There will be a presentation of awards in the clubhouse bar on both Saturday and Sunday evenings approximately 30 minutes after the completion of the last race.

Welcome to Cadwell Park and the second meeting of the 1992 Historic Racing season. A cracking pace was set at the first meeting at Mallory and the racing this weekend is certain to be just as sensational. As you will see, it's quite a packed programme with Saturdays racing featuring TWO Manx Norton races, sponsored by Summerfield Engineering.

Our main sponsor for the meeting is Richard Whittle of Highbury Manufacturing Company (who make naughty underwear). We do try to keep our sponsors happy, so if you see riders with frilly knickers on their heads don't be alarmed, they're not all completely mad, it's just one of Richards ideas.

In the Langham Engineering Sidecar Championship Nick Weston and Mick Scott on the white Triumph (31) are driving the outfit even more furiously than ever, but Andy Molnar and Kim Wilkinson (25) are equally determined to hold onto the Championship. There's going to be some epic battles between these two outfits, with George and Sue Darbyshire (37) ready to take advantage of any mistake, along with sponsor Robin Williamson (55), who had a nasty prang at Mallory. Luckily neither Robin or passenger Nick Houghton were injured, but the Manx Norton outfit was unintentionally converted to a solo. Hopefully they'll have it back together in time for this weekend as Cadwell circuit should ideally suit the big single. You can't fail to miss them, dressed in classic black leathers and helmets on a black machine.

The Sotheby's 350 Championship is always closely contested. Relative newcomer Mark Walker (7) will be giving Doug Jones (31), last years champion, something new to worry about, as well as the challenge from both David and Alan Witt, Phil Jobborn and Dean Mitchell. Mark is also up in the top five in the R.F. Witt & Sons 250 Championship, again on an Enfield, and just might have Mervyn Stratford worried also. Chris Plant (168) made a tremendous impression in his first year of Historic Racing in 1990. Riding a 750 Norton and still wearing an orange novice vest, he scored many victories against other more experienced riders, including Doug Jones and Steve Radakovic. Unfortunately, an accident sidelined him for most of 1991 so it's good to see him back again this year. Chris will be racing in the Bartool Engineering Unlimited Championship.

The revised format of the Champion of Champions Race, sponsored by Penrite Oil, is proving very successful with the smaller capacity bikes now having a better chance of taking the win. Mervyn Stratford (47) looked certain to take victory in Round One until a front tyre puncture put him on the grass. Mervyn will be determined to be first over the line on his unbelievably quick 250 Rudge; look out for some really close action in this race, especially on the last lap. Dean Mitchell (68) is currently leading this championship on his 350 Gold Star.

Dean is also contesting the W.E. Wassell 500 Championship against current leader David Witt (8) and Doug Jones, but look out for Tim Barnes (51), former champion Steve Harvey (3) and Richard Adams (170). Mustn't forget John Greenwood who can be very quick indeed.

Stu Rogers (122) often gets away last from the start line, but watch the way he rips through the field to take second or third place! Elaine Drury, Colin Blowers' passenger on the Ariel outfit (41) promised to put on more weight this year to try and keep the third wheel down. You can see how successful she's been this weekend, especially at Mansfield and Coppice. And look out for Liz May and Sue Watson on another Ariel outfit; they only started racing last year and are improving by leaps and bounds.

So you see ladies, there is an alternative to being dragged along to these race meetings; get out there and beat the men at their own game!

Have a good weekend, and look out for the Penrite Oil representatives in the paddock, you'll think twice about putting any other oil in your bike!
