

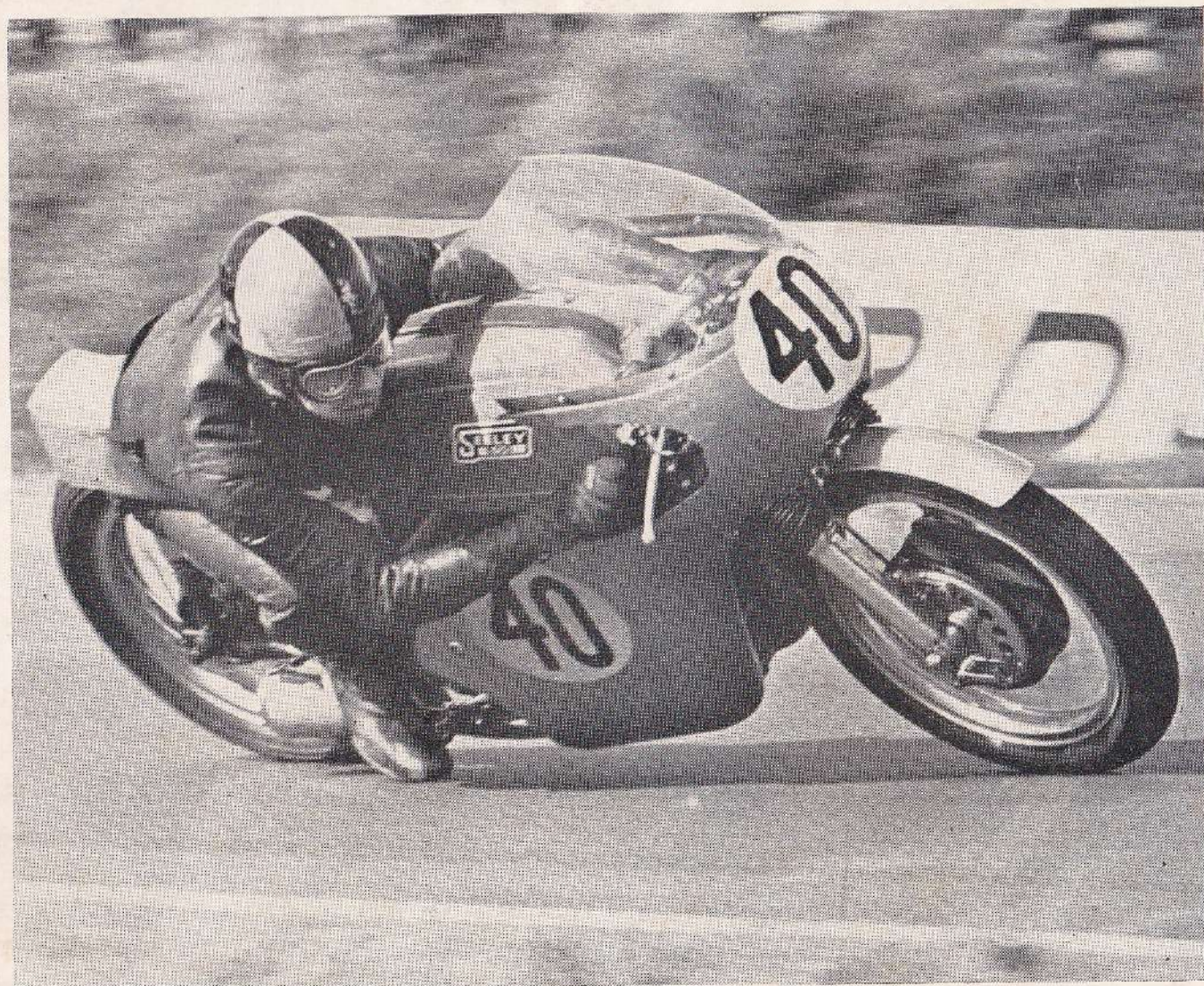

END OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP TRIAL

Although the season is not absolutely over (for instance, we hope that you will all be back here again on the Sunday after Christmas, December 29, for the Brands Racing Committee's Yuletide Trophy meeting), today's is the final bout of the hard-fought national championship battle.

Not surprisingly, after a long season of racing, most of the championships are now concluded and only the 350 cc championships remain to be settled.

