

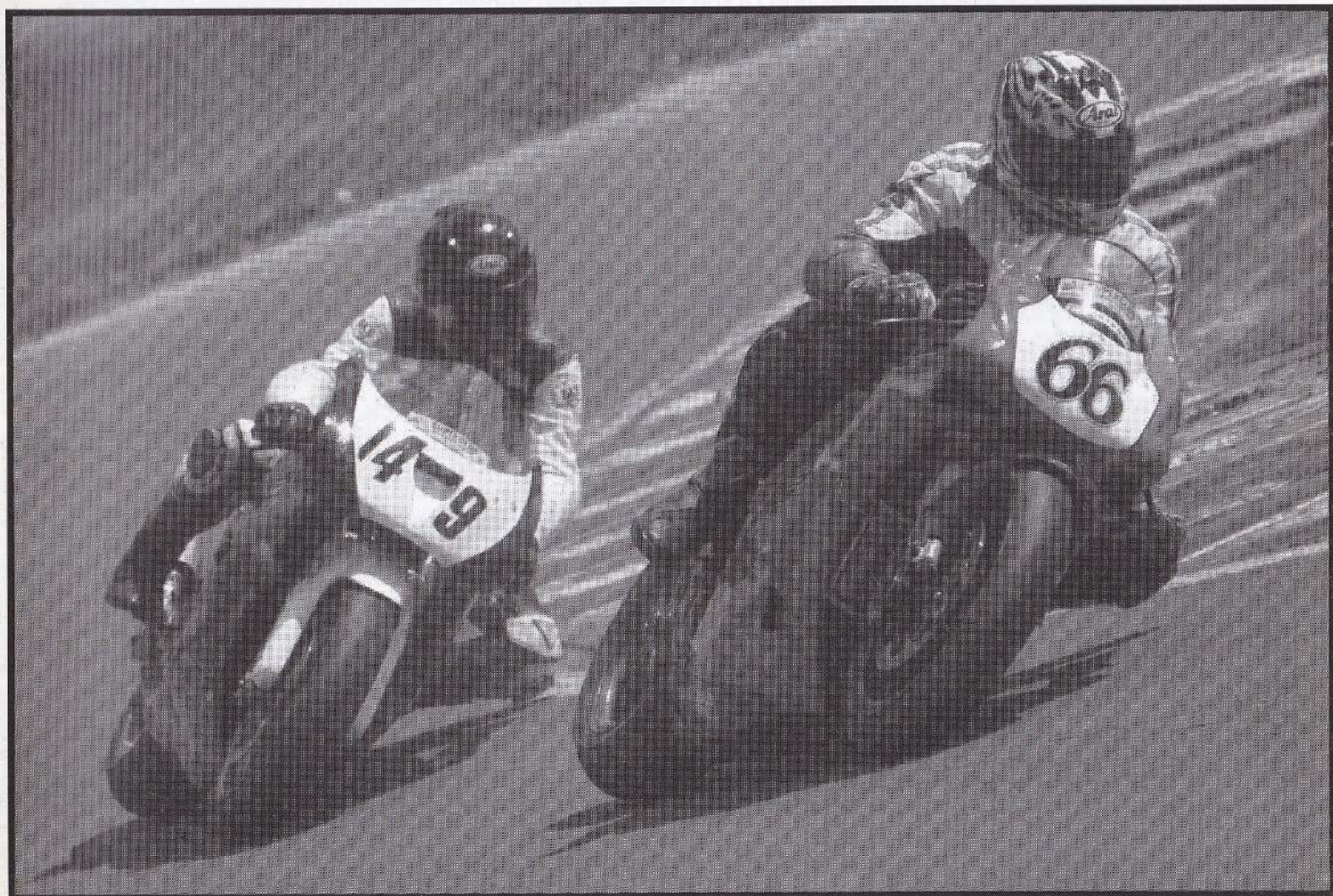

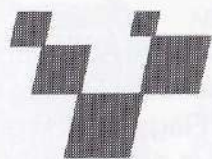

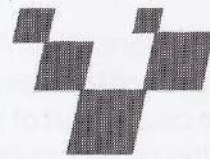

Important Notice FLAG SIGNALS USED AT ALL NEW ERA EVENTS

FLAGS GIVING INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

RED FLAG OR RED LIGHTS: The Race or Practice is being interrupted for safety reasons. Riders must immediately cease racing and return slowly to the Pits, or as directed by the Marshals acting on the instructions of the Clerk of the Course.

YELLOW FLAG: Danger on this section of the track. When shown motionless riders must prepare to slow down. When shown waved, the danger is imminent and riders must slow down and be prepared to stop. In both cases overtaking is forbidden up until the point where the green flag is shown.

BLACK: This flag is designed to convey instructions to one rider only and is displayed together with the rider's number. The rider must stop at the end of the current lap and cannot restart. This flag is always shown at the start/finish line on special instructions from the Clerk of the Course.

BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK: (40 cm dia.) Shown together with a white number on a black signalling board, on the orders of the Clerk of the Course at the start/finish line, it informs the rider whose motorcycle number is displayed that his motorcycle has mechanical problems likely to endanger himself or others, and he must immediately leave the track.

WHITE FLAG: This flag is not applicable to New Era Club Meetings and is never used.

FLAGS & LIGHTS GIVING INFORMATION

UNION JACK: Start of a race.

GREEN: Course is clear of all hazards This flag is shown on the first lap of each practice session, on the sighting lap and the warm-up lap. After the last yellow flag, the green flag will be shown motionless at the following flag marshal's post to indicate that the circuit is now clear ahead.

YELLOW WITH RED STRIPES: Oil, water or another substance is affecting adhesion on this section of the track.

YELLOW WITH BLACK CROSS: Denotes start of last lap.

BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED: Finish of Race or Practice session.

SLOW MOVING VEHICLES ON THE TRACK

In accordance with ACU Standing Regulations, the NEW ERA Club NEVER despatch an Ambulance, Fast Intervention Vehicle (FIV), or any other slow moving vehicle on the track whilst Practice or Racing is taking place on any part of the circuit. If such a vehicle is required on the circuit, the Red Flags are first displayed and the race or practice brought to an actual & effective halt before the vehicle is deployed.

EXCEPTION: Stationary or moving Ambulances, Fast Intervention Vehicles, Recovery Vehicles and the like, may be encountered anywhere on the circuit when riders are despatched from the Assembly Area on their "Sighting Lap" to the Startline prior to the start of a race. This "Sighting Lap" is not considered to be either Practice or Racing and riders must always be prepared to encounter such vehicles. When such a vehicle or vehicles are on the track the Yellow Flags will be displayed in the appropriate section of the course.

New Era Superclub at Brands Hatch

"Without doubt this series brings together some of the cream of British club racing"

Only five riders have notched up wins in the opening rounds of this year's Superclub Formula 600 series Richard Norris, Glyn Ormerod, Mark Cronshaw, Kevin Brown and Brad Howell.

But even with 14 races still to go only two of that talented quartet, Norris and Ormerod, look to be serious contenders for the title.

The pair tops the points table with Norris, the 33-year-old from near Reading, unbeaten in his five rides on 125 points, 20 ahead of his 34-year-old rival, Ormerod.

Ormerod could well have cut that gap to 15 if he had known at Mallory Park in the last round that Cronshaw, the 25-year-old from Rossendale, had been penalized ten seconds for jumping the start.

With conditions tricky Ormerod eased the pace to make sure of second spot. Had he known Cronshaw's situation he would have attempted to close the gap.

Do not be fooled into believing that the others have given up, though.

