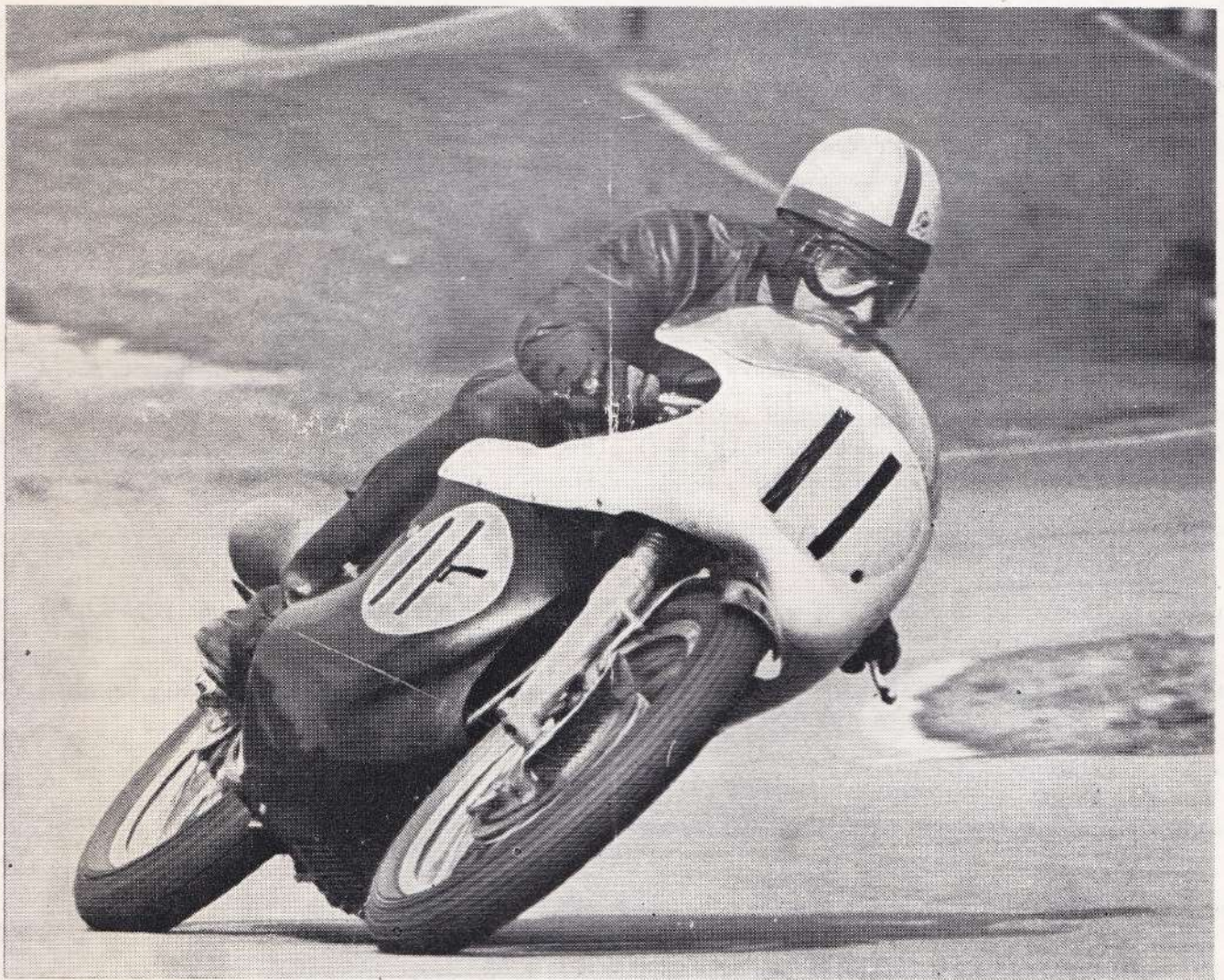

AN OPEN LETTER TO DEREK MINTER FROM ONE OF HIS FANS

Dear Derek,

Perhaps you might like to know how one of your fans feels about you, one who cannot be present today because his new son is being christened.

In the ten years since I first saw you race I've come to regard you as a giant killer on your brilliant days, a champion of the underdog, one of the few top men interested in helping newcomers, and an outspoken—sometimes possibly misguided—critic of all and sundry.

These attributes have made you the Mint, the most consistently successful and popular rider to grace Brands. Who can ever forget those monumental Norton battles with Mike Hailwood, Bob McIntyre, Phil Read, John Hartle and John Cooper? It was the finest racing ever seen at Brands—or anywhere else for that matter.

The cheerful, cheeky, chappie that spectators know is not just a facade for their benefit—you have been the same person to us Press types on most (but not all!) occasions. And your controversial doings have given us plenty to write about. Like the fans, I've frequently speculated just how far you could have gone had fate, or a good business manager, pointed you in another direction at some of the crossroads in your career.

