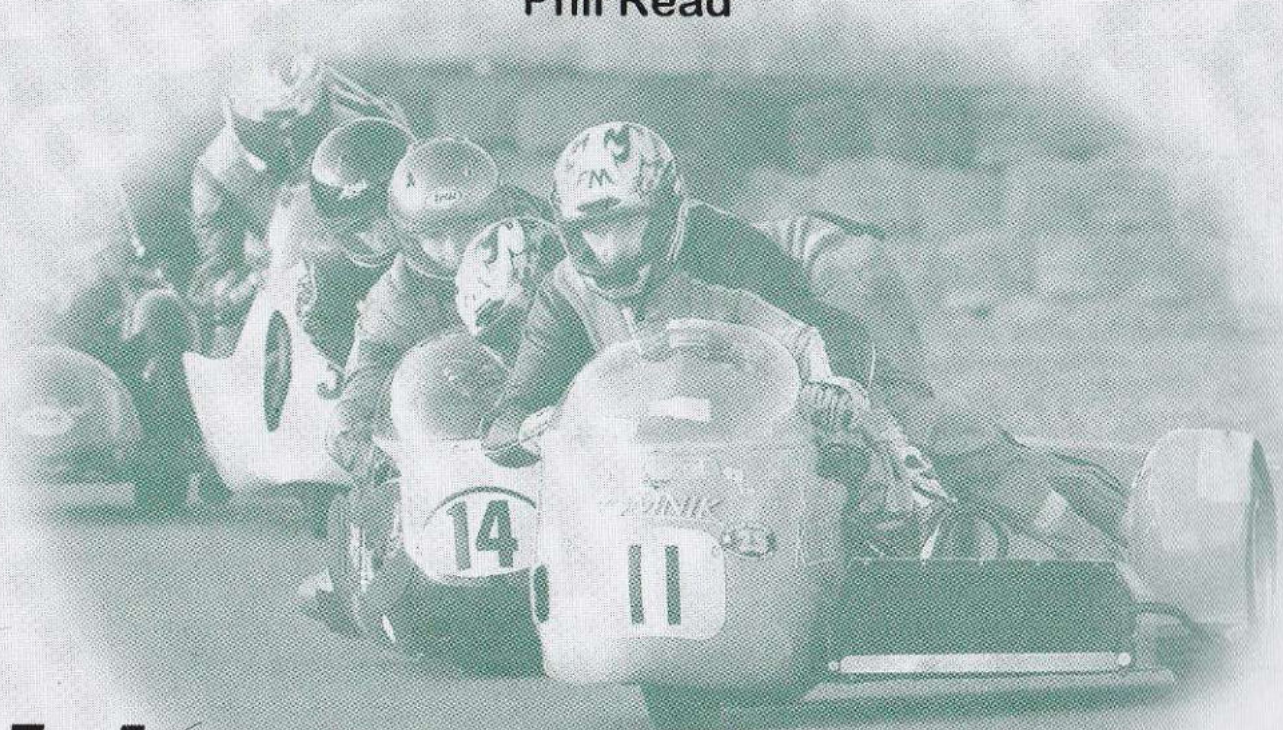

Welcome to Brands Hatch where we have a huge entry of solo and sidecar riders for what will be a terrific celebration of Classic Motorcycle racing. This is the fourth date on the CRMC's 2005 racing calendar and as always our thanks go out to our untiring officials and marshals and of course our loyal sponsors for their continuing support.

During the 50's, 60's and early 70's Brands Hatch was home to all the great riders of the time, including most of the top international stars. This weekend we commemorate that golden era with a revival of the most coveted of all the short circuit trophies – The King of Brands – with the King of them all, Derek Minter, presenting the prize. We also have a round of the popular Lansdowne Cup series devoted to very original specification machines up to 1964 and, in keeping with Brands' international traditions, an International Historic Racing Organisation race.

