






WELCOME

WHO WILL TASTE THE VICTORY SPOILS?

The lead of our Sports and GT championship has resembled a hot potato this year, with two drivers constantly tossing it back and forth. Both really want the mouth watering taste from the big cup but have been unable to keep hold of it along the way.

Today, one of them will get to tuck in, but will the other get his fingers burnt or will they both be happy with their place at the table?

Simon Tilling has already tasted the delights of the title, having devoured it in 2009, but his rival Andrew Shanley has 'only' last year's class A title to his credit. The local scrap dealer will certainly want to go one better in his third year of competition in the category.

Both drive Radical sports racing cars, but the two machines are quite different. Shanley drives the wingless Prosport version once in the hands of Louis Davidson, who

took it to four class and two outright championship titles from 2003 to 2006. The nimble car has been renowned for its reliability and fast starts, somewhat in contrast to the notoriously slow starting Radical SR3 of Tilling.

Whilst the more powerful turbocharged SR3 has won every race it has finished this year, five non scores have allowed Shanley to remain in contention, ironically despite his own absence from the last race due to engine failure in qualifying.

This has put Tilling back into the points lead for this final encounter of 2011, some five ahead of Shanley, with 7 potentially available.

Whilst the odds appear stacked in Tilling's favour, the form this year has shown nothing can be predicted with any certainty, the outcome remaining very much in doubt until the chequered flag is waved.

Also in contention until very recently was Ian Hall. His multiple race and championship winning Darrian Wildcat has been unchallenged in class B this year, but some reliability issues and unfortunate mishaps have limited the V8 machine's scoring potential. With the same no-score record as Tilling, the veteran Hall only has a 3.5 point class lead and is now out of range for the top honours.

SOME BATTLES WON BUT WAR CONTINUES

On the face of it, much has been settled in the circuit's Saloon Car championship where Nick Charles retained his outright title at the last round. The double honour came despite Charles posting his first retirement with his Peugeot 106 GTi, still with almost double the points of his nearest Class B challenger. Slotting into the win was Adrian Slade who now has his MG ZR working well and capable of running in the top ten.

Looking to upset their chances will be Will Di Claudio, last year the only man on the same pace as Charles, with his similar 106. After missing this year's races to concentrate on developing his race preparation business, the former champion is a welcome addition to the last round.

The man who has benefitted from Di Claudio's skills in 2011 is Nick Clark whose Suzuki Swift has been transformed into a front running C Class car. Clark has enough of a lead to make it almost impossible for Russell Poynter-Brown to pick up another title, especially as Will Burns and Charles Hyde-Andrews-Bird are around to steal those valuable points.

Class A has also been settled in favour of Tony Dolley in the Peugeot 206, with enough of a margin over Mark Wyatt in the Astra. That will not stop the likes of Adam Prebble going all out for another win in his powerful Rover Turbo.

Whilst the circuit's outright Formula Ford championship has been settled, there is still plenty left to fight for. With the absence of champion elect, Rob Hall, who took the Swift Cooper to its first home grown outright title with a round to spare, Ben Norton will be favourite to drive off into the distance in the Wiltshire College Spectrum. But behind him will be a titanic battle for Class B, as well as the runner up places.

Adam Higgins and David Vivian are both young chargers who never give up, so sparks will almost certainly fly. Higgins has a useful points advantage with the Van Diemen, putting pressure on Vivian to secure a hat trick of wins to be in with a chance.

Higgins has the added pressure of trying to secure second place in the outright championship. The consistent scoring of Roger Orgee puts him in that position going into this race, with a single point advantage, but Higgins has had a non finish which he can drop, which Orgee, in the Kevin Mills Van Diemen, cannot.

Lurking just behind them is Ed Moore, the 2004 and 2007 champion, who, with a good placing, could steal it from both of them. The Swift Cooper team's Luke Cooper could also muscle in on the action.

END OF YEAR FUN

The last meeting of the year is often when drivers come out to race purely for fun and the annual FF1600 Carnival is just for that.

Amongst those playing is 2009 Castle Combe Saloon Car champion and Fiesta championship front runner, Jason Cooper, having his first single seater outing in the Swift Cooper family run Van Diemen RF89. He will be pitted against many of the circuit's Formula Ford regulars, possibly including his brother Luke, so we shouldn't expect too much, even with his undoubted saloon car speed.

The season end spawns another fun race, the 'Gadget Helpline Classic Alfa v MG Challenge'. Open to mildly modified cars of the same name, the numerically dominant Alfas include the 1600 Giulia Sprint GT of Crispin Thomas, the race's founder.

Staying with the classic theme, cars from the '50's, '60's and '70's engaged in pit stops and driver changes are one of the highlights of the Classic Sports Car Club's Swinging 60s and Classic K Series 40 minute 'enduro'.

Cheltenham's Stephen Bond should have one of the quickest cars in the form of his Lotus Elan 26R, which he will be driving solo, whilst Frome's Andy Vowell usually performs well at his local track in his 1969 Triumph Spitfire. But he will face considerable opposition from Charles Marriott in his rare 1960 Turner MKII, which gives the often race-leading Austin Healey Sprites something to think about.

Rounding off the day and the year is an 'anything goes' race for 'Open Sports and GTs' where we hope to see some of the bigger capacity sports racing cars stretching their legs before their winter rest.





Swinging Sixties

The Swinging Sixites is the oldest of the Classic Sports Car Club's Series and is a 40 minute race for one or two drivers, driving cars from the 1960's on Yokohama 60 profile tyres. Huge support over recent years has meant the Series has been split into two races at CSCC Race Meetings this year but today sees a combined grid.

So who might be the class winners? The smallest cc class, although usually the largest numerically is also one of the closest fought over the years. Charles Marriott must be favourite to take this class after a good third overall at Silverstone a couple of weeks ago, but if it is wet watch the two minis with the Cooper S of the Wagers able to challenge Marriott. In class C, the Triumph TR4 of Roy Chamberlain must dominate after winning overall the first two Races of the year (Snetterton/Brands) but he did have mechanical problems at Mallory in August. Classes D and H should produce the front runners of the race with fibreglass cars dominating! Here the Marcos cars take on the Lotus cars and it will be interesting to see who exactly comes out on top at this lovely Wiltshire Circuit. The Marcos of Ben Gough/lan Daniels had a good 4th at Mallory in August with the Lotus Seven of Gideon Hudson/Josh Sadler just 10 seconds behind at the line and they freely admit they did not have a good pit stop changeover! At Silverstone the Marcos of Nigel Edwards/Myles Castaldini just had the edge over Gough/Daniels though. Watch Stephen Bond in the 26R Elan who may well spring a surprise. In the end it may well be down to who can make the fastest pit stop.

While the Swinging Sixties cars run on Yokohama tyres, the Classic K cars run on the more restrictive Dunlop Historic tyres and are standard production cars.