For instance, after that brilliant Senior TT lap at 101.05 mph on Steve Lancefield's Norton in 1960 came your only TT win, the 1962 250 cc Lightweight on a Honda four

which was lent to you. Had things turned out differently after that, who knows but a Honda contract might have come your way? What might have been the outcome of the 1966 Senior TT had you not dropped your Gilera in practice? Such imponderables pepper your career more than any other rider in recent years.

Your long slog with Gileras after everyone had long since given up hope for them, your efforts to put Cottons on the racing map, your championing of the underdog and your consistent support of home racing, endeared you to fans but was probably at the expense of a career on factory machines.

This fan is convinced that had the dice rolled differently back, say, in 1962, you could have won world championships by now. You had the courage—perhaps too much—the ability, the determination, and the backing of race supporters everywhere. That things did not work out differently is life, just life Remember, Stirling Moss was one of the greatest, yet he never won a world crown.

Of more merit is to retain the affection and friendship of spectators as you have done. You have given us great pleasure and some wonderful memories, Derek. Thanks.

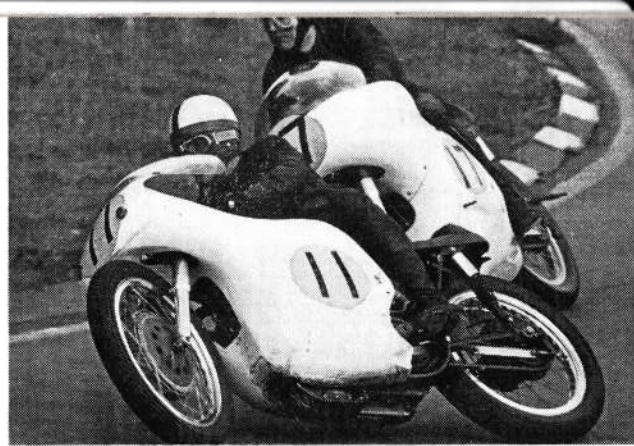

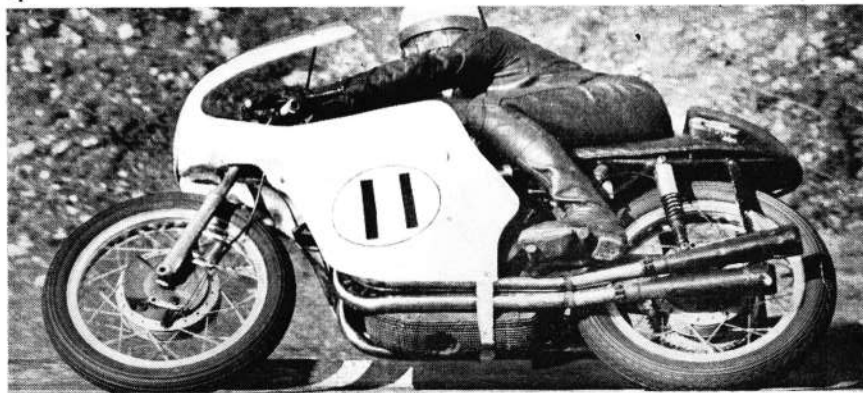

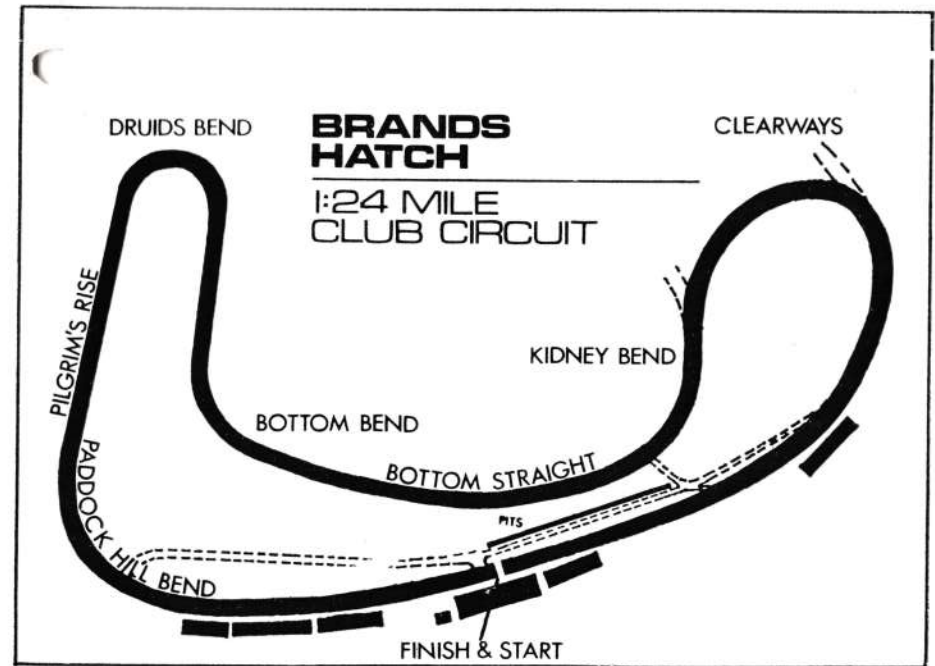