As if that isn't enough, our Classic Parades include four legends of British road racing, including two former Kings of Brands - Stan Woods on his Suzuki RG500, Ron Chandler on a BSA triple and Tommy Robb and Frank Perris on stunning Phil Morris replicas of 1960's Works 250 Honda and Yamaha. As an added treat, former multiple World Champion Phil Read will be competing on a 500 Goldstar and the exotic Moto Paton 499. Away from the track you will find displays of historic machines by Mike Braid, Chris Wilson and the Norton Owners Club to drool over.

Forget any ideas you may have about Classic Racing being old bikes pottering around – this weekend you will see cut and thrust competition throughout the field in every race and the continuation of some truly intense rivalries. Top among these is that between Lea Gourlay (Summerfield Petty Manx) and Glen English (Molnar/FWD Manx) in the Junior and Senior GP and National races. Since Lydden their party has been gatecrashed by Alan Oversby on his Craven Manx 500 and 350 Honda twin so whatever you do, don't go to the café when these three are on the track together!

In the FRC races you can bet on an intense battle between the TZ Yamahas of Richard Parker, Roy Flower and Mike Russell while in the Ultra Lightweights you can expect to see another close duel between the leading 4-stroke 350cc Goldstars and the nimble 200cc 2-strokes. The classic Senior has seen smooth riding Nigel Palmer win every round but former moto crosser Rob Gregory (Rickman Metisse) has been getting ever closer to the Ducati man and will no doubt be straining every muscle to take that first win.

In the Lightweights it's been close between the Ducatis of Graham Wade and Mike Smith all season and when it comes to the Junior Twins you can expect to see a real ding dong between at least four closely matched riders, including Father and Son-in-Law duo John Davidson and Simon Walsh. Walsh should also be prominent on his Triton in the stunningly quick 1300 series, which again brings Lea Gourlay out to play, this time on his beautifully prepared Lidgate Triumph. This series includes a round of the Classic Racer Syndicate championship. Equally rapid are the Post Classics where some mightily quick big Japanese 4-strokes in the hands of people like Phil Davenport and Team Glam's James Clark will be slugging it out with the shrieking TZ Yamahas of Roy Flower and Rob Hall among others.

We also have a strong sidecar entry where Lynx mounted Richard and Samantha Holmes and Matthew and Emma Kingsmill will be just two of several crews looking to prevent Brian Gray and Alan Bedford (Windle Nourish) from repeating their Snetterton four-timer.

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FLAG SIGNALS

Red: Immediately stop racing.

Yellow (steady): Signal of danger. (Waved) Slow down, driver must be prepared to stop.

OVERTAKING FORBIDDEN ON ANY YELLOW FLAG.

National flag or Green: Start

Black displayed with white number: informs the driver of motorcycle the number of which is shown that he must stop at the pit on the next lap.

Black with Orange circle: Displayed with vehicles number: the rider must leave the track IMMEDIATELY.

Yellow with Red Stripes: Deterioration of adhesion of the track surface

White: Slow moving intervention vehicle on track. The white flag informs drivers they are about to overtake a vehicle which is travelling on the track at much slower speed than competing motorcycles.

Blue: Overtaking signal, informs rider he they are about to be overtaken by a faster motorcycle.

Yellow with black diagonal cross: Start of the last lap.

Black/White Chequered: End of race.

