1988. Paul tragically died as a result of an accident at Brands Hatch last October but his family has decided to continue its involvement with motorcycle racing through sponsorship.

On three wheels

1988 Champion of Brands sidecar champions, Alan and Mark Richardson are back for another crack at the Kentish title before launching an assault on the national competition in 1990.

The racing brothers from Hailsham, Sussex, struck up

riding at Lydden," continued Alan, "and we decided to try it out at Brands Hatch during the latter part of the 1987 where we got it going a lot better."

The Richardsons finally conquered the Brands Hatch circuit last year when they

frustrated by the lack of publicity their achievements obtained. It appears that some sections of the press accused the pair of turning it into a boring championship but Alan defends their success. "We simply went out and finished every race bar

their partnership after 35year old Alan suffered a big accident at Brands Hatch in summer '85. "My passenger chickened out after that and I roped Mark in," explained Alan.

The younger of the two, Mark had no previous racing knowledge and the pair initially played around with a Suzuki water-cooled 750 2stroke at Brands and Lydden Hill. The chalked up their first major achievement when they finished fourth in the 1986 Lydden Championship but were not quite so fortunate at Brands Hatch. "For a while I couldn't stand the sight of Brands Hatch," Alan remembers, "it was a nightmare of a place for me."

A brief foray with Yamaha proved disastrous and so the brothers opted for the current four-stroke Suzuki. "But the bike wasn't suitable for

conclusively wrapped up the Duckhams Champion of Brands title, building up on a 30 point lead by mid-season, clinching the title three

meetings before the end of the year.

Alan and Mark, who both work as fencing contractors during the week, took the title with a bigger winning

margin than any other rider in any other category of motorcycle racing but are still the two in which we crashed. We didn't go and win every race but just took advantage of the way the system oper-

"What errs me more than anything else though is the lack of coverage given to sidecars in general. They're a decent bunch of lads.

"We all park up together in the pits and if there is ever a problem, everyone will rally round and help out ... even whey you know full well that the guy you've just helped is likely to go out and beat you in the race! For some reason though, we never get the publicity we deserve. It doesn't really bother me about seeing my name in the papers but some recognition for the sidecars won't go amiss."

Championship trial starts here

TODAY'S racing gives a chance for fans to see a number of top Bemsee riders involved in the Champion of Brands series, which is sponsored by the Duckhams Oil Company. Rod Hysom surveys the field

The Championship is run over 17 rounds spread over the whole season and is always a close fought affair creating much interest and excitement. Our races for today have an added bonus because the winners will receive a coveted Motor Cycle News Trophy. There are three groups of trophy races: Race eight is for sidecars up to 1300cc, Race nine is for Class A solos up to 600cc and Race 10 Class B solos up to 1300cc (this class has two qualifying heats early in the day.)

The main attraction of the day will be the class B solos and many of the fancied runners in this year's championship will be on view today. Last year's winner of the Duckhams title was the popular Tim Bourne from Ashford in Kent. The 27year-old map salesman took the title after a close battle with another Ashford resident, Mark Whiting. Mark is out in today's battle on his 350 Yamaha, but will find some extremely stiff opposition lined up on the grid.

Jon Higgens on the Brands Hatchentered 1100 Suzuki should be well in contention. Jon had a very successful year in 1988 and is keen to put the Brands bike first past the chequered flag. All rounder Richard Defago is back on the road racing scene after a winter of successful trials riding in the South Eastern Centre. It is always nice to admire someone who can combine the skills necessary to master both forms of bike riding.

Micky Davidson from Kingston is a consistent front runner at Bemsee meetings and is looking for a Class B win this season. Other favourites who could well take leader board positions are Paul Willis (750 Suzuki), Graham Burgess (1100 Suzuki) and Dom Connor (750 Yamaha). The Mobike entry of an 1100 Suzuki ridden by circuit specialist Dave Burford must surely be a contender. Derek Lee (750 Suzuki) from Park Royal will be out of show his paces and printer Jim Perry from Climping starts his campaign for the season aboard his 1100 Suzuki. Altogether the Class B race promises to be fast and furious over the 12 laps. It is a brave person who would predict which of the fine and talented riders will be first past the chequered

The Class A Trophy promises to be an even more open event with a host of riders who could possibly take the win. Nigel Froud (yet another Ashfordian) aboard a 250 Yamaha must start as one of the favourites for a trophy win. Last year after only two seasons in road racing, Nigel took fourth place in the Class A series. David Wilson (247 Brooklyn Extactweld) will be out to make his mark on the race and after such a successful year in 1988 we can expect to

see him head the series when he gets into its stride. Adam Fletcher on a 250 Suzuki makes the long journey down from Whittlesey in Cambridgeshire to continue his early season promise.

