



Welcome to Cadwell Park for round four of the VMCC Historic Racing season. The Full Circuit is very popular with our riders. The circuit is very demanding and will put to the test riding ability for all riders entered. We also say welcome again to the Morgan Three Wheeler Club who hold their second round of their season with us today.

Well let's have a look how things are now we are half way through the season. The last meeting was at Anglesey in North Wales and there were four sets of points to be gained from the weekend.

In the Tuers Garage Championship Toby Smedley has got a good lead over Ian Bain who has Mervyn Stratford trying to gain vital points to close the gap between them.
