FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Held under the National Sporting Code, the Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions on the day.

1. The course will consist of 3 laps of 15 sections.
2. Any rider not starting at their start time will be penalised 1 mark per minute up to 20 minutes, after which they will be deemed a non starter.
3. All riders must when allocated their number be signed on by a parent or guardian.
4. The car park and start area is a SILENT ZONE. No starting of engines will be permitted until instructed to do so by an official.
5. Once a machine has been examined and moved into the start area it should remain there until the start time.
6. Riders must sign on and off.
7. Parents or guardians will not be permitted to walk the sections, doing so may result in disqualification.
8. Only competitors are allowed in the Observed sections until a '5' penalty has occurred, only then may the rider be assisted.
9. There will be a time limit of 5½ hours for the 'A&B's and 4½ hours for the 'C&D'S.
10. No riding or practicing after the event.
11. There will be a practice area marked on the way to your first sections.
12. There will be a 'PARC FERME' for the 'C' class where the finishers will park their bikes and the cubic capacity of the engines may be checked, this applies to all bikes in this class, failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Please treat our observers with civility and politeness, use the procedures available to you for protests and common sense in dealing with simple matters.
