

Blue/Steady: Another competitor is close. Waved: Another competitor is Black (at individual marshals posts): Race stoped. trying to pass.

White: Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit

Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.

Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.

Yellow with Red Stripes: Slippery surface ahead.

Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared;


Red: Stop recing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by

Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of

mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver, call into pits Black/White rectangular with White number: Warning to driver that his

behaviour (ie corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged. Black displayed with White number: Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.

Black/White Chequered: End of race.



May their wheels forever turn. There is however a fun side, where the taking part is just as important as winning. The camaraderie, the willingness to help each other, the BEER, and barbecues and doing something unusual just for the hell of it, so if this story gives you some amusement, well and good.

Three years ago I was given the chance to again take an active part and after watching solo riders grinding and polishing handlebars and footrest ends, not to mention certain parts of their anatomy, by carefully selecting a nice abrasive piece of tarmac to do it on, I decided it would be wise to use a machine fitted with stabilisers - the good old sidecar. At Mallory Park one weekend I met Paul, who must have had a D.I.Y. Lobotomy kit for Christmas as he actually 'Wanted' to be a passenger! We were in business.

I thought a nice steady ride round with all the other 'old codgers' would be just the job. Hells teeth!, did I get a shock. Every inch of the road is fought over and, when all the road is taken up, battle commences for the grass verge. I found it particularly awe-inspiring to be lapped by people of the calibre of Chris Williams and his mighty Vincent. He must have missed his breakfast that morning as I swear he was eating an apple as he passed me.

Our tyres were so shredded at times, that when chasing Marshals through the shrubbery, they received at least 50 lashes before diving for cover. We cut more grass than a herd of cows could chew, but above all, we had fun and, if you the spectator, who we are especially pleased to see, enjoy watching then give us a wave and if the red mist had not descended, we will wave back.