A good front row grid position will make Paul Streets (249 Yamaha) difficult to beat. Other front runners should include Mark Curtis (250 Suzuki), Dom Connor (600 Yamaha), Gerald Wicks (250 Simmons Yamaha) and Gavin Wolfe on a 600 Yamaha. This class can give extremely close racing and a "blanket" finish involving up to half a

The sidecar Duckhams Champion of Brands combined with Motor Cycle News Trophy is set to be an exciting event. There are somewhere around 18 crews all out to contest this prestigious race. Alan and Mark Richardson on the 1050 Suzuki will be out to repeat last year's success in the series. Finlay Morton and Stuart Smith are also likely to be strong contenders for a top placing. Also in with a chance of good points will be Jonathan Hall and Richard Burford (1000 Kawasaki). Stephen Humphrey and Paul Walker (750 Yamaha) and Andrew Dingsdale and Kevin Jarman (1175 Suzuki).

In the smaller category we can expect Geoffrey Moeser and Stephen Bennett (350 Yamaha) Gary Golder and Karl Firman (347 Simmyam) and Glenn Walsh Berry (350 Windle Clifford Yamaha) all to be setting the pace in this hotly contested and popular class.

Altogether these three 12 lap races will provide a magnificent highlight to our day's racing. It is to be hoped that once you have seen this excitement of a day's Bemsee meeting, you will return for many more during the season long campaign of some of the top club riders in the country.





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
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The supporters club

The programme kicks off with the Stan Stephens- sponsored 250 Production race. The championships at present led by East Anglians Mev Potts and Adam Fletcher, both out today to try and extend their lead. Second race out will interest the big bike enthusiasts for the Mobike 750 and 1300 open event. Paul Clarke (750 Honda) leads the 750 with Dave Goodley and Micky Davidson (750 Suzuki) out front in the 1300 title race. This race combines good racing with the spectacular noise of the fourstroke machinery. Paul Blanks is sponsor of the 350 and 500 Production bikes. Mick Fincham and Mick Archer top the 350 listing, while Jason Emmett and Mark Ebbage are the ones to look for in the 500 event. This race promises much in the excitement stakes with a great deal of fairing bashing.

Pure racing bike fans will be keen to see the 125 and 250 open class. The former group is lead by Graham Harknett and Martin Cox. The latter group is led by Nigel Froud, but with John Laker not contesting the challenge should come from Paul Streets. Mobike of Bromley again promote the 750 and 1300 Production Class. Paul Clark and Clive Cotton are ahead in the 750 race with Dave Goodley (not contesting) and Chris Perrin at the top of the 1300s. L.C. Yamaha always provide excellent racing and today's line up is well worth a watch. The 250 class is headed by Stewart Bayley and Sean McGee. The 350 class has Paul Sheridan and Mark Proctor out in front.

Brands Hatch Leisure is supporting Race 11 which is for single 2 and 4strokes, 125, 250 and 600. Nigel Collier is in the lead in this series.


With all your favourite riders getting at least one other outing, the afternoon will conclude with the SEB Supplies Chris Perrin heads today's 1300 Production Class challenge.

Yellow (waved): Great danger in section of texts phead slow decumpance.

Yellow (motionless): Danger in section of track ahead: take care, no overtakor track ahead: take care, no overtak-ing, maintain positions until clear of section displaying yellow flag. Green: Course clear. Used on marshals' posts to indicate their position to riders

on first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been shown to indicate circuit now clear ahead.

Black: Accompanied by riders number on separate board. That rider to stop in pits next time round. Always shown at start/finish line on special instructions from Clerk of the course.

Yellow with red stripes: Oil flag. Dis-played when oil has been dropped on the circuit in that section, displayed until the hazard has been dealt with. also denotes slippery surface ahead.

White: Ambulance or course car on circuit.

Yellow with black cross: Denotes start Black/white chequered: Denotes finish



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
