FLAGS AND LIGHTS

Marshals and other officials display flags, lights or boards to provide information and/or convey instructions to the riders during practice as well as the races.


Flags and lights used to provide information.

NATIONAL FLAG OR "START LIGHTS" : Start of the race.


GREEN FLAG OR GREEN LIGHT :

 This indicates the end of a Danger Area controlled by yellow flags. In these circumstances overtaking is **PROHIBITED** until the point where the Green Flag is displayed has been passed. It is also to signal the start of a warm-up lap and shown at all posts during the first lap of each practice session.


YELLOW AND RED STRIPED FLAG :

 Shown waved indicates oil, water or another substance is affecting adhesion on this section of the track.


BLUE FLAG :

 Shown waved, this flag indicates that a faster rider is about to overtake.


WHITE FLAG :

 Shown waved, there is a slow moving car, ambulance or similar vehicle on the track this flag indicates that the rider will encounter the vehicle in current section of the track. The dispatcher of such a vehicle on the track must ensure that the post prior to the point where the vehicle will join the track is aware of the situation. It is forbidden for a rider to overtake another rider during the display of the white flag. Overtaking the slower moving vehicle is permitted. As soon as such a vehicle stops on the track, the white flags must be maintained and the yellow flags must be presented.


CHEQUERED (BLACK AND WHITE) FLAG :

 Finish of race or practice session.

CHEQUERED FLAG AND BLUE FLAG :


 These flags are shown together at the start line when a rider(s) precedes the leader during the final lap before the finish line.

YELLOW FLAG WITH BLACK CROSS :


 You are about to start your last lap.

Flags Which Convey Information and Instructions.

RED FLAG OR RED LIGHT :

 The practice or race is being interrupted. Riders must slow down and be prepared to stop. Riders must return to the pits, or as directed by the Marshals acting upon instructions from the Clerk of the Course.


YELLOW FLAG OR YELLOW LIGHTS :

 Danger on this section of the track. When motionless overtaking is forbidden. When shown waved the danger is more imminent and riders must slow down and be prepared to stop. Overtaking or failing to slow down is


forbidden. Riders must take immediate action on seeing the yellow flag/lights. During the final inspection lap, the yellow flag must be presented motionless at the exact place where the flag marshal will be positioned during practice and races.

There are automatic penalties for disregarding yellow or red flags. It may also be considered as an act of dangerous or reckless riding.

BLACK FLAG :

 This flag is designed to convey instructions to a rider and is displayed at the startline together with the rider's number. The rider must stop at the pits at the end of the current lap.

BLACK WITH ORANGE CIRCLE FLAG :

 This flag is displayed with the rider's number. The rider must leave the track IMMEDIATELY.

OTHER FLAGS MAY BE USED FROM TIME TO TIME IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ACU HANDBOOK.

SPECTATOR NOTICES

Please do not leave litter about the grounds, place in receptacles provided, or take home with you, remember just one piece of litter could be FATAL.

Please drive with care and consideration when leaving the circuit, this is a RaceTrack, the Road outside is NOT.

PROHIBITED AREA NOTICES

The Public are not permitted in the areas where these notices are displayed, any fences or gates are there for your protection, any person found trespassing, or wilfully damaging trees, fences etc, WILL BE PROSECUTED.

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

It is a condition of admission that Children and Others are not permitted to ride bicycles or motorcycles within these grounds, any person found in contravention of this ruling will be removed from the Circuit Grounds.

NO CHILDREN UNDER 16 ARE ALLOWED IN PIT LANE.

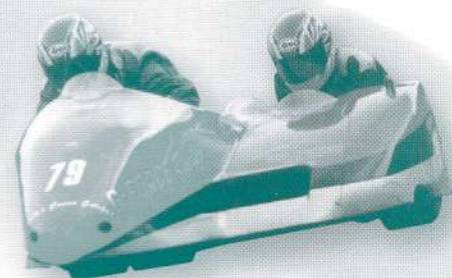

The Champion of Brands rides again!



The Champion of Brands title has stayed close to home for two of the past three years with Strood based Adam Redding being the current champion. 1999 champ, Chris Bishop is back for another charge this year aboard his Bike Shop Faversham CBR600 Honda. The only winner from north of the river in recent years was Lowestoft based Jamie Hitter in 2000.

The magnificent AMC Trophy could be heading a lot further north this year though with a hoard of very talented Scots lining up for the challenge, lead by Scottish Champion Les Shand. There are no less than 15 members of the Tartan Army aiming at snaffling the points and prize money this weekend, including Doug Cowie, Scott Shand, Donald MacFadyen, Magnus Houston, Keith Amor, Will Monie, Keith Watt and Andy Wallace.

If that wasn't a good enough reason to get the Cross of St George ironed and flying from the flagpole, the Irish are mounting a strong assault too. Marshall Neill, Declan Swanton, Dave Mateer, Derek McLaughlin, Eddie Allingham, Derek Wilson and Steve Thompson are all hoping to take the lions share of the prize fund back across the Irish Sea on Sunday night.

It might end up going just halfway, to the Isle of Man, if Chris Heath, Tom Clucas or Juan Kinnish have anything to say about it. It's great to see such well respected riders travelling all the way to Brands Hatch and it will make this the first International meeting of the year on the mainland. This is a race that any one of 40 riders could win, and with lap times all within less than 1 second of each other the action around the short and twisty speedbowl will be frantic.

Kent based World Cup sidecar teams Tim & Tristan Reeves and Trev Stafford & Simon Wright will be taking on the best Formula One teams the UK has to offer over the two days. Last year both teams finished in the top five of the British Championship and this year they aim to make this a South Eastern dominated class. The title has gone to midlands based Tom Hanks for the past two seasons but the southerners are determined that Round One spoils will stay south of the Thames this year.

If you've never seen or heard 28 Formula One outfits screaming into the awesome Paddock Hill Bend on the first lap, it's advisable to hold on to your hat for this one.

When the Powerbikes fire into Paddock Hill for the first time, they will be unleashing a combined 6000 horsepower and they'll all be aiming at the right hand apex of the corner at the same time. Even as a professional it never ceases to amaze and astound me when they all emerge unscathed at the bottom of Tumbledown. Then it's up to Druids Hairpin for a scene that is reminiscent of a busy Friday night on the M25. With racing this close you'll be glued to the action from Green Light to Chequered Flag and with more overtaking on a single lap than an entire F1 Grand Prix you will certainly be back for more.

With a whole new intake of riders in both Rookie classes this might be your first chance to see a future world champion take to the track for the first time.

I will always remember the stunned looks on the faces of the regular riders when Shane Byrne took his first sideways win aboard his bucking and weaving Kawasaki ZXR 400 in atrocious conditions. He has since gone on to win the British Superbike privateers championship and we hope he follows that up with the overall title this year.

Which one of today's riders is the 'new Shakey'?

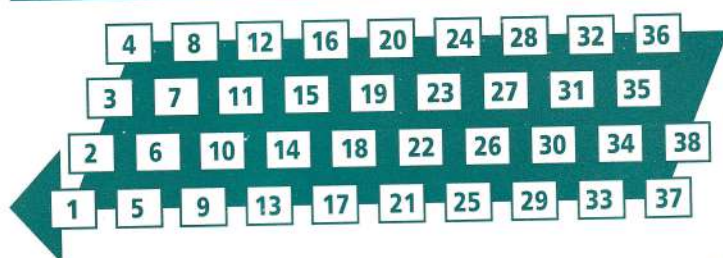
