







AMCA NEWS 2nd April 2007

The opening round of the 2007 IMBA Open European Championship was held at the superb Wohlen circuit in Swizterland at the weekend, the circuit which has seen many a GP held in yesteryear produced some superb racing. After an absence of 2 years, a new Belgian federation has joined and they sent a strong contingent of 6 riders.

Snow on Friday night had left the pits in a bit of a mess but the circuit was in perfect condition for raceday on Sunday.

The AMCA IMBA Wulfsport team consisted of #10 Simon Lane, #11 Richard-Mike Jones, #12 Rick Du'Feu, #14 Danny Blakeley and the man on form #16 Clinton Barrs with Steve Harvey as team leader.

After practice all the riders enjoyed the circuit, which was already rough after Saturdays racing.

As the gate dropped for the opening moto it was Richard-Mike Jones (Servo Kawasaki) who forced his way to the front, he was involved in a tight battle between local favourites, Bruno Rufli and Reto Vogelsang, Richard-Mike eventually being forced into a mistake which dropped him back. Rick Du'Feu (Delkevic Kawasaki) had gated seventh with Clinton Barrs (Wildmoor/Wulfsport PAR Honda) behind in 8th. Barrs made superb progress through the pack to catch the leading quintet of Rufli, Vogelsang, Belgian Christophe Descamps and defending Champ Frank Jansen Teitz from Germany, with Du'Feu in tow. Barrs couldn't get by and a small crash saw any chance of a podium slip away. At the flag it was Rufli who won from Vogelsang, Descamps and Teitz with Barrs in 5th. Simon Lane (Honda Equipe) had made good progress through the field for 10th at the flag, Danny Blakeley (Bricon Yamaha) had a rotten start but fought his way through to 21st.

Rufli was again the man to beat in race 2 as he hit the front ahead of Descamps, Lane, Teitz and Barrs with Jones in 6th. Du'Feu had gated 11th just ahead of Blakeley in 12th. The positions stayed the same at the front until both Teitz and Barrs got around Lane, Barrs then managed to put a pass on Tietz and set about trying to get the front two, but he ran out of time at the flag and it was Rufli who won from Descamps, Barrs, Teitz and Lane. Du'Feu was charging through the pack before disaster struck and he mistimed a corner and both he and Richard-Mike Jones went down. Du'Feu remounted for 11th with Blakeley riding solidly for 13th with Jones finishing 26th and suffering from concussion.

Race 3 it was Rufli again who hit the front ahead of Descamps and Lane. Barrs was 8th with Du'Feu 14th, Blakeley 24th and Jones touring at the back after deciding to try and ride but wisely deciding to pull in. Rufli managed to hold off Descamps all the way to the finish to just win and complete the maximum of three wins from three starts. Teitz finished third with Barrs an excellent fourth with Du'Feu 9th, Lane 16th after a mid race crash and Blakeley 18th. Results
