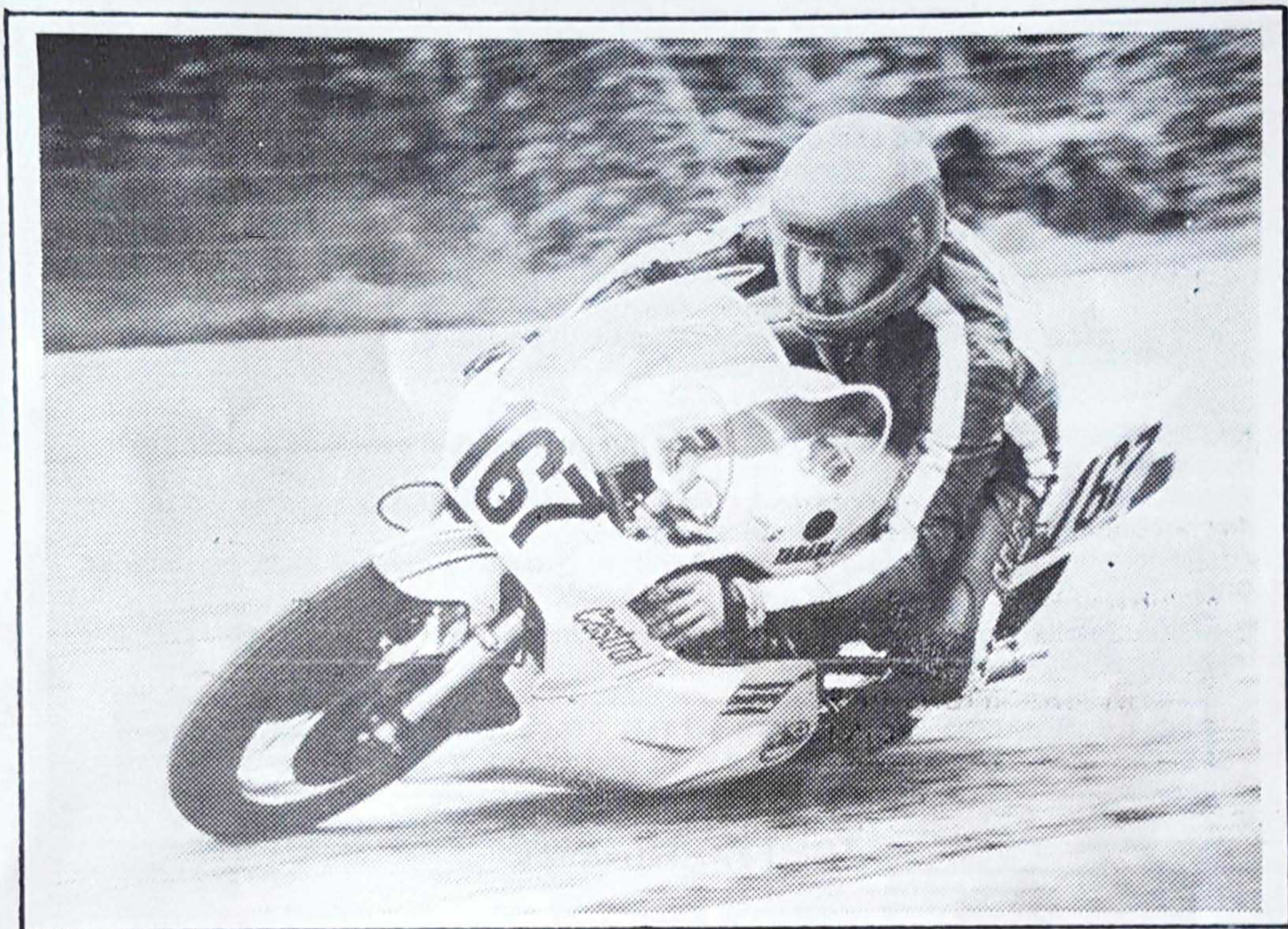

USED BY THE FLAG MARSHALS.

