

#### INTRODUCTION

Pete Doughty of A.S. Doughty Precision Engineers is the sponsor of today's meeting, who until ten years ago was a regular competitor at our meetings riding a 250cc Rudge.

Pete then swapped from two to four wheels and embarked on a highly successful career in rallying. Making his debut in 1972 driving a Mini Cooper S, Pete soon purchased a 1300cc Ford Escort and in 1973 entered the RAC Rally. After a few seasons of mixed success in stage rallies around the country an entry into the 1978 Mazda Hatchback Challenge and several class wins locally led to the purchase of an ex-DTV Yauxhall Chevette in 1981.

Victory first time out and several top five finishes were the result and with upgrading to 2.6 litres, two local championships were the spoils for Pete and co-driver, wife Kath.

In 1985 an Opal Manta was purchased and entered in the BTRDA Championship. Pete's skills as a precision engineer came into force in order to manufacture the correct parts to bring the car up to full specification. Victory on the Dukeries proved Pete's ability as a driver and resulted in a close second place for the overall title, the margin being just one point. However in 1986 the BTRDA title was won at only the second attempt.

Following his move up to the National Rally Championship, Pete was regularly the quickest of the twowheel drive cars, and with the purchase of a Ford Sierra RS Cosworth victory in the Mazda Winter Rally proved Pete was the man to beat.

The 1989 RAC Rally saw Pete finish in overall 19th place, he was however the highest placed privateer. For 1991 a 4-wheel drive Cosworth Sapphire provided Pete with a first time out win on the Dukeries and subject to sufficient sponsorship being forthcoming Pete will be competing in the RAC Rally later in the season.

Despite his heavy business workload and obvious professionalism in his hobby of rallying, Pete enjoys his links with Historic Racing and sees his sponsorship of this meeting as a way of keeping in touch with his earlier sport and as a fitting tribute to his grand-father Alan Doughty who gained great respect from those who knew him and was a regular at Historic Race meetings.
