





FLAG SIGNALS: The flag signals to be used are as follows:—

UNION JACK—Start. RED—Stop, all drivers.


BLACK WITH DRIVER'S NUMBER—That driver to stop.

YELLOW—Danger, drive slowly. BLACK AND WHITE CHEQUERED—Finish.

DETERMINATION OF RESULTS: No driver will be allowed to start another lap after the first driver has crossed the finishing line. Thereafter every driver crossing the finishing line within five minutes of the winner will be flagged off, and the position of these drivers determined according to the number of laps completed, and for those drivers completing the same number of laps, by the order in which they do so.

Who's Who!

Dealing with the solo entry first, Mike Hailwood—the young engineer apprentice from Oxford who won all four solo A.C.U. Road Racing Stars in 1959—has entered four machines. They are a Ducati for the 125 c.c. class a Mondial for the 250 c.c., an A.J.S. for the Junior and a Norton for the Senior. Another favourite of the Castle Combe spectators who is joint holder with John Surtees of the 350 c.c. lap record is Derek Minter, he will be riding Nortons in both the Junior Race and the Senior Race. Riding similar machines in the same two races is Tony Godfrey, who at the July meeting last year equalled the track record when he put in a lap at a speed of 85.79 m.p.h.

Honoured by being awarded the Pinhard Prize in 1959, third in the 1959 350 Clubman's Race and co-winner with Mike Hailwood of the 1958 Thruxton Nine Hour Race, Dan Shorey—from Banbury—will be another rider having a busy day riding a Ducati in the 125 c.c. class, an N.S.U. in the 250, and Nortons in both the Junior and Senior Races. John Holder, who is a motor cycle fitter and comes from Sidcup, rides an A.J.S. in the Junior and a G50 Matchless in the Senior, he won the Senior Clubman's Race last year to add to his successes. A rider who up to last year was better known in trials and scrambles and who created a sensation when making his road racing debut in finishing second in the Manx Grand Prix—Ron Langston—will be riding an A.J.S. in the Junior Race and a G50 in the Senior Race.

From Birmingham comes Bill Siddle who started his racing career at Castle Combe in 1957. He rides a Taylor-Dow special, basically a Gold Star B.S.A., in the 500 c.c. Non-Experts Race and a Norton in the Junior. As a matter of interest he came second in the 350 Non-Experts Race here in April last year and won the same class in July putting in the fastest lap in both races. Well-known 125 c.c. exponent riding an E.M.C. is Jim Baughn who has some six years of experience in this class. F. A. Rutherford, from East Ham, is another well-known rider bringing a brace of machines. He has an A.J.S. for the Junior Race and a Norton for the Senior and among his other successes he finished in fourth place in the Manx Grand Prix last year.

Phil Read, a Luton man, rides Nortons in both Junior and Senior Races, he won his heat here last July in the Junior Race and came third in the final. Another regular is B. E. P. McEntee, he finished third in his heat and third in the final in April last year and seventh in his heat and seventh in the final in July.

West Country riders include Gordon Allin from Bath, G. A. Bonney, L. S. Froud, J. A. Watts and D. Comley from Swindon, J. Amos, Vernon Cottle, J. A. Cross, J. W. Goodwin, E. L. Griffiths, C. E. Duggan, P. Hazell, M. Hewlett, Les Iles, R. H. H. James, George Todd, A. D. Williams and P. F. Wood—all from Bristol, Roy Farr from Chippenham, L. Dando from Norton St. Philip, J. Denton from Clevedon, R. J. Difazio from Frome, J. E. Kidson from Stroud and H. W. Rayner from Bridgwater.

So great was the response from the sidecar drivers that their scratch race will be run in two heats and a final, this is in addition to the usual handicap race.

Prominent in the entries are P. V. Harris and Ray Campbell with their B.M.W.—“Pip” retained the sidecar A.C.U. Road Racing Star last year. Opposing him are Bill Boddice and his new passenger G. Stokes with their Norton, Bob Robinson and L. P. Young with their Vincent—Bob has held the sidecar lap record at Castle Combe since April, 1957, Pat Millard/G. Spence (Norton), E. Pickup/J. Biggs (B.M.W.), Terry Folwell/P. Knocker (Norton), E. T. Young/J. McAuliffe (ETY/Vincent), Jack Difazio/A. Mustard (B.S.A.) and many others.

Apart from Jack Difazio, who of course is the well-known Frome motor cycle dealer, there are two local drivers—T. Clark from Bristol and N. H. Lewis from Bath—the latter making his road racing debut.
