

All too frequently at meetings children are allowed to ride machines in the mistaken belief that because a race paddock is on private property and outside the jurisdiction of the Road Traffic Act no Insurance is necessary, it cannot be stressed too strongly that LIABILITY FOR A SUBSTANTIAL CLAIM COULD REST WITH THE OWNERS OF THE VEHICLE AND THE DRIVER. (or the Parent in the case of a minor).

The Union's Insurers will quite legitimately repudiate any claim on them for damage arising out of the Accident caused by an unauthorised driver.
