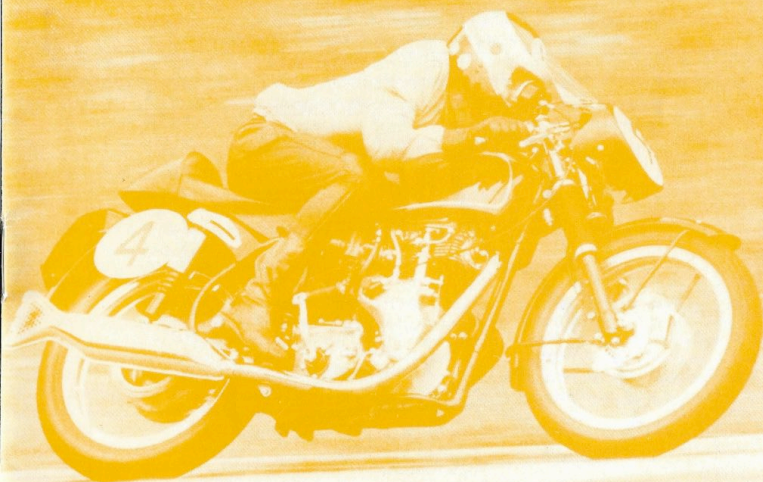

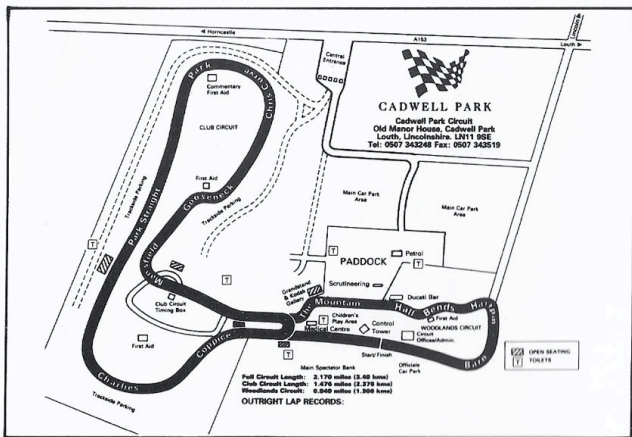

VELOCETTE OWNERS CLUB DAY AT CADWELL PARK

Welcome to our traditional annual race day and get-together of Velocette fans and motorcycle enthusiasts of all persuasions!

This year sees a slightly new format, with several races modelled on the Historic Racing Classes that will follow our meeting tomorrow. The aim is to attract the top riders from Sunday's Historic Race meeting, giving close, exciting, top-quality racing. The talent of the leading riders matches that of any other national class of bike racing, though their experience usually means thankfully fewer 'incidents'. Older bike racers have learnt to find the limit from below rather than from above! (.....famous last words.) Our meeting is a favourite with many of these riders because the races are almost twice as long as usual. This suits a skilled rider who may have had trouble coaxing his temperamental steed into life in a 'push-start' - they have the chance to cut through the field and take their rightful place at the front before the chequered flag drops. At least that's the way they seem to see it!

We still have one 'High Speed Trial', which starts the meeting. In this race, the riders are competing for 1st or 2nd class awards which require them to complete a certain number of laps within the 20 minutes of the trial. The number of laps for a First class award is a real challenge, requiring a sustained lap time that could well win a place amongst the leaders in a straight race! For example, a 500cc machine would have to average better than 1 minute 20 seconds a lap.

The EA Lavington Memorial Race, Event 8, is for Velocettes only and it commemorates the popular Velocette racer who did so much for the Velocette Club.

Another highlight is Event 14, the Gold Star versus Velocette challenge; which is never a walk over for either of these great marques, and along with the Arthur Lavington it is probably the most fiercely contested of the afternoon.

At the other end of the scale is the Circuit Tour for Road-worthy Velocettes, which will take place just after the lunch break. It is not a race, rather a chance to see several generations of Velocettes motoring steadily around the circuit, giving us all a feel for the strong affection that keeps our club so healthy.

Please do have a closer look at all the bikes in the paddock, and a chat with their riders.

The Velocette Owners Club has over a thousand members, and organises many social events throughout the year, mainly through its 22 British Isles Centres. Members receive copies of the club magazine 'Fishtail' throughout the year detailing the club's activities and also benefit from a 'Spares Scheme', which has the objective to assist the owners of Velocette models, old and not so old, to keep their machines on the road or race track.
