

SATURDAY'S ACTION - RACING MEETS RALLYING

Welcome to our very first combined race meeting and rally stage, with £50m of competition cars, billionaires and ex Formula 1 stars mixing with our best local racing talent.

Tour Britannia has established itself as the UK's premier 'race tour' attracting top drivers and Pre 1981 classic cars from all over the world. This year's tour, a combination of rally special stages, hillclimb, regularity runs and races is based predominantly in the West Country and Wales and on Saturday we host one of the 'stages' and two of the races.

One of the most successful of the 70 strong entry is 1985 Indianapolis winner and ex Tyrrell Formula 1 driver, Danny Sullivan. In a similar car, the former Williams Grand Prix driver Ian Ashley continues to demonstrate his versatility having driven every kind of racing machine from World championship sidecars to Touring cars and Formula Ford in which he competes to this day.



Porsches are not the only exotic machinery you can ogle. A full complement of 'DB' Aston Martins, Shelby Mustang, Jaguar XKs and 'E's and a gorgeous line up of Ferraris will all be taking part.

And it's not just the cars which are exotic. In the 'regularity' section are at least six titled individuals. Driving a Ferrari Daytona is Count Alexandre de Lesseps, the great-great-great grandson of Ferdinand de Lesseps, the builder of the Suez canal, who also presented the Statue of Liberty to America.

Driving a Mercedes-Benz 220B Cabriolet is Count Joachim von Finckenstein with Countess Christina von Finckenstein.

Lord Irvine Laidlaw, one of the wealthiest people in the UK according to the Sunday Times 'Rich List', drives a Ferrari 250 GTO, whilst his wife Lady Christine Laidlaw has a Ferrari 275 GTB/C.

Billionaire Sir Michael Kadoorie, the utilities magnate and 6th wealthiest person in Hong Kong drives a Ferrari 250GT.

Closer to home, Dave Smithies from Flax Bourton, pairs up with fellow Bristolian and Austin Healey racer Eric Woolley in a BDA engined Mk1 Escort. The Escort was a winning car when the 'Tour of Britain' visited us in the 1970s. Roger Clark, the overall winner of the 1974 event,



won one of four races here in July of that year and Ari Vatanen did the same in 1976.

For a touch of variety we also have a round of the SuperPro VAG Trophy, a championship catering for two wheel drive machines from the Volkswagen, Audi, SEAT and Skoda stables.

SUNDAY'S ACTION - HIGGINS HOLDS 'EM OFF

It's been a cracking season so far for the circuit's own three championships for saloon cars, sports and GTs and Formula Fords, which will be providing the bulk of the action today.

Still holding off his more sophisticated opposition in the Castle Combe Formula Ford 1600 championship is Adam Higgins. He has a 9 point overall lead with his ancient B class RF90 Van Diemen with another B class driver, Nathan Ward in the locally built Swift Cooper, heading a tightly

packed bunch of drivers all looking to depose him. Last round winner Rob Hall in the Swift SC10 is certainly one of them.

Within range are the Kevin Mills Racing team mates, Steven Jensen in the Spectrum 011 and Roger Orgee in the Van Diemen RF00.

Amongst those praying for rain will be 18 year old Luke Cooper, part of the Swift Cooper team based next door to us here. His 4th place in his SC92 at the last wet meeting puts him 3rd in class behind Higgins and Ward and a useful 11 points clear of David Vivian in the similar Wiltshire College run Swift.



Not having the season they would have liked so far, but not to be discounted, are Ed Moore and Andrew Jones in the Rays and Marcus Allen in the Wiltshire College Spectrum.



Also doing a rain dance will be Mark Funnell who shocked everyone with his race pace last time in the circuit's Saloon Car championship. The reigning Sports and GT champion put his ability well beyond doubt, having take his relatively standard Mini Cooper to an absolutely dominant outright victory, leaving his A class rivals floundering in his wake.

Another potential 'giant killer' is Simon Norris who put his standard D class Honda Integra on pole, only to be denied a decent finish by an errant back-marker.

Deserving of his 'Driver of the Day' award last

time was Nick Clark in his tiny C class Suzuki Swift which started and finished 3rd and therefore now heads the overall points table jointly with the almost similarly named Nick Charles in the B class Peugeot 106.

David Kift has his 106 very close to Charles and is a big threat just one point behind, whilst Clark's nemesis is Will Burns in the Fiesta.

If it's dry, the class A drivers looking to win the National Mobile Windscreens 40th Anniversary Trophy will be Tony Dolley in the 206 and Mark Wyatt in the Astra, whilst on the pace in all conditions is Tony Hutchings in the Audi TT.


Darcy Smith took advantage of the treacherous conditions last time to take his first win in the


Bath drivers Guy Parr in the Nemesis RME98 and Des Andrews in the MegaHart 001 are both run by the Wayne Poole Racing team.



Flag Signals



Union Flag or Lights:

Used to start all races in the United Kingdom.

Yellow Flag:

Signifies danger, Drivers must slow down and not overtake. When waved, signifies even greater danger and drivers must be prepared to stop.

Yellow and Red Flag:

Oil on course. When waved, signifies oil slick is particularly hazardous.

Green Flag:

Danger area passed, overtaking permitted.

Black Flag: Accompanied by competition number of car concerned, instructs driver to call at his pit at the end of the lap.

Black Flag with Orange Spot: Indicates to driver whose number is shown that there is a mechanical defect with his car. He must visit



Black and White Diagonal Flag:

Last warning to the driver whose number is shown that for reasons of unsportsman like behaviour, he will be "black flagged" for further misbehaviour.

Blue Flag:

Driver warned he is being followed closely. When waved, indicates driver behind is trying to overtake.

White Flan:

Signifies service vehicle is on course.



Red Flag:

Used under instructions from the Clerk of the Course, warns all drivers to stop immediately.

Chequered Flag:

Signifies end of race.
