1. RACE DISTANCES

All support races will now be run over 6 Laps (11.04 miles), with the exception of race fifteen - 1300cc Open which will be run over 10 Laps (18.40 miles), the winner of this race will be awarded the Castle Combe Silver Cup (1994 winner Vince Nolan), which will be presented at the club's 1996 Dinner and Dance. All other race distances remain as per the programme.

2. LUNCHTIME ACTIVITIES

During the lunch interval (12.00 - 13.15), the current Shell Advance Superclub Championship leaders will be required to take their machines to the startline for interviews etc. Immediately after this there will be a 2 lap parade of ALL competitors, led by a course car and the Superclub Championship leaders. All competitors are requested to participate in this, and should take their machines to the assembly area when called.
