





GRAND PRIX ACES ON THE SHORT CIRCUIT

Making his first-ever appearance on an English circuit, Czechoslovakia's popular Frantisek Stastny joins double world champion Phil Read and ex-champion Bill Ivy in a star-studded entry for today's Evening News International.

It is the first time for some years that a full-scale international programme has been staged on the short, 1.24-mile, version of the circuit instead of on the full 2½-mile course. And with the sort of line-up here today it is almost inevitable that a new lap record will result.

The Evening News title race is open to machines of 101 - 1000 cc and the field ranges from Stuart Graham's ex-works 125 cc Suzuki to the big 750 cc Dunstall that Ray Pickrell will be riding and the 750 cc Nortons of Mick Andrew, Martyn Ashwood and Paul Smart.

Ex-King of Brands Dave Croxford — one of the very few riders in this event who will not be rushing straight from the track to start practising for the Isle of Man TT Races — has nominated a 750 cc Seeley.

Stastny has put himself down for either a 250 cc or a 350 cc version of the very fast new four-cylinder two-stroke Jawa. And as the smaller model is currently proving more reliable than the bigger one he could well decide to play safe and use it, relying upon its phenomenal acceleration to put him to the fore.

Phil Read will appear either on one of the very fast Daytona-style 350 cc Yamahas or, if it is over its teething troubles, on the 500 cc Read-Weslake twin. Bill Ivy, who at one time looked like being a new Jawa team man, now plans to ride a 350 cc Yamaha.

Banking on "good old-fashioned British singles" of 500 cc capacity are the new "King of Brands," Peter Williams (Arter Matchless); John Taylor (Matchless), the Gravesend rider who has regained top form this summer after an unlucky 1968 season; Alan Barnett (Kirby Metisse); Welshman Malcolm Uphill (Norton); Ron Chandler (Seeley) and Rex Butcher (Oakley Quaife).


Rod Gould from Banbury — first man to get acquainted with the 140-mph Daytona Yamahas — is relying on one of these Japanese "350s;" Barry Sheene has a works 350 cc Bultaco from Spain; and Pat Mahoney has a 382 cc Aer-macchi from Italy.

Two five-lap heats will be run for the Evening News event which will have two 20-lap finals, same riders in each, with the results decided on moto-cross lines. Points on a scale of one for the winner, then in ascending order for the rest of the finishers, will be awarded for each race, with the overall victor as the man with the lowest number of points. Ties will be decided by aggregate time for the two races.

Also included in the meeting is a further round of the 500 cc Redex Trophy series. And there are 125 cc, 250 cc and 350 cc solo class events.

Two heats and a 10-lap final will be run for the sidecar class which has attracted entries from Britain's own two top men, national champion Peter Brown and ex-champion Chris Vincent, both with 654 cc BSA outfits and both entered by Guilsborough, Northants., enthusiast Peter Chapman; and from West Germany comes BMW ace Georg Auerbacher.





Above : The new 'Master of Mallory,' Rodney Gould, astride his 348 cc Yamaha.





