

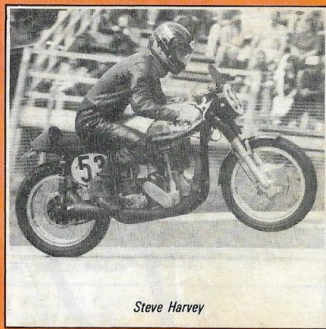

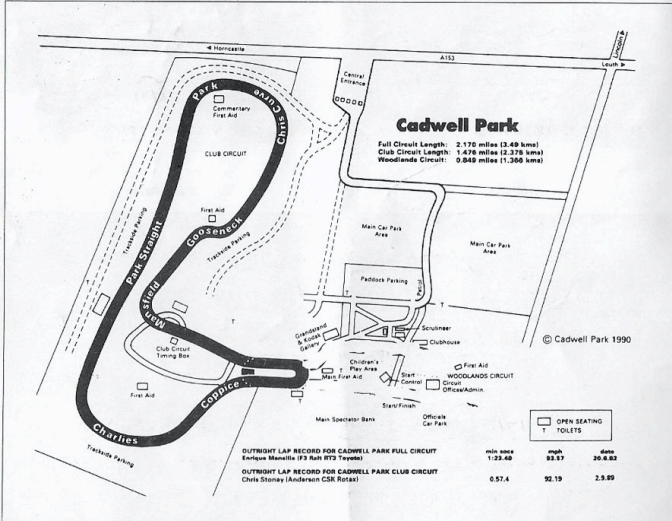

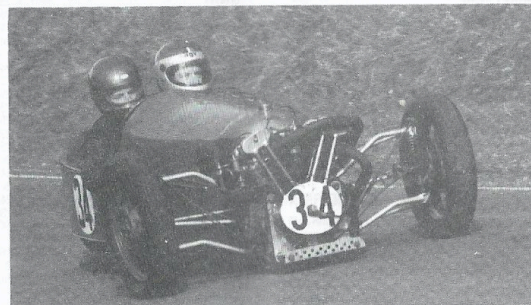

INTRODUCTION

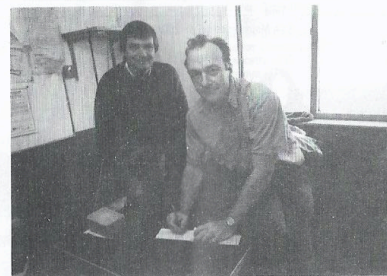