Of the leading contenders, all but John Cooper, who is nursing some recently acquired knocks, will be among the contestants for what promises to be a rousing conclusion to the championship series of 1968, while with two heats and a final in every event of the day, racegoers are promised combat of both quantity and quality.

In the 250 cc event, with John Cooper winner of the championship, the major conflict will be between runner-up Derek Chatterton on his 246 Yamaha-engined mount, Tony Godfrey of Southampton on a Kawasaki, Paul Smart from Maidstone astride a Yamaha, Grant Gibson from Bromley with his Ducati, Jim Curry on an Aermacchi and Dave Browning, also Yamaha mounted. An interesting entry here is Steve Murrey, the young Liverpool rider on an extremely fast 125 cc Honda. A few of the 250 cc equipped entrants will have to motor to keep up with him. Charlie Mortimer from Shere, Suzuki-borne, will also need watching.

In the fierce 350 cc reckoning, both title protagonists, Grovewood Award winner Alan Barnett, from Iwer, Buckinghamshire, and Jim Curry, will be anxiously hoping to tot up the points, though other riders in search of prize money will be pleased to see them eliminated from the scoreboard.

Barnett on his 349 cc Kirby Metisse and Curry on the 344 cc Aermacchi will have to fend off the fast combination of Chatterton (Kawasaki), Paul Smart (Ducati), Grant Gibson (Ducati), Brian Ball (Yamaha), Ray Pickrell (Aermacchi), No. 3 Grovewood Award winner Rodney Gould (Aermacchi), Dave Simmonds (Kawasaki), Tony Smith

(BSA) and Ron Chandler (Seeley), if they are to collect at all. But, either way, one or other will almost certainly wear the championship crown for the ensuing year.

Dave Croxford won the 500 cc national championship at Mallory Park last weekend but today, Barnett will be out to turn the tables with the big Kirby Metisse against Croxford's Seeley, and their titanic duel will be joined by the Harrow express Ray Pickrell on his 497 Dunstall, John Taylor, the Gravesend member of Tom Kirby's highly successful stable, on the Kirby Matchless, Rod Gould on a Norton, Tony Smith astride a BSA, Ron Pladdys on a Norton, Charlie Sanby from Hatfield on a Manx Norton, Brian Ball on one of Colin Seeley's senior mounts, as well as other noted performers.

Although the national 500 championship is won, there is still today's final round in the Redex 500 cc championship but here, too, the odds are on Croxford. The "King of Brands" has an eight point lead over Alan Barnett and there are eight points for first place down to one for sixth. If Croxford gets anywhere into the first six he wins the £100 award and the best that Barnett can hope for is a tie if he wins the race and Croxford finishes lower than sixth.

The leading riders in all categories come together, at least on the starting grid, for the no-holds barred 500 - 1300 cc Mayhew Trophy race with two 5-lap heats and a 10-lap final.

The three-wheel event for the Slazenger trophy, with the championship already decided, will bring some of the finest exponents in the business into view, headed by the formidable ensemble of Terry Vinicombe, Chris Vincent, Colin Seeley, the Hanks' and the Bodices, all of them except Seeley being aboard BSA-powered combinations.

With a big supporting cast and prize money providing an incentive for all-out performance, the crowd can look forward to some fast and hectic encounters.

Points are scored automatically to the first six finishers in each race as follows : 8 points for the winner and 6, 4, 3, 2 and 1 for the next five places.

