





If an event is cancelled before, during or after practice and before any racing riders will receive £3. back with the other 50p. split between the organising club and the A.M.C.A. to cover postage of the riders tickets.

An event cancelled after riders have had one race, those riders who have had a race will receive £2.00 back, the organising club 75p. and the A.M.C.A. 75p.


