

RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS

Welcome to Cadwell Park for the final round of the Historic Racing Season and judging by the Championship standings we will see some fanlastic racing as riders battle for each championship title. Some of the Championships already show a winner but with others it will down to who crosses the line first.

We held the seventh round at Three Sisters last month and it was not only the case of who won each race but who managed to stay on board their machine and not slide their way down the track. The count was on to see which corner would have the most fallers at the end of the meeting, and we are glad to stay that no one was seriously hurt.

We have started this season picking on people and setting them up in the programme one way or another and the final programme of the year wouldn't be complete without doing just that. CONGRATULATIONS MR AND MRS MARTIN NASH DE VILLIERS. Martin and his fiancee Mary got married the weekend after Three Sisters, but Martin nearly ended up in hospital instead, after falling at Lunar.

PLONKER OF THE MEETING must go out to none other than our Treasurer who sat down drinking his Whisky on Saturday night in the awning after B-B-Cling under an umbrella in the torrential downpour only to find on Sunday morning, when he opened the car door WAIT FOR IT he'd left the sunroof open all night.

With two sets of points left to add to the totals already gained this is how they start the day. In the Tuers Garage Championship No. 190 Ian Bain has already enough points in hand to secure him the title, but No.51 Toby Smedley and newcomer No. 25 Mike Farrall gave him a good run for his money. In the 250cc Championship of Hart McLeod Print Production No.65 Stu Noble is leading from No.100 Andy Hunt and No.97 Ray Hemmings. In the Jim Lidgate Memorial Championship No. 12 Steven Radakovic has a good lead on No.10 Martin Page but with Steven absent today (unless he enters late) will Martin be able to close the gap. The Old Bike Mart Championship also has it's winner sewn up with lan Bain taking the championship again. No 195 Graham Builer will have to settle for second place this year.

The Integrated Control Solutions (I.C.S) sees Graham Buller leading with 191 points and the battle for second place is between Stacey Killworth No.5 and No.168 Phillip Wade. Lee Moore No.2 leads the G B Motor Company Championship with No.1 Plate holder Doug Jones in second place. The Specials class for upto 500cc machines sponsored by TemPer Recruitment Services has Cliff Ransley No.77 at the top of the table with No.40 Nigel Waring and No.11 Ray Moore in second and third place. The over 500cc Specials class has Nigel Waring at the top with No.45 Jim Overbury and No.186 Paul Wade battling for second place.

The Langham Engineering Championship still has the sidecar team of No.41 Steve Harpham and Daniel Toone at the top with No. 63 Dave Hammerton and Neill Bartell in second, Dave and Neill prefered grass tracking to road racing at Three Sisters and put hearts into mouths as they slid their way round Exit Bend. In the Three Wheelers Unlimited to 1972 Championship we have joint leaders between Morgan Owners Bill and Maggie Tuer and Greg Bilby and passenger. Greg normally has Debbie Bain as passenger but she has taken time out mid season to have a baby so congratulations go out to her, in the meantime her sister Katle has volunteered to sit alongside Greg. With them both level on points who will end up the winner, stay around to find out. In third place we have No.14 Ewan Cameron and David Toone in the Halec, Ewan had a nasty incident at Three Sisters last month when he book the Halec headlong into the barriers, he and his passenger emerged virtually unscathed and he has worked hard to rebuild it for the meeting today.

The M.A.N Flying Systems Championship for formula Bantams has No.142 Peter Tibbitts just ahead of No.62 Keith Woods. The Bantam Club have a different way of scoring their championship from the others in the way that their points are totalled according to where they finish in each race and then they deduct their four worst results from the total. Confused, so an I, but the Bantam riders appear to know what they're doing. In the Norvil Motor Cycle Championship for Norvice Riders already has No.177 Martin Owen with a clear lead and therefore the title.

The clubs two premier events of the season which give the riders chance to ride under the No.1 Plate for the season, runs under a handicap scheme based on the rider's times during the day sees the slower riders off the grid first and the more experienced and faster riders going off the grid at the last minute leaving them to plough their way through the field and take the chequered flag. In the Fullist Unperts Sclo Champion of Champions Championship sees No.2 Lee Moore only 13 points ahead of No.190 Ian Bain which means Lee needs three points to hold that precious No.1 for the year 2000. Who will it be I wonder. In the Richard Adams Three-Wheeler Champion of Champions to Championship it looks like reigning No.1 Flate holder Bill Tuer and wife Maggie will retain it for yet another year, but who will finish second? Greg Bibby and Katle Bain, Ewan Cameron and David Toone or Dave Fanthorpe and Laurie Wealt.

Whatever happens today there will be some spectacular racing and stay around for the awards presentation for riders and the annual Marshals draw in the bar and find out which rider this year will receive the GOOSENECK UNDERDOGS AWARD. The presentation will be approximately half an hour after racing finisher.

We would like to take this opportunity of thanking all our sponsors who have supported us through the season, Marshals who have braved weather conditions to stand out there on the cold, wet and windy days and the 90 degree heat wave at the beginning of August and not forgetting you the public for your continued support wherever in the UK you live.






