




RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS

Welcome to Cadwell Park for the Roger Allen Memorial Meeting which is the final point scoring round of the Historic Racing Season and judging by the Championship standings we will see some fantastic racing as riders battle for each championship title. Some of the Championships already show a winner but most of the championships will be down to who crosses the line first. We have never had the championships as close for quite a few years.

We held the sixth round at Three Sisters only two weeks ago and would like to take this opportunity of thanking all Marshals, Medics, Officials and especially the Riders who despite the fuel shortage still made the trek up north to the circuit near Wigan for what turned out to be an excellent meeting. We were only sorry that an oil spillage and some heavy rain spoilt the last hour of the day.

With two sets of points left to add to the totals already gained this is how they start the day. In the Tuers Garage Championship No.190 Ian Bain has already enough points in hand to secure him the title, but No.51 Toby Smedley, Ian Cramp No. 215 and No. 25 Mike Farrall will give a good race as they battle for second, hind and fourth place. In the 250cc Championship of Hart McLeod Print Production No.65 Stu Nobels is leading from the rest of his contenders can No.100 Andy Hunt and No.97 Ray Hemming close the gap? In the TemPer Recruitment Services Ltd Championship all is level between No. 154 Stu Tonge and No.10 Martin Page, tension will be building up as to who will take that all important chequered flag. The Old Bike Mart Championship has it's winner seven up with Ian Bain taking the championship yet again, Second place is currently being held by No. 25 Mike Farrall with No. 51 Toby Smedley only eight points behind him.

The Integrated Control Solutions (LC.S) sees No. 108 John Butcher leading with the battle going on between No. 130 Mark Capewell, No. 138 Mike Kemp and No. 168 Phillip Wade. We hope Mark has recovered enough from his fall two weeks ago and managed to repair his broken yokes in order to finish the season. In the G B Motor Company Championship No. I Plate holder Lee Moore has increased his lead sufficiently to stop No.170 Richard Adams from knocking him off top slot but he will have to watch over his shoulder as No.154 will be looking to take second place if he can.

In the upto 500 cc Specials Class sponsored by Dresda Autos No. 77 Cliff Ransley may have the edge on No. 170 Richard Adams as he was not at Three Sisters, this enabled Cliff to close the gap on him. Will Richard be able to get the better of him or will Cliff take the title again. The over 500cc Specials has been secured by No. 108 John Butcher but that won't stop second place man Graham Williams No. 72 from giving him a good race.

The Ossie Neal Memorial Championship still has the sidecar learn of No.41 Steve Harpham and Daniel Toone at the top with No. 50 Andy and Yvonne Hunt only 13 points behind them but they will have No. 63 Dave Hammerton and Neill Bartell and No. 31 Nick Weston and Kerry Williams putting the pressure on them. In the Consort Limited Championship for sidecar based three wheelers No. 49, father and daughter team, Martin and Harriet Shosn have collected enough points to clinch the title but the challenge remains for second and third. Who will lit be No. 68 Grahame Alcock and Paul Emmerson or No. 11 Dave Fanthorpe and Laurie Wealt, these two teams are only one point apart. The Big Shots Championship for B3 Cyclecars and Morgans will also depend on who can get to the line first with just three points separating the top three

The M.A.N Flying Systems Championship for Formula Bantams has No.33 Mike Powell at the top of it's championship with No.88 Martin Nash De Villiers in second plaze, the battle for third is between Mick Nash De Villiers and Ian Scutt. The Bantam Club have a different way of scoring their championship from the others in the way that their points are totalled according to where they finish in each race and then they drop their four worst placed results from the total. Confused, so am. I, but the Bantam riders appear to know how it works. In the Novil Molor Cycle Company Championship for Novice Riders has No.72 Graham Williams with a 10 point lead over No. 131 Daniel Toone but as this is a handicap race they start from the back of the grid and will have to work their way to the front. Will they manage to get there though? It will be interesting to watch.

The clubs two premier events of the season which give the riders a chance to ride under the No.1 Plate for the following season, runs under a handicap scheme, based on the rider's times during the day which sees the slower riders of the grid first and the more experienced and faster riders going off the grid at the stamulate, leaving them to plough their way through the field and hopefully take the chequered flag. In the Pertemps Recruitment Partnership Solo Champion of Champions Championship sees regining champion No.1 Lee Moore only five points ahead of No.9 Tim Jackson which means Lee needs to be careful out there to keep that preclous No.1 plate for the year 2001. Who will it be I wonder. In the Brooks Auctioneers Three-Wheeler Champion of Champions Championship only ten points separate the top four places and there is only one point between No.46 Greg Bibby and Kate Bain and No.1 Bill and Maggie Tuer.

Wherever you choose to watch from and whatever happens out there today, I am sure you will see some spectacular racing, please stay around afterwards for the awards presentation for the riders in the bar and find out which rider this year will receive the GOOSENECK MARSHALS UNDERDOG AWARD. The presentation will be approximately half an hour after racing finishes.

We would like to take this opportunity of thanking all our sponsors who have supported us throughout the season, Marshals who have braved weather conditions to stand out there on the cold, wet and windy days and not forgetting you the public for your continued support wherever in the UK you live.
