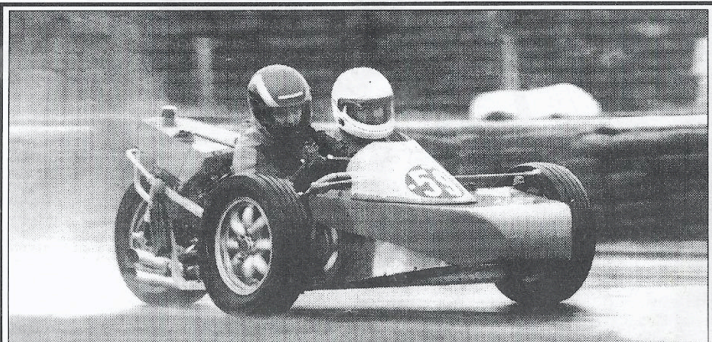
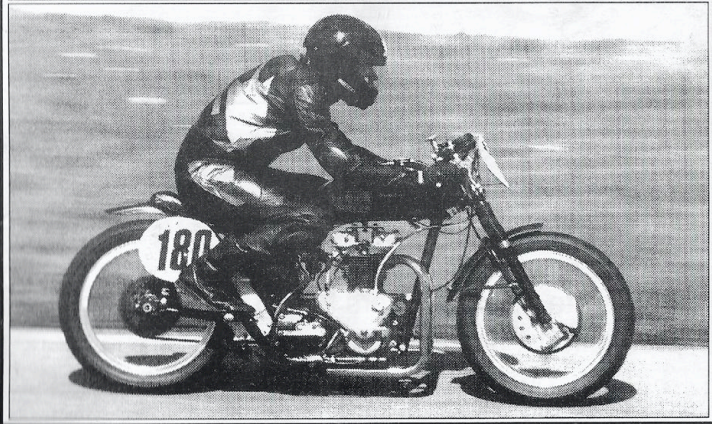

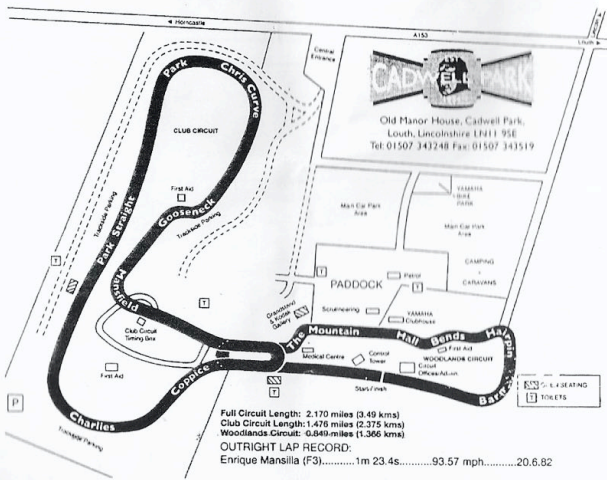

Round 4

Welcome to Cadwell Park for round four of the VMCC Historic Racing season. The Full Circuit is very popular with our riders. The circuit is very demanding and will put to the test riding ability for all riders entered. We also say welcome again to the Morgan Three Wheeler Club who hold their second round of their season with us today.

Well let's have a look how things are now we are half way through the season. The last meeting was at Anglesey in North Wales and there were four sets of points to be gained from the weekend.

In the Tuers Garage Championship Toby Smedley has got a good lead over Ian Bain who has Mervyn Stratford trying to gain vital points to close the gap between them. In the M.A.N Flying Systems Championship for Formula Bantams Mike Powell seems to be heading the championship with Martin Nash De Villiers closing the gap between him and Peter Tibbitts, due to Peter being absent from Anglesey.

In the Old Bike Mart Championship Ian Bain is at the top of the championship with Toby Smedley in second place. In the Bennetts Championship Mark Capewell had a good weekend at Anglesey and has increased his lead over Phillip Wade. In the GB Motor Company Championship Phil Jobborn is just five points ahead of Tim Johnson, so I'm sure he will be out to gain some points there.

The Dresda Autos Championship for under 500 Specials has Martin Page just in the lead from Michael Schofield. In the Big Shots Championship for over 500 Specials Graham Williams has a significant lead over Nigel Waring and Mike Kemp.