UNION JACK

RED

YELLOW (Motionless)

YELLOW (Waved)

YELLOW AND RED STRIPED

BLACK (With number)

BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED

YELLOW WITH BLACK DIAGONAL

CROSS

WHITE

YELLOW/YELLOW& RED HELD

CROSSED

START

STOP IMMEDIATELY

TAKE CARE: DANGER

GREAT DANGER: PREPARE TO STOP

OIL ON COURSE

MOTORCYCLE WITH THAT NUMBER

TO STOP

SIGNAL FOR END OF RACE

SIGNAL FOR START OF LAST LAP

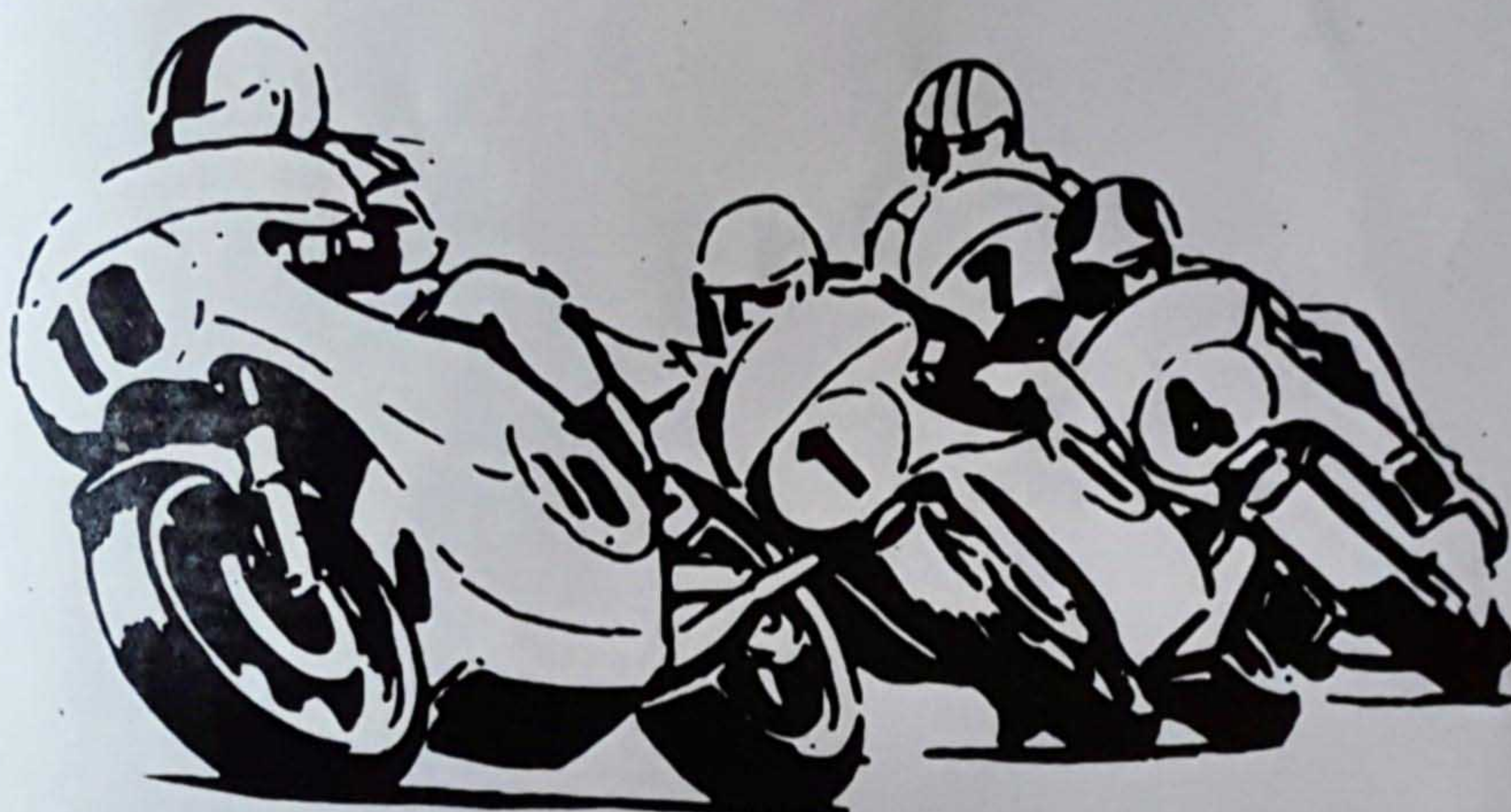

TAKE CARE: AMBULANCE ON COURSE

RACE PREMATURELY STOPPED

RETURN SLOWLY TO PADDOCK

NOTE: The crossed Flag Signals are put out in sequence on the stopping of a race by a Red Flag at the start.
When the yellow flags are displayed, riders will hold their distance and position and will not overtake.
