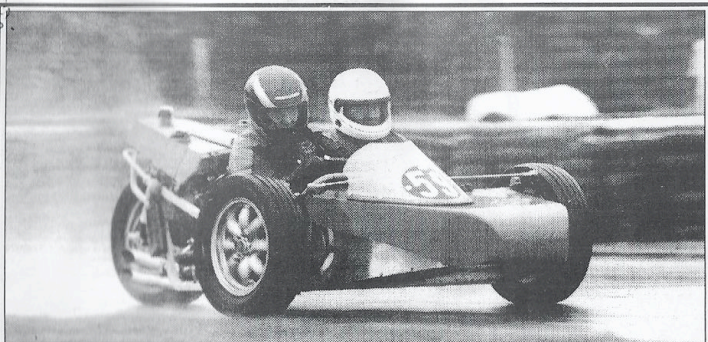
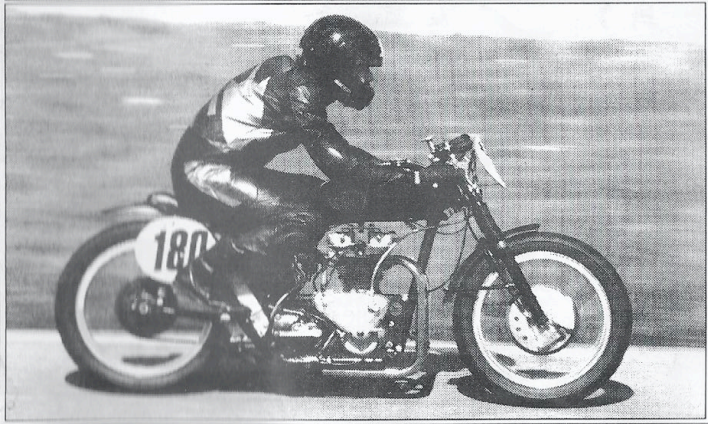

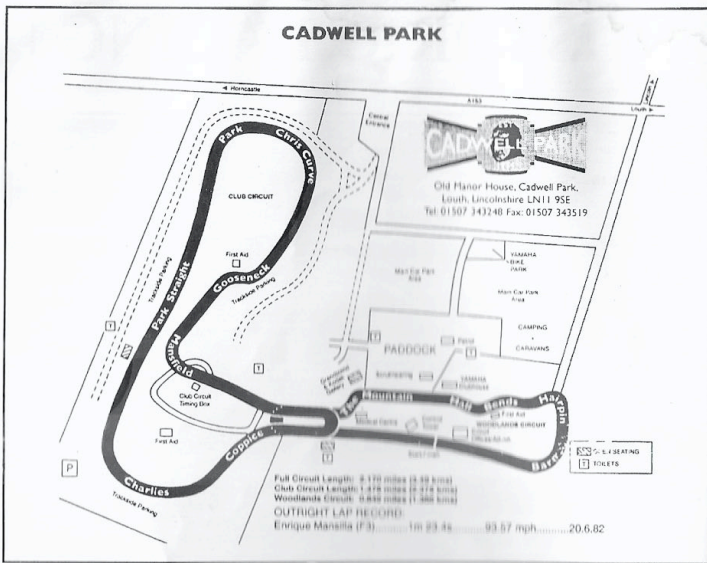

RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS

Welcome to Cadwell Park for the Roger Allen Memorial Meeting which is the final point scoring round of the Historic Racing Season and judging by the Championship standings we will see some fantastic racing as riders battle for each championship title. Some of the Championships already show a winner but some will be down to who crosses the line first.

Our last round was two weeks ago at Three Sisters where rain poured in torrents on Saturday but thankfully stayed dry for most of Sunday, and point gaps closed in some of the championships but other gaps increased. Now with two sets of points left to add to the totals this is how they start the day. In the Tuers Garage Championship No. 51 Toby Smedley has the lead over No.190 Ian Bain but will be enough to secure him the title. Ian Cramp No. 21 and No. 25 Mike Farrall will give a good race as they battle for third and fourth place. In the 250cc Championship No.65 Stu Noble is leading from the rest of his contenders but can No.97 Ray Hemming close the gap, with No.47 Merv Stratford absent from today following a fall at Three Sisters. In the Drury Precision Sheet Metal Championship No. 154 Stu Tonge has a five point lead over No. 30 Mick Hunter, tension will be building up as to who will take that all important chequered flag. Tables are turned in the Old Bike Mart Championship with Ian Bain just ahead of No. 51 Toby Smedley.

