



CHANGE OF MACHINE OR NOMINATION OF A SUBSTITUTE DRIVER:
Any entry of a particular make of machine and/or a nominated driver having been made and accepted, no change in either shall be permitted unless submitted to the Secretary of the Meeting at least 24 hours before the commencement of the start, and then EITHER driver or machine may be changed. A change of both driver and machine WILL NOT be permitted. All substitute drivers must qualify in practice in accordance with Regulation 15. A change of Driver can only be made by an Entrant under a Registered Licence No.

PRACTISING: Three practice laps of the course must be carried out by all riders.

WARNNIG: Competitors are reminded that riding in the paddock is strictly forbidden.

SCRUTINEERING: No machines will be accepted for scrutineering after these times: SOLOS — 10.40 a.m. SIDECARS — 11.00 a.m., except by special permission of the Clerk of the Course.