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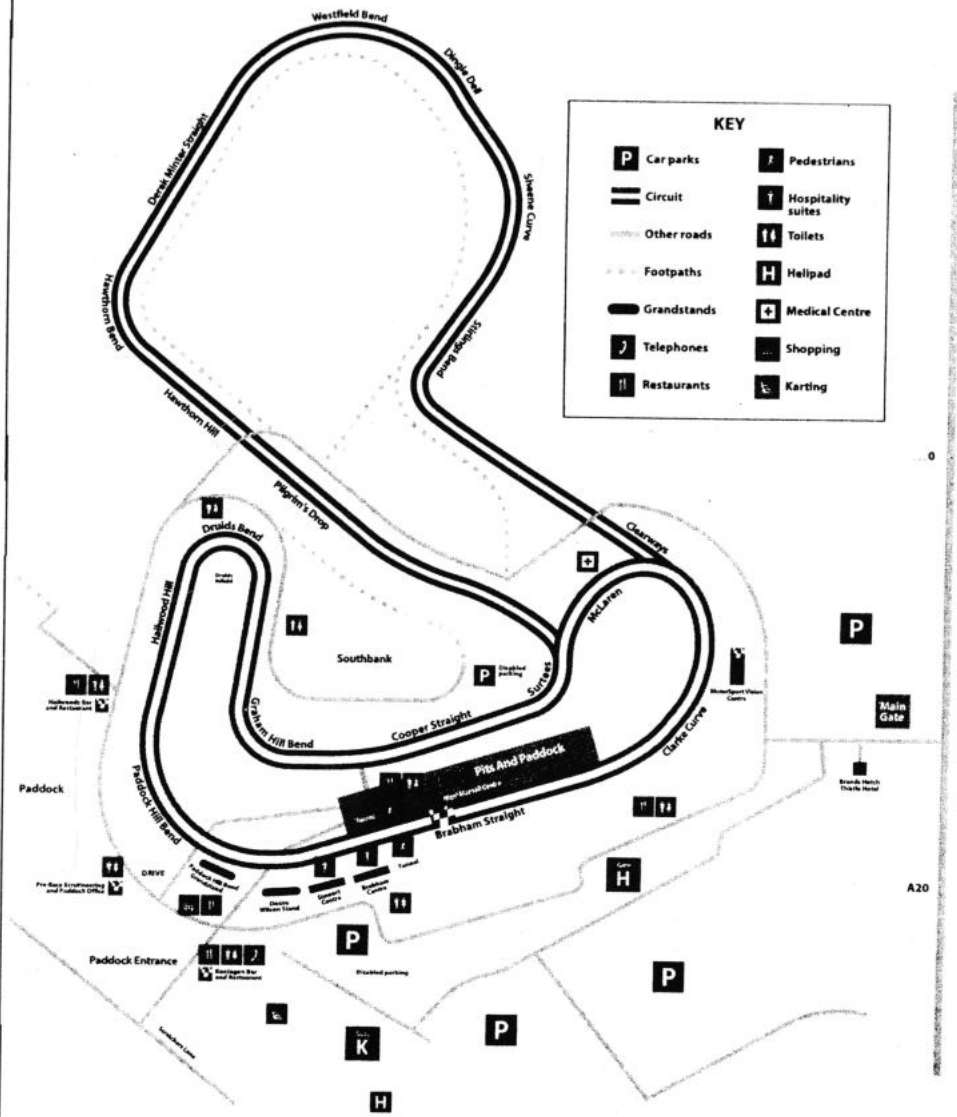

Classic Parade - Stan Woods

Among the collections of gorgeous classic motorcycles here this weekend are five examples from the stable of Mike Braid that represent a wonderful cross section of British racing machinery of the 1960's and 70's. These are a Peter Williams' 1967 500cc pannier tank Arter Matchless, a 1962 Duff Arter Matchless G50, a 1973 Mono JP Norton twin, a 1963 500cc Norton Domiracer and a 1972 Boyer Triumph triple.

As at Snetterton and also our forthcoming Cadwell Park round, we are delighted to welcome to our Classic Parades this weekend four legendary names from British road racing history – Tommy Robb, Frank Perris, Ron Chandler and Stan Woods. We reviewed Frank and Tommy's careers in our Snetterton programme and will be looking back over Ron's achievements at Cadwell, so today we focus on Stan, who will be riding a Suzuki RG500 (XR14) and also the Boyer triple described above.

Stan started club racing in 1963 at the age of 18 on an Excelsior Manxman. After successfully graduating to a 350cc Manx Norton he switched to 2-strokes and became the first rider to lap the TT course on a Yamaha TD1C at over 90mph. After many successful seasons on board the H Dugdale Motors Yamahas he was contracted in 1972 by Crooks Suzuki to ride the 500cc Production Racer and duly secured Crooks' first TT victory. This led Stan to a 5 year relationship with Suzuki GB riding legendary factory machinery like the RG500, RG700A and TR750.