Tony Keilty is third in the points. The highly experienced 38-year-old from Milton Keynes is on 74, 51 behind Norris, but things could easily change, particularly after this weekend where there are 100 points to be won here and injury or mechanical problems could play havoc with anyone's title ambitions.

Scotsman Kevin Brown was forced to miss the Mallory Park event because his partner had booked a holiday in New York before the season's dates had been announced. The 39-year-old from Jedburgh, who won

two of his races at Cadwell Park, is contesting the rest of the series, aiming to make up the 55 point deficit on Norris.

Antony Hendy is fifth in the points after consistently scoring in every round, while Cronshaw, looking set for his best season ever is sixth.

Adam Lovett, the very talented 20-year-old from near Lincoln, crashed out of the opening round of the series at his local track, Cadwell Park, badly damaging his shoulder.

He hopes to be fit enough to be back in Superclub action here, but without a single point to his credit the chances of him winning the title are slim.

What he could very well do, though, is have a distinct bearing on the outcome of the series.

Ant Hinton is another who could play a part in deciding the outcome. The 24-year-old crashed at Mallory, breaking a thumb and preventing him from riding that day.

He hopes to be back to near full fitness, but with only 22 points to his credit, to Norris' 125, he will need a miracle to get back in the hunt.

Watch out, too, for Jamie Wheatley, the very-stylish 35-year-old from Beaconsfield who has done well in the New Era Clubmans Challenge series this year.

Just five points separate Jonathan Lester and Marcus Jones at the top of the Superclub Pro-Bike Open series.

Lester, like Norris in the 600 class



returning to his club roots, was cautious at Mallory, but thanks to two wins and a second at Cadwell Park the 34-year-old from Ashby-de-la-Zouch still tops the standings.

Jones, the 35-year-old from near Oswestry, in his first season big bikes after switching from the 600 class, has like Lester not finished outside the top in five outings.

But reigning champion Peter Baker is not far behind the pair on 83, to Lester's 99 and the wily 46-year-old from Kings Lynn will be hard to stop.

Jules Croft, Jim Payne and Greg Lewis are fourth, fifth and sixth in the points and they will each need to grab a big score this weekend to climb into contention.

Alex Kvintas is making a comeback to the sport and had a good day at Donington Park recently. He could well be in the thick of the action.

Keep an eye too on Lee Fletcher, the hard-riding 20-year-old from Doncaster, who switched to big bikes from the 600 class. Fletcher's luck has not been too good so far this season, but on his day he will be a real threat.

The same must surely be said for the normally cheery Rick Ellis. He, too, has moved up the Pro-Bike class, but accidents and mechanical problems have left him an unhappy man.

Closest of all the Superclub championships, though, is the Sound of Thunder where series leader Mark Hoogenboom leads his arch-rival Simon Nuttall in their all-Ducati battle, by just a single point.

Jason Dixon is third, 27 points adrift of the leader on his Aprilia, while Dean Wain, in fourth place, continues to confound the opposition by running up at the front on his Triumph.

Richie Welsh on the other hand, has a comfortable 36-points' advantage over his arch-rival Dave Irons in the Formula 400 battle.

Last year Welsh won both the New Era club and Superclub 400, but this season his aim is even more ambitious.

He is out to take the Superclub and MRO crowns.

But for problems in the first race in the opening rounds at Cadwell Paul Turner would be closer to Welsh. The Cheshire racer is third on 72, 48 points adrift.

Lee Wollington, fourth in the points, will be keen to get back into contention and so too will be Barry Poll, in sixth place.

Keep on eye on one of two very fast young ladies in action this weekend, Catherine MacDonald. Under the guiding hand of top 600 racer Brian Bartlett, Catherine is improving every time out and her fifth place in the points' table is no fluke.

Sharing the grid with the 400s will be the CB500s, where Rick Coles is the comfortable series leader on 101 points.

It is close, very close, behind him.

