



'MOTOR CYCLE' BRITISH MOTO CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

by Martin Christie, Motor Cross Editor of Motor Cycle

The battle for this year's British Championship reaches the half-way stage today and the scenic surrounding of the Royal Welsh Showground are the setting for what promises to be a sensational scrap.

1974 Double Champion Vic Allan (Bultaco) aims to hang on to the number one plate he carries, and has made a good start by pulling ont a ten point lead in the series. Plagued by mechanical breakdowns, the forceful combination of John Banks and CCM must regain its lost luck today or lose a grip on the title chase, as must teammate Vic Eastwood, the nicest guy never to win a championship.

But already the new-look series has justified all the pain and sweat that so many people put into its planning. Britain's young lions have stepped forth to meet the challenge of the grand-prix length races, and contest the domination of the established big names.

And not for a decade in British scrambling has anyone done that more forcefully than 18 year-old Graham Noyce who romped away with the last round on a borrowed Maico. Also, second on points so far. Cambridgeshire's stylish Stuart Nunn (CZ) is always a threat on the leaderboard.

Fast men on today's track should be Kiwi Ivan Miller (Bultaco) and Bryan Wade (Suzuki), but Welshman Andy Roberton (Bultaco) will be anxious to regain his early points lead. Among those who won't be on the track out of the original thirty graded names, is Andy Lee who is withdrawing. Andy Ainsworth has a broken left wrist, Les Lloyd, his left ankle, and Andy Nurden a collar bone.

But despite the casualties, we still have a line-up that boasts the cream of British scrambling, and promises some spectacular racing.




