

Top Stars Chase Increased Prize Money Preview of today's racing by Peter Arnold

Each new season inevitably brings new ideas and machines. The first full national motor-cycle meeting at Brands Hatch this year — the Redex 100-mile Grand National today — is no exception. A speedboat-engined solo is one of the most interesting entries.

But you, the Brands fans, come in your thousands to see your favourite stars—there are plenty of the country's top road-racing stars present today to keep you satisfied. John Hartle tops the bill and he is backed by Dan Shorey, Rex Butcher, Ray Pickrell, Griff Jenkins, Martin Carney, Derek Chatterton, Pat Mahoney, Brian Ball and none other than the King of Brands himself, Ron Chandler. Sidecar fans will be able to see Pip Harris, Chris Vincent, Peter Brown, Bill Boddice and 1967 Grovewood Award winner Mick Boddice.

Revised prize money scheme

The racing will be tougher and more exciting under the Motor Circuit Developments Ltd.'s revised scheme for 1968. No appearance money is given and the prize money has been increased so that there is an extra incentive to be just that one place higher! Total prize money amounts to £1500.

100-mile feature event—with pit-stops The major race of the day, the Redex 100-mile Grand National, is to be held over 40 laps on the 2.65-mile Grand Prix circuit and is sure to attract a tremendous amount of interest as each competitor has to make a compulsory pit-stip. Using approved cans and funnels everyone has to stop to take on half a gallon of fuel.

Pit-stops as such are an innovation in road-racing (apart from the 500-mile production race later in the season), but they could certainly add to the general spectator interest. Efficiency in the pits can change the leader-board considerably.

New machines

With few actual factory-produced roadracing machines available, more and more competitors are producing their own specimens. Composite bikes utilising proven frames fitted with proven engine units from another marque have been with us for quite a while. New frames are not so popular, although always interesting, and it is the engine units that create most interest. Certainly one of the most appealing machines on view will be the Peter Humber-built Crescent 3. Housed in his own frame, the engine is a well-known Swedish-built speedboat motor; watercooled it is a three-cylinder two-stroke Left: Desperate Dan Shorey, not a Brands specialist, will nevertheless give the 'scratchers' something to think about. producing over 70 horsepower. Although used in a sidecar outfit last year, this is the first time the Crescent 3 has been installed in a solo. Humber has practised at Brands recently and is happy with the handling and performance.

Same riders - different bikes

Another interesting new combination is the Grant Gibson 650 Domiracer Norton unit in a Bultaco 250 frame named the NW Bultaco. Grant, a Lightweight (250 cc) jockey in the past, makes his "heavyweight" debut on this machine. During the winter riders also change their stables. Rex Butcher, for instance, is now riding his own Kawasaki in the 350 cc class but is mounted on a Joe Francis-entered Domiracer Norton in the up to 1000 cc class. To complete his sponsorship changes, Butcher rides the Eddie Crooks-prepared Suzuki in the 250 cc class.

Up-and-coming trio

Promising Pat Mahoney, last year with Tom Kirby, now rides an Aermacchi entered by ex-racer Tom Phillips of Newbury. Pat is on a Curtis Domiracer in the bigger class, while in the 100-mile 500 cc Redex event he rides a Mortimer-Quafe-Metisse special.

John Taylor, a lighterman on the Thames (like King of Brands and British 500 cc champion Ron Chandler), who showed great promise in clubman's meetings last year, is sponsored by Tom Kirby for 1968. Taylor makes his debut today on the immaculate red, white and blue AJS and Matchless machines at this meeting. Ken Watson, another up-and-coming rider, is this year riding for Stevens, the well-known Velocette distributors, and is on their Velo and Suzuki machines.

Welcome return

Well-known Brands Hatch scratcher of a few seasons ago, Lewis Young, returns after an absence of two years on home circuits to compete in this meeting under the banner of two-stroke specialist Frank Sheene. Young, who has concentrated on Continental and South African meetings for the past five years, is to ride Butaco 125, 250 and 260 machines and a 498 Matchless.

Sidecars

But the solos do not have it all their own way. The three-wheeler "barrow boys" are there too. It would seem to be a BSA versus Triumph battle with a couple of BMWs thrown in for good measure. Riding the BMWs are Pip Harris and Tony Wakefield, while Chris Vincent, Peter Brown, Bill Boddice and his son Mick head the BSA brigade. Triumph-mounted are Ron Waters, the Woodhouse brothers (Doug and Roy), Tony Baitup and Jim Swain.