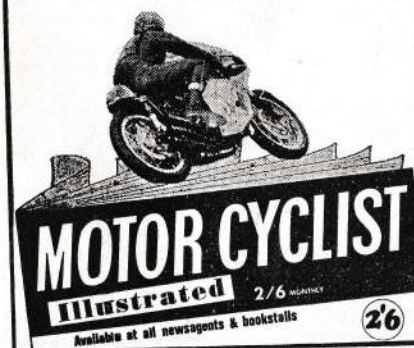

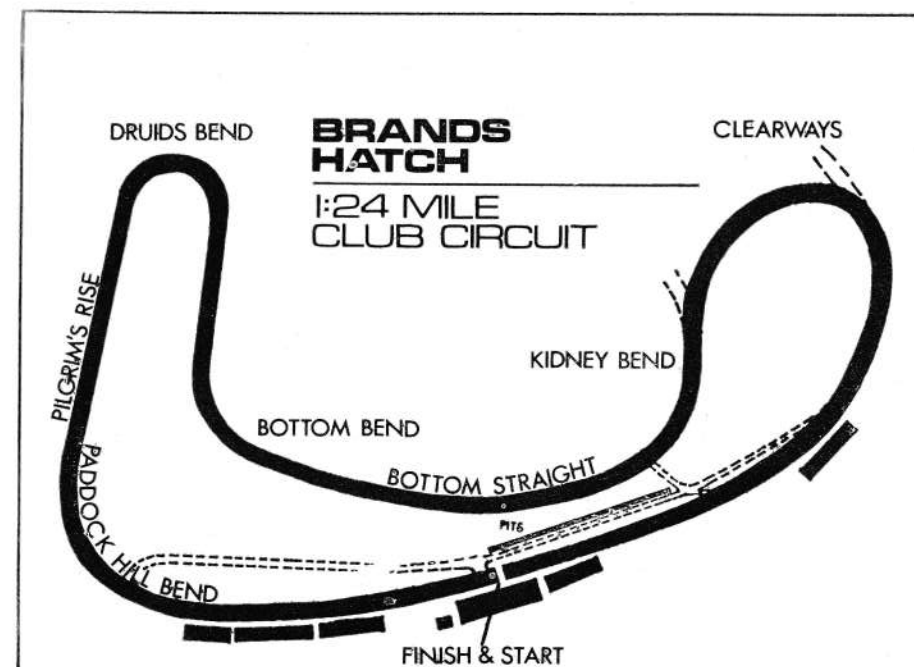

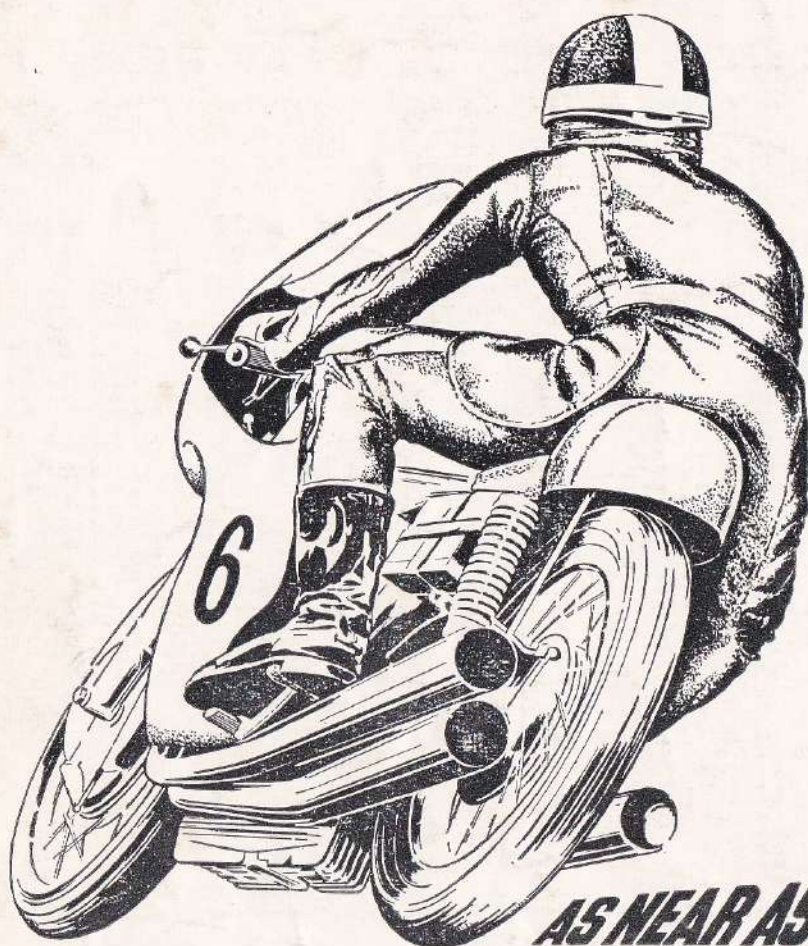
