## WELCOME TO VINTAGE CADWELL!

For the last of the 1971 Season of Motorcycle Races organised by the VMCC there is a record entry and for the first time we have been forced to turn away would-be competitors. This makes us unhappy because motorcycle racing organised by this Club is very much for the benefit of the participants and we hate to deprive our members of that pleasure. Unfortunately 15 races represent about the maximum that it is possible for us to cram into one long afternoon at Charles Wilkinson's splendid miniature T.T. circuit.

However, for those of you lucky enough to be present here as spectators, the programme promises a wonderful afternoon's sport. There has been a decline of entries in the Vintage class (pre 1931) which has been more than compensated by expanding interest in the post-Vintage class (1931-1944). So numerous are the entries in this latter category that we have been able to run individual races for both 250 (Lightweight) and 350 (Junior) classes. That great supporter of our sport (see him in action in the 3-wheeler races) Bert Milnes, has generously donated trophies for both these events which we expect to be hard fought with the two favourites being Mervyn Stratford (250 cc) and Ivan Rhodes (350 cc). The post-vintage class is completed by two potentially very exciting races for machines of unlimited capacity and here the versatile Mick Broom is favourite having dominated senior events on the Geeson Brothers' 498 cc Triumph for the last couple of years.

Charles Thomas, Editor of the Club Bulletin, has generously donated an "Editor's Tankard" for the winner with the fastest race time in the Senior P.V. Scratch Races (5 & 6). There will also be Editor's Tankards for the winner of the Vintage Scratch Race (No. 2) and the 3-Wheeler Race (again for the fastest time in races 7 & 8) with a smaller Tankard for the winner's passenger. The Aotearoa Plate (current holder D. LeCoq) will again be awarded to the winner of the Vintage Handicap Race (No. 11). This strangely named

trophy is the gift of VMCC New Zealand member David Goodman and is the only handicap race award contested today.

Thanks to the sterling support given by our Morgan friends, we have an excellent field for two scratch three-wheeler races where Mick Broom mounted on the instant racer Norton will attempt to stave off the very fast three-wheelers from Malvern driven by Bill Tuer, Gary Caroline and Jim Evans among others. There is usually a visible movement of spectators towards the hairpin for this event particularly if Mick Broom is on good form; using every bit of road and all the grass on each lap.

Vintage motorcycle racing began around the original class for machines made before 1931 and we have a good field today with champions Chris Williams (riding George Silk's very rapid Scott in place of his traditional Clive Waye machine of the same type), Ivan Rhodes on one of his evergreen 350 cc Velocettes and John Wilkinson riding an indecently fast Ariel. Bob Collett is rarely far behind this trio and speeds are generally higher in this class than in the later petrol-only post-vintage category.

Today's racing begins with an event for standard motorcycles in the two categories vintage and post-vintage and this is useful for those who wish to use their roadsters for a little competitive activity. Some of the riders in the post-vintage category will later be seen in the pure racing classes having a good run for their money.

Halfway through today's programme you will be afforded a glimpse of the future in the form of a demonstration run by machines which will form the hard core of our future post-war racing class. As the Club's 25 year date-line moves forward provision will have to be made for those classical motorcycles that appeared during the late 40's of which today's offering is an excellent cross-section. We must emphasise that this is purely a demonstration run although it is possible that some riders will attempt to cross the finishing line ahead of their fellows.
