There is free choice of spring rates and anti-roll bars; dampers must be steelbodied and singleadjustable.

The engines must be seriesproduction fourstroke units and may not be modified from standard; they run in three classes: standard Fireblade engined kit cars (class C), up to 145 bhp (class B), 146 to 180 bhp and all rearengined cars (class A). Control tyre is the Yokohama AO48R.

Premier Choice Group 750 Formula Championship

750 Formula is for two-seater sports racing cars, introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits There are two engine options either the highly tuned Reliant 850cc or the unmodified Fiat 'FIRE' 1108cc. the latter introduced in 2003 due to the diminishing supply of spares for the Reliant engine. All cars run on a control Yokohama slick tvre.


