It is also a condition of admission to any event held under the ACU permit that no part of the meeting can be filmed or video recorded and/or transmitted in any way without the written consent of the promoters/organisers and/or the ACU except for the sole purpose of private enjoyment.

FLAG SIGNALS

These Flags and lights are used to convey information to competitors on the circuit, and when displayed must be obeyed.

- National Flag, or Red and Green lights :** Start of a race.
Green Flag, : At Start signifies the start of warm up lap.
 When racing, indicates end of danger area controlled by YELLOW flags. Overtaking is prohibited until the point has been passed where the GREEN flag is displayed.
- Yellow and Red Striped, :** SHOWN WAVED, indicates Oil, Water or other substance on the track affecting adhesion in that section.
- Blue Flag, :** SHOWN WAVED, indicates the rider is about to be overtaken.
- White Flag, :** SHOWN WAVED, indicates there is a slow moving car or ambulance on the circuit, which will be encountered in the section .
- Yellow with black cross, :** You are about to start your last lap.
Black & white chequered, : Finish of race or practice

These Flags and Lights convey an instruction to competitors on the circuit, which when displayed must be obeyed.

- Red flag or Lights, :** Practice or Race is being interrupted. Riders must slow down and be prepared to STOP. Riders must proceed as directed by Marshals, acting under instructions from the Clerk of the Course.
- Yellow flag, :** DANGER in this section of track.
 SHOWN MOTIONLESS, **Overtaking is forbidden.**
 SHOWN WAVED, danger is more imminent, and riders must slow down and be prepared to stop.
Overtaking or failing to slow down is forbidden.
- Black flag with riders number, :** Displayed at the start line, **the rider must stop** at the pits at the end of the current lap.

The warming up lap is conducted under the Yellow flag displayed Motionless.

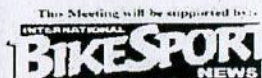

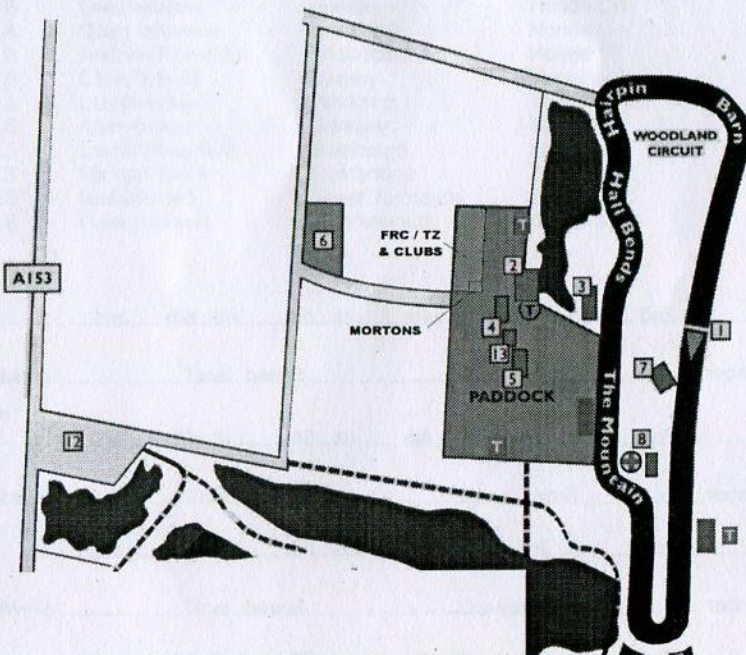