Brian Gamble is second on 58, closely followed by Sam Parry, Phillip Higgins, Jamie Ward, Luke Jackson and Michael Houlden. Those six men separated by nine points.

Heaven help any of the F400 competitors who get in the way of this private war!

It is not so close in the Hornets, but still very interesting.

Michael "Jack" Russell tops the standings on 106 after never having finished outside the top three this year.

But Matthew Briggs, in second spot with 83, is on good form and so too is Jonty Dixon, third with 73 points.

But Stuart Martin, younger brother of pure-road race expert Guy Martin can point to a crash while leading at Mallory for the reason he is only fourth on 68.

Consistent Stuart Machin is fifth and Colin Dunstan, who has a win to his credit, is sixth.

Three storming wins at Cadwell Park got Darrell Higgins' bid to win the Superclub

250 title off to a great start.

Two thirds at Mallory keep the 46-year-old firmly at the top of the standings with 107 points, 33 clear of his closest rival, 21-year-old Ben Johnson from Chesterfield.

Another Derbyshire racer, 27-year-old Adam Hoare, having his best-ever season, is third, three points further back.

Andrew Cotton, the 19-year-old from Poole is fourth, five behind Hoare, one of only three riders, along with Higgins and Johnson to have won a race.

Ian Brookman, the 34-year-old from near Swindon, had to ride through the pain to score points at Mallory Park after hurting his back in a heavy crash at the same circuit a couple of weeks earlier.

He is fifth on 60, but could well climb the table after this weekend.

Lee Costello is sitting pretty at the top of the 125 GP points' table.

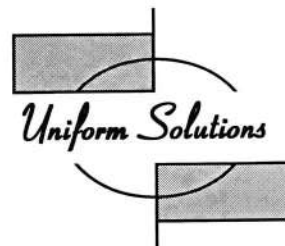
The teenager has 102 points, 26 more than another talented youngster, 15-year-old Philip Wakefield.

Consistent Ashley Cornall, the 18-year-old from near Preston, is third on 68.

Joel Williams, the 15-year-old from near Manchester, is hoping for better luck this weekend after two very recent meetings were ruined by crashes or major engine failures. He is fourth after his only two scores, the wins at Mallory Park.

A crash stopped another Northern youngster, 14-year-old Matt Hoyle, from near Bradford, adding to his win in the opening race at Cadwell Park, but he is still fifth in the points, 62 behind Costello.

Watch out for Aaron Easter, the 14-year-old former mini moto racer, who had his best ever meeting at Snetterton a couple of weeks ago, when he led the highly-experienced Andrew Sennett in one race.

