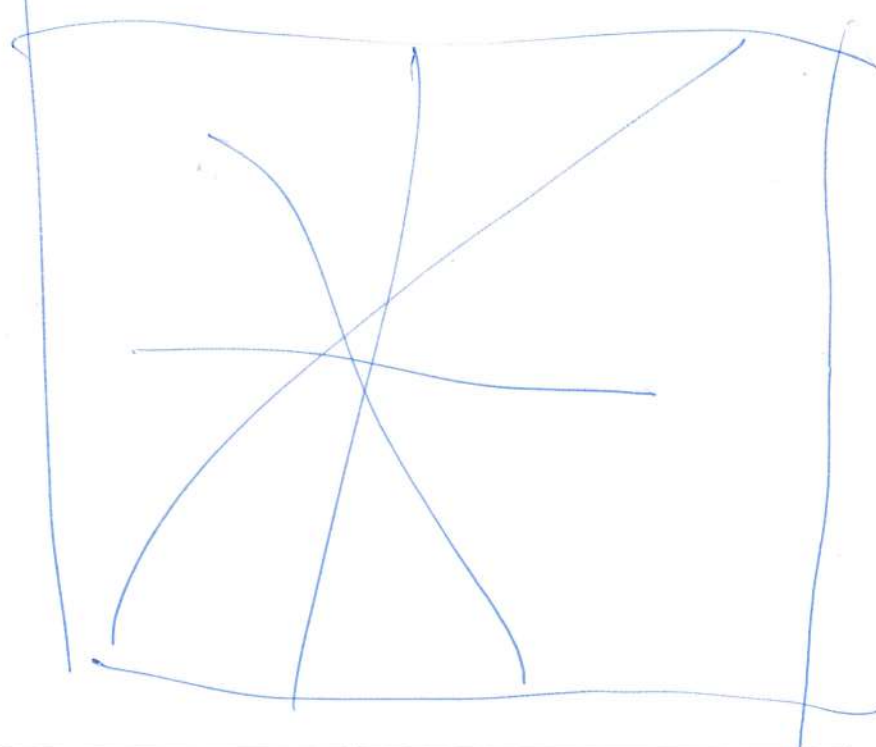

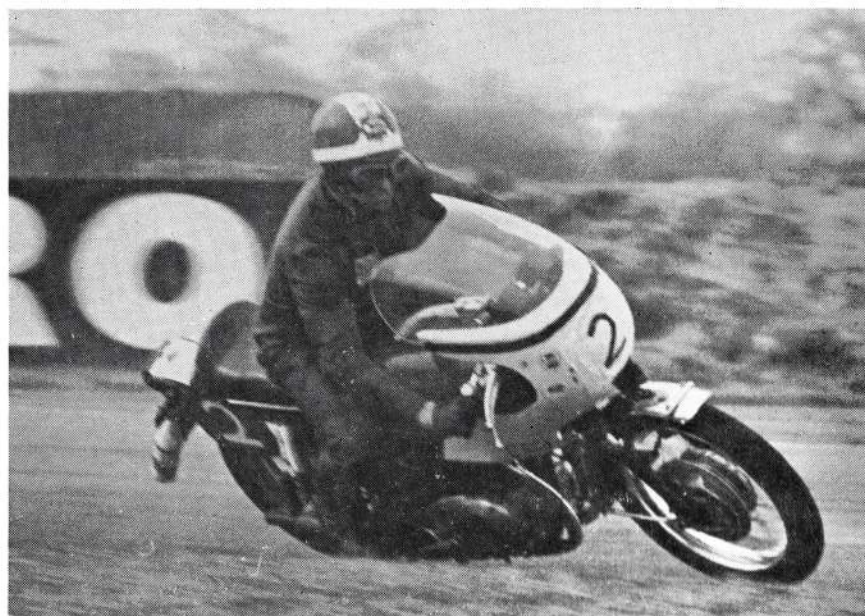

### JOHN HANDS, B.S.A. (No. 2)

Born in January 1941 at Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire, John is a long-serving regular soldier, who has now been in the Army for 13 years. John spent four years as a parachutist and for the last five years has been with the Royal Artillery Motorcycle Display team as their mechanic. Married for two years, he has a three-month-old son. He only started riding motorcycles six years ago, and raced for the first time during the 1970 season, on his "ride to work" BSA Spitfire in the up-to-1000cc Production class.