The Bennett Associates Championship has the title already sewn up to No. 130 Mark Capewell, No. 138 Mike Kemp and No. 168 Philip Wade will be battling for second place though. In the G B Motor Company Championship No. 197 is at the top of the table with No. 10 Martin Page in second place at the moment but he will have to watch over his shoulder as No.1 Lee Moore will be out there to claw back some vital points.

In the upto 500 cc Specials Class sponsored by Dresda Autos No. 10 Martin Page just has the edge over No. 72 Graham Williams but with two sets of points. The Big Shots Championship for over 500cc Specials has been secured by No.108 John Butcher but that won't stop second place man Lee Moore from giving him a good race.

The Ossie Neal Memorial Championship still has the sidecar team of No. 31 Nick Weston and Kerry Williams with second place holder No. 10 Werner Eckel and Tim Johnson absent from the event with No. 21 Tim Miles and Matthew Francis be able to gain sufficient points to move from third to second place or will it be No.41 Steve Harpham and Daniel Toone putting the pressure on them. In the Consort Limited Championship for sidecar based three wheelers No.95 Nick Saunders and Kay Green collected their first win of the season at Three Sisters, and with their other points gained over the weekend this was enough to put them in the lead but the challenge continues for first, second and third between the leaders, No.11 Dave Fanthorpe and Laurie Weat and No.68 Grahame Alcock and Paul Emmerson. In the Janic Antiques Championship for B3 Cyclecars and Morgans husband and wife team Bill and Maggie Tuer have secured the title already but Nick Weston and Kerry Williams are going to try and close the gap on Greg Bibby and Paula Heaney. Will they be able to manage it I wonder?

The M.A.N Flying Systems Championship for Formula Bantams has No.33 Mike Powell at the top of it's championship with No.88 Martin Nash De Villiers in second place, the battle for third place. In the Norvil Motor Cycle Company Championship for Novice Riders has nine points separating the top five riders. As this is a handicap race where the faster riders start from the back of the grid and will have to work their way to the front it will be interesting to watch to see who will take the flag to clinch this championship, will it be No. 41 William Free who is currently at the top or any one of the top ten riders (the points are really that close).

The clubs two premier events of the season which give the riders a chance to ride under the No.1 Plate for the following season, runs under a handicap scheme, based on the rider's times during the day which sees the slower riders off the grid first and the more experienced and faster riders going off the grid at the last minute, leaving them to plough their way through the field and hopefully take the chequered flag. In the Partnership Recruitment Partnership Solo Champion of Champions Championship has BSA Bantam rider No.33 Mike Powell not only at the top of the championship but with enough points to have secured the No.1 Plate for the 2002 season. In the Bonham & Brooks Three-Wheeler Champion of Champions Championship No.1 Bill and Maggie Tuer have also secured the title and will take back the No.1 plate for next season from Greg Bibby and Paula Heaney. But none the less, even though these two championships are already sewn up each competitor will still go out and give it their all to make the races as spectacular as they can.

Wherever you choose to watch from and whatever happens out there today, I am sure you will see some spectacular racing, please stay around afterwards for the awards presentation for the riders in the bar and find out which rider this year will receive the GOOSENECK MARSHALS UNDERDOG AWARD. The presentation will be approximately half an hour after racing finishes.

I will take this opportunity of thanking the riders who do not get a mention in our write ups. The ones that may have only started this season or those who have raced for more years than they want to remember. The ones that have their own battles for eleventh and twelfth places that don't even qualify for an award. They continue to turn up, ride in all types of weather what come may and sometimes go home wondering why they bother but they are not forgotten because without them, there would not be many for our leaders to contend with.

We would like to take this opportunity of thanking all our sponsors who have supported us throughout the season, Marshals who have braved weather conditions to stand out there on the cold, wet and windy days, and not forgetting you the public for your continued support wherever in the UK you live.
