RAY EDWARDS MEMORIAL SCRAMBLE

AMATEUR MOTOR CYCLE ASSOCIATION

50th ANNIVERSARY SPECIAL

CELEBRATION SCRAMBLE
"Ray Edwards Memorial Scramble"

at Brownhills 30th May, 1982

At this special event the programme will include 3 demonstration Races for scramble machines built before 1965. If any of your members have a suitable machine and they would like to ride perhaps you could let the office know by the 24th May.

Also at the Meeting a 3 wheeler race (ATC type machines may be included if sufficient entries are received Again if any members have an ATC or similar machine contact the Office as soon as possible deadline the 24th May.

As this event is part of the A.M.C.A.'s 50th Golden Jubilee Anniversary celebrations any former members are invited to attend and if any of your members know to any former older members if they could send or phone to the Office with the addresses, special passes can then be sent.

Each group of clubs in the Association have been invited to enter 2
Senior riders for this event. The purpose is to give some riders who do not normally have the chance to ride in prestige events a ride. Each group co-ordinator is responsible for submitting the names of the 2 riders and clubs or riders (especially the longer serving A.M.C.A. member) should ensure his co-ordinator is given the details of the riders who wish to be considered or eligible to ride.

The circuit at Brownhills has been levelled out immediately after the Sidecar International held on April 25th and if necessary will be watered. At the Sidecar International 60,000, gallons of water were sprayed on the course. Midland Clubs are asked to help marshal one point at the event and help on the gate or car park for 1 hour — (Details have been sent to the clubs concerned).

As no club or even group of clubs is responsible for this event all the A.M.C.A. riders who do compete are asked to help with clearing up after the meeting. As most of the course is permanently chestnut fenced the clearing up should only take a few minutes.

Among A.M.C.A. riders competing in the scramble events will be Gordon Mycock of the Walsall Club who many A.M.C.A. Championships in the late fifties and early sixties riding a B.S.A. Gold Star. He is being lent a similar 500 cc model in the Pre-65 events. His Son now rides in the Juniors so Gordon is still involved with the Walsall Club.

Les Powderhill who was the first A.M.C.A. rider to win a European title in the mid-sixties riding a 250 Greeves and now rides with the Kinver Club on a Maico.

Sammy Grigg from Birmingham a long serving member and still rides in the Senior class hopes to borrow an ex Jeff Smith B.S,A. Victor on which he won the World Championship.

Terry King the A.M.C.A.'s Public Relations Officer hopes to borrow a Greeves two stroke and he will be riding in the Seniors.

In the sidecar class Johnny Wolverson hopes to compete and he first held an A.M.C.A. Licence in the late fifties and except for a couple of short retirements still rides regularly and has won several A.M.C.A. Sidecar Championships plus the European Title. Unfortunately his Son Mark will be unable to ride as he broke his ankle at the last Brownhills event.

Probably the most successful all rounder to have ridden in the Association is John York from Earlswood near Solihull who has won all 4 different A.M.C.A. Championships, trials solo and sidecar and Scrambles solo and sidecar in which he still rides and should finish in the first three on the 30th May

The racing events will include the final round of the Super Class with the Ray Edwards Memorial awards going to the best 250 and 750 riders in this event and sidecars will also compete for the 3rd Ray Edwards Trophy while the top Senior will he awarded the Brownhills Trophy.

In addition to the racing a short demonstration trial will be held during the interval in the sand pits with A.M.C.A. invited riders demonstrating rather than competing. Riders invited to compete include the most successful trials rider ever to compete in the A.M.C.A. — Johnny Biddulph from Birmingham who has won the A.M.C.A. Trials Championship for the last nine years. The Championship is based on the winter season of trials, run most weekends from Mid-October up till Mid—April and each event can be up to 45 miles in length and include 40 observed sections.

It is hoped that former A.M.C.A. trials champions will be attending on the 30th, ex-champion Tony Chamberlain has already indicated he would like to have a ride and other riders invited include John Townsend whose father was a member of the Moseley Club when the club started in 1929. John now a member of the Rugby Club has ridden for many years and started as a passenger to his Father when Sidecars were included.


