FLAG SIGNALS

National Flag: Start.

Red Flag: Stop, all Competitors.

Black Flag with Rider's Number: That Rider to stop.

Green Flag: Course Clear.

Yellow Flag: Danger, ride slowly.

Blue Flag: Give way to Competitors about to pass you.

Yellow Flag with Diagonal Black Cross: Last Lap.

Checkered Black and White Flag: Finish of Race.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO COMPETITORS.

The attention of all competitors is drawn to the Regulations concerning (1) Self-closing throttles (2) A.C.U. approved pattern crash helmets; (3) Leather clothing.

PRACTISING: TWO practice laps of the Course must be carried out by all riders between 1 and 1.30 p.m. on the day of the meeting. A testing ground will be provided but no machine may be started before 1 p.m.

WARNING: *Competitors are reminded that riding in the Paddock is strictly forbidden.*

STARTING: On the recommendation of the A.C.U., starts from the Grid will be 30ft. nearer the Paddock. In all races starts will be by push start from the Grid.

FOR THE ATTENTION OF SPECTATORS.

Please do not leave litter about the grounds or woods—remember you CAN take it with you.

The Rochester, Chatham and District M.C., acknowledge with thanks the valuable assistance given by the individual marshals and supporting Clubs in conducting this event.

If a spill occurs, leave it to the marshals and Doctor and St. John Ambulance men who are in attendance.

We would like to ask that you remember to drive with care and caution when leaving the ground.

To safeguard both competitors and public, the spectators must see that their dogs are secure and not allowed to run loose. This is most important.

Prohibited Area Notices.—The Public are not permitted in the areas where these Notices are displayed. The Fences are there for protection and any person or persons found trespassing or wilfully damaging Fences, Trees, etc., will be prosecuted by Brands Hatch Stadium Limited.

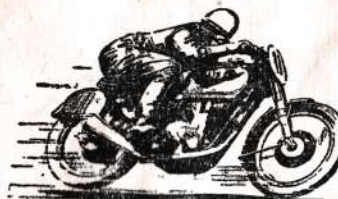