Honda then stepped in and Stan found himself back on 4-strokes, riding the RCB RS1000cc Endurance Racer to three FIM Coupe d'Endurance 2nd places between 1978 and 1980. During this time he also helped with the development of the infamous NR 500 4-stroke GP bike.

At the same time Stan was also one of the country's top privateers, riding production based RG500 and TR750 machines to success in mainland Britain, the IoM and Ireland. He was the first rider to lap the Ulster GP circuit at over 110mph, took the British 750 Championship, rode for the Transatlantic team 1974 and 1976 and twice won the famous King of Brands title that we are celebrating this weekend. In 1978 Stan was drafted into the Texaco Suzuki team to ride the RG700A following the tragic death of Tom Herron at the Ulster GP.

Jim Bromley of Albion Street Motors was another great provider of privateer machinery for Stan such as the ex-works KR250 7-speed (ex Ron Pierce), Yamaha TZ750 (ex Don Vesco), a Steve Baker replica Yamaha OW31 and the Maxton TZ750 on which he achieved 3rd place in the Race of the Year.

Stan retired in 1981 after 18 years of racing bikes from club rider to International star and we warmly welcome him and our other star guest riders to our Classic Parades this weekend.

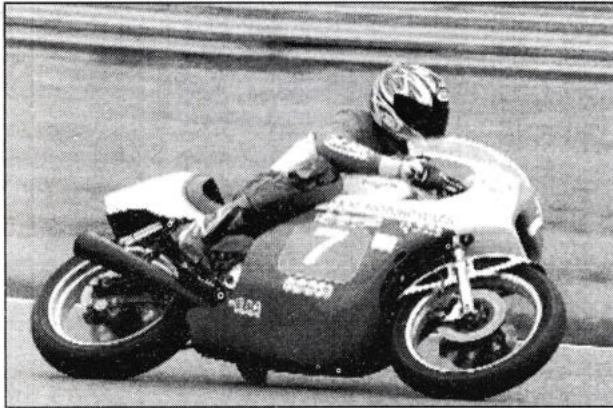

Following the last absolutely two stupendous round at the Malory Post TT meeting, Richard Adams has now moved up to a menacing fourth position and so will be looking to take maximum advantage of Bill's absence as will 'on form' Stacey Kilworth on Brian Penfold's extremely fast Manx. Almost certainly, the top action will be amongst these four but watch out also for Messrs Tonge and Clark who will both be anxious to use Brands as an opportunity to put more clear water between them and the rump of the mid-field.

In the growing 350cc Class, a failed clutch at Mallory on the usually totally reliable Whitehouse Norton has relegated Mike Russell to second place in the championship with Andy Molnar (no introduction needed) now ahead of Mike by just one point. This is going to be very interesting! But the dark horse of the 350's, and proving the worth of the Lansdowne's unique points handicap system, is the 350 KTT Velocette of Graham Rhodes – a wonderful sight – very quick – and certainly puts a few Manx's in their place. The Lansdowne races will be well worth watching for that alone!

