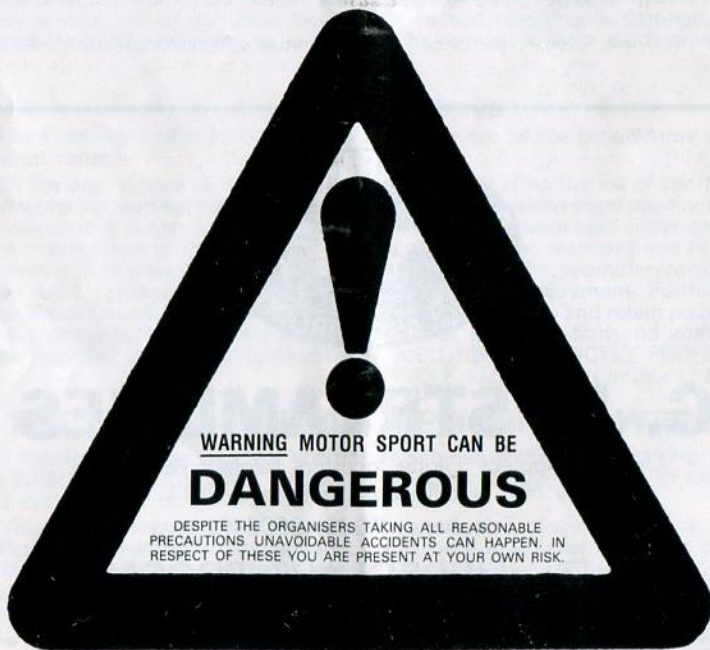
## Spectator Notices

## ATTENTION ALL COMPETITORS

Did you know that from the start of this season, "Ducting Tape" can no longer be used for the temporary repair of Racing Leathers?

Therefore even a simple "Get-Off" which rips your leathers could result in your withdrawal from the Meeting even if your bike is O.K.

We are pleased to welcome to our Meeting today STEVE ANDERSON, of A.M. Leathers, Barnard Castle, Co. Durham. Steve started a Paddock Repair Service for damaged leathers last year and was very well received. He will be available today (and at tomorrow's Waterloo Club Meeting) should you need your leathers repairing in a hurry. His prices are very reasonable! Steve has a facility for Sew-On Badges and Logos in the Paddock as well. He also sponsors the Sidecar Team of Steve Hickman & Peter Wilson (No. 10 today).

## FLAG SIGNALS

**Red:** When shown at marshal's points around the circuit all riders must immediately cease racing and return with extreme caution to the Start/Finish line.

**Yellow (motionless):** Great danger in section of track ahead, slow down, proceed with caution.

**Yellow (waved):** Danger in section of track ahead; take care, no overtaking, maintain positions until clear of section displaying yellow flag.

**Green:** Course clear. Used on marshals' posts to indicate their position to riders on first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been shown to indicate circuit now clear ahead.

**Black:** Accompanied by rider's number on separate board. That rider to stop in pits next time round. Always shown at start/finish line on special instructions from Clerk of the Course.

**Yellow with Red Stripes:** Oil flag. Displayed when oil has been dropped on the circuit in that section, displayed until the hazard has been dealt with. Also denotes slippery surface ahead.

**White:** Ambulance or course car on circuit.

**Yellow with Black Cross:** Denotes start of last lap.

**Black/White Chequered:** Denotes finish of race. Usually waved at the winner and held motionless until every other rider has passed.

*N.B.: Races at all Brands Hatch Circuits are started using a system of red and green lights.*
