Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared;


Red: Stop recing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by

Welcome everyone to Cadwell Park for todays meeting on the full circuit.


I started Vintage 'racing' (the inverted commas are for me) at the beginning of last season, and as a result have been asked to write a few words for today's programme.