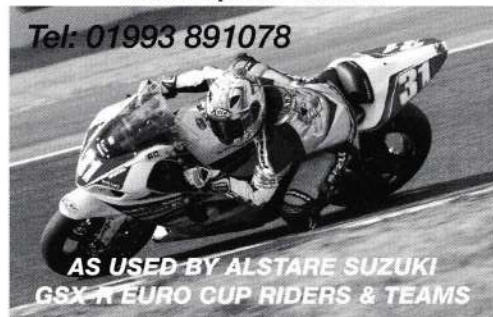

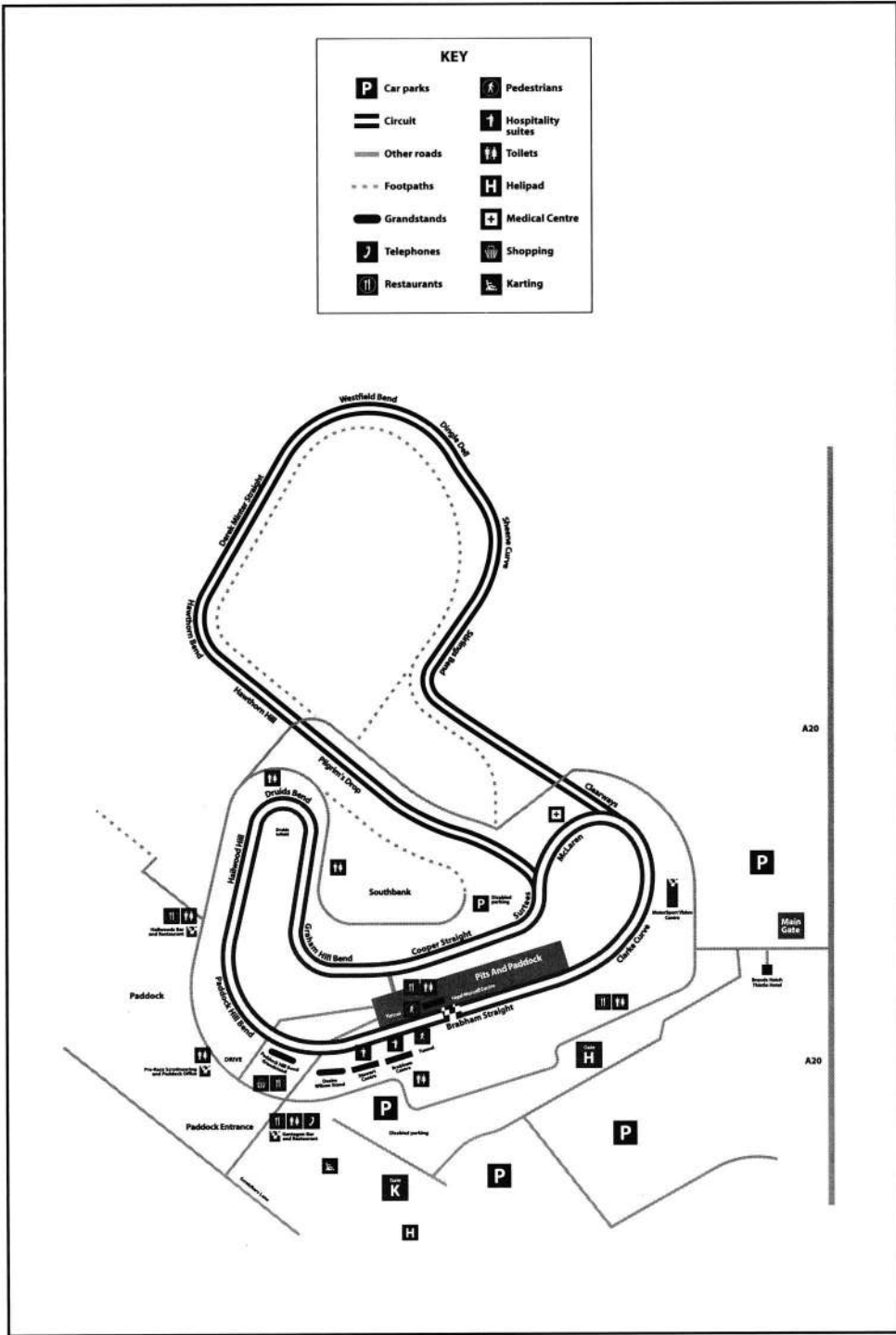

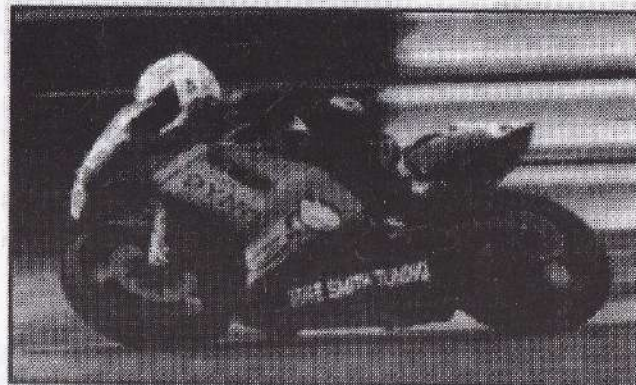