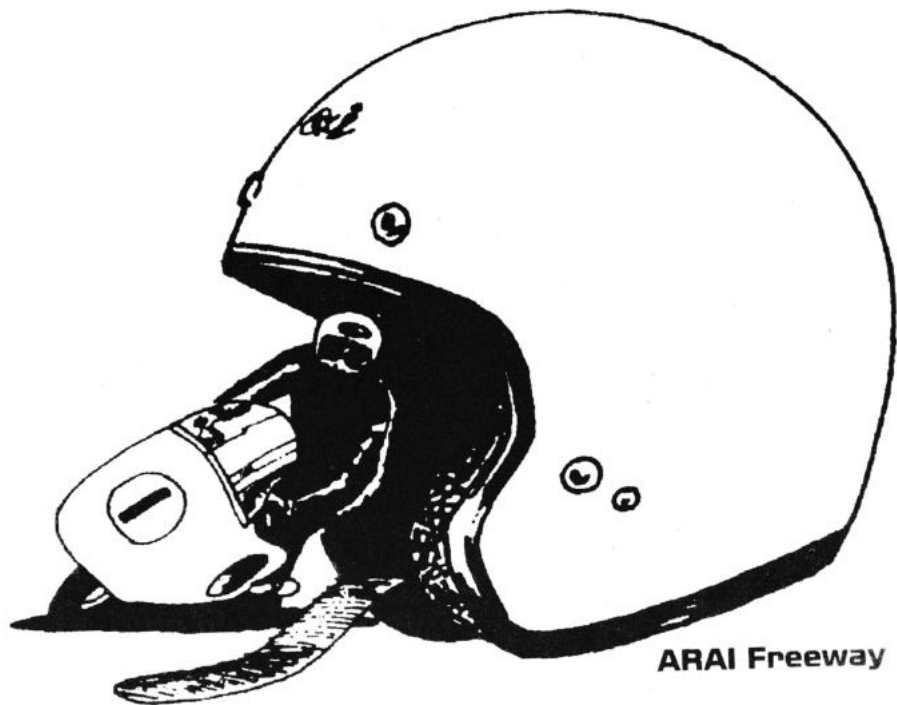

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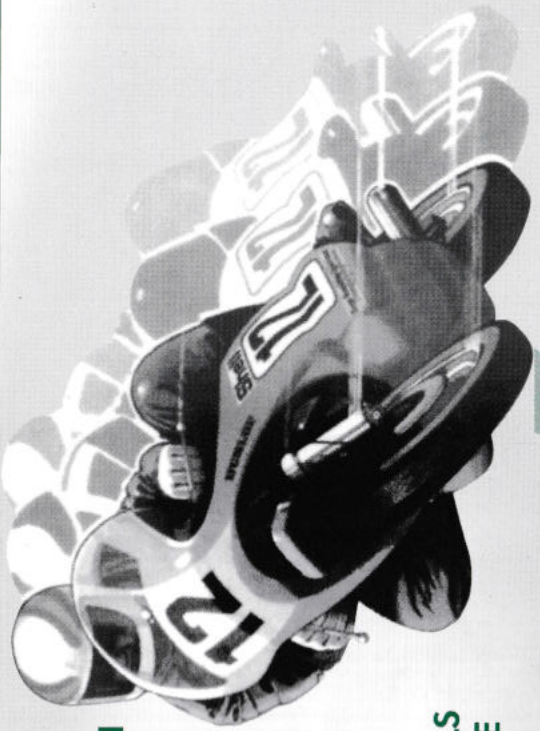
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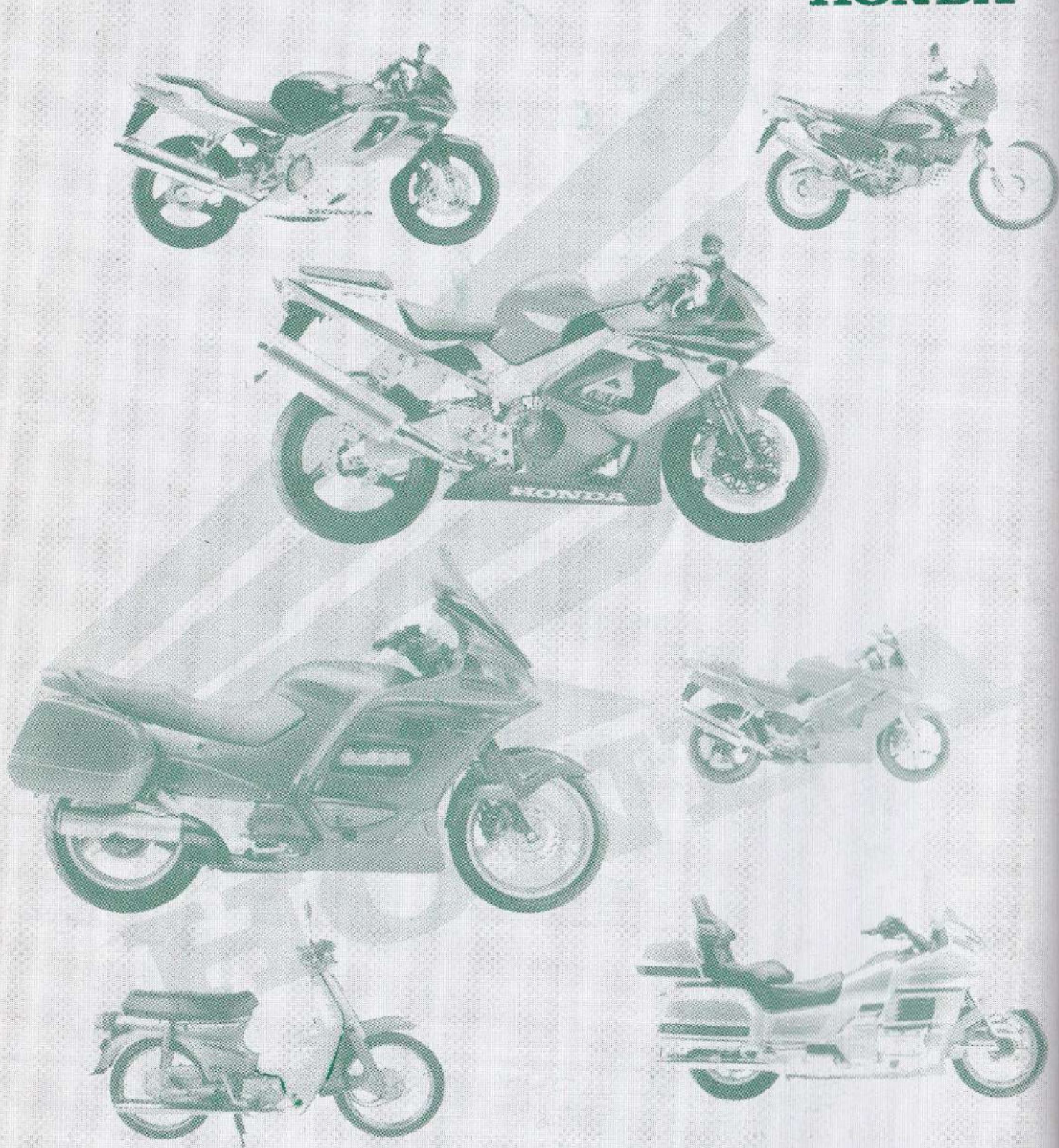


