Tribute to a Motor Sport Organisational Legend and his dear wife. Founder of SEMSEC and TWMC stalwart.

Doug Jennings – 14th April 1937–29th July 2012

Pauline Jennings – 3rd September 1939–6th September 2012

I first met The Jennings' in the late 60's through TWMC and shortly became aware that Doug always supported by Pauline, who herself was involved administratively at many events, was a major driving force and served TWMC as Competition Secretary, then Chairman. This led to them regularly being the Secretary of the Meetings or Clerk of the Course for Autotests, Production Car Trials, Autocross, the Annual Brands Hatch Sprints, Race Meetings, the original World of Sport Rallycrosses and Stock Car Race Meetings for Spedeworth – at both Brands Hatch and Lydden.

Doug had the ideas for the 'Kent & Sussex Trial' – a multi venue, multi discipline event, the formation of the TW, 70Oaks, Rochester and B19 Motor Clubs into a motorsport consortium for joint promotions. He also persuaded the MD of the Kent & Sussex Courier Group to give the green light for sponsorship of an Autocross Championship – The 'Courier Champagne Trophy Autocross Championship'.

Doug saw an opportunity to provide Trophies for Motor Clubs and the like, set up PMJ Engraving with Pauline, whilst he still worked at the Courier. His active involvement with TWMC and the ASEM was

reduced somewhat when he became more involved with Brands Hatch.

Doug became involved in the formation of SEMSEC, as a joint venture between British Motor Cycle Racing Club, TWMC and BARC SE Centre at Lydden, but SEMSEC's first year was made particularly difficult by a somewhat obstructive influence so the TWMC took over total control and sole responsibility for SEMSEC.

Throughout this time Doug was an RAC then MSA Steward supported in this role by Pauline and daughter Wendy. On their retirement they moved to Henfield but sadly only had a few years to enjoy it, but still found time to help out Brighton and Hove MC as membership secretary.

Both suffering from the big 'C' Pauline's sell by date was shorter than Doug's but in typical Doug fashion he 'blue flagged' Pauline to reach 'the chequered flag' first, to pave the way.

Our sincere condolences go to daughter Wendy, Pauline's sister Beryl and the rest of the family.