Extremely determined and courageous, John races under considerable adversity owing to the accidental loss of his left hand. Careful examination of the photo will reveal that both the clutch and the front brake levers are on the same (right) side. In spite of the extra difficulty this must cause, John races very competitively and on even terms in good company, asking no special favours.

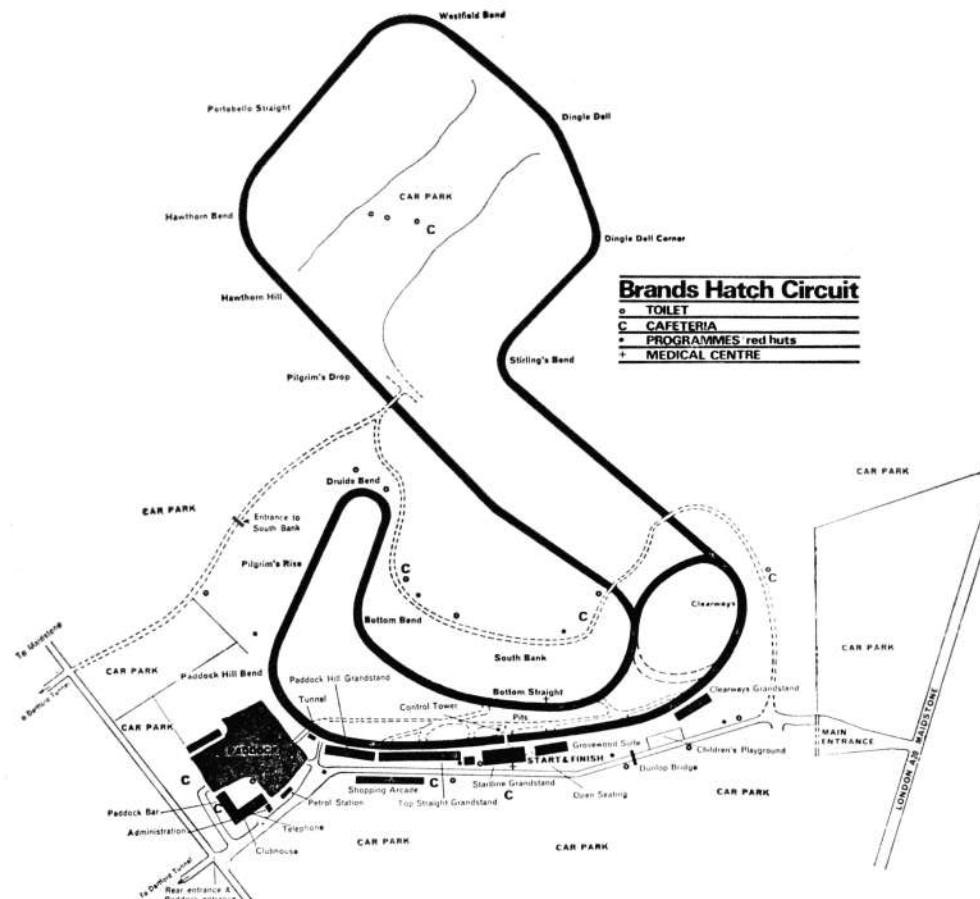

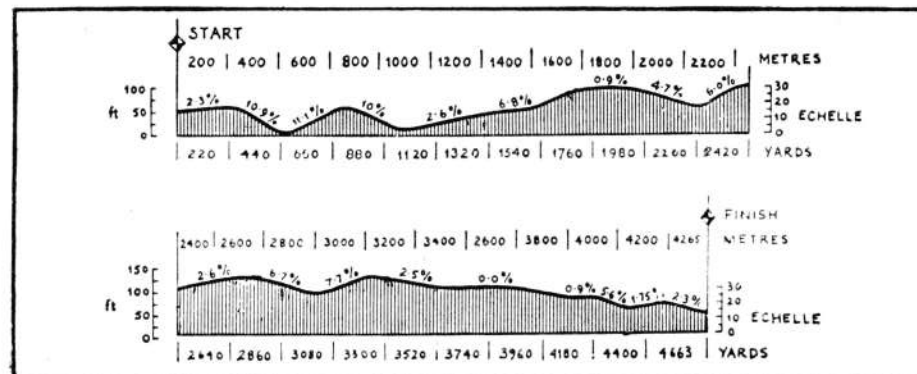