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Classic Parade – Ron Chandler

Among the former Greats riding in our Classic Parades this weekend is one of the most famous 60's and 70's short circuit "scratchers" – Ron Chandler.

Famously known for his occupation as a Thames Lighterman, Ron was born in Bermondsey in 1939 and started racing in 1958 on a Matchless G45. In 1960 this was changed to a G50, resulting in his first win at the now sadly long gone Crystal Palace circuit near to his home in South East London.

Over the next ten years Ron became one of the most successful and best known names in British road racing with appearances in many Nationals, Internationals and Grand Prix. A major part of Ron's success was his partnership between 1967 and 1970 with leading sponsor and tuner Reg Kirby. This culminated in 1967 with Ron winning the British 500cc Championship and that coveted King of Brands title that we are reviving here this weekend.

With the writing on the wall for the 4-strokes Ron switched to a Chris Allen 500 Kawasaki, but in 1972 acquired a Triumph 750 triple that he took to victory at the Rouen International 1 hour race. Ron continued racing on a variety of machinery until 1975, at which time he threw himself into a new career breeding and training working dogs such as Labradors and Springer Spaniels.

Ron would probably have been lost to road racing if he hadn't been persuaded by Peter Lockwood in 1998 to ride in the Dutch Classic Revival meeting. This experience reawakened Ron's interest in road racing and as well as now being a regular on the parading circuit he has managed to reacquire and restore the very same Triumph Triple on which he achieved his Rouen victory.

Ron now lives at Kemsing, just a stones throw from the Brands Hatch circuit that saw some of his greatest racing achievements, and we are delighted to be able to welcome him as our guest this weekend.
