



WHEN ONE POINT MAKES ALL THE DIFFERENCE

It's the time when Castle Combe's three championships have to be decided and just like last year, our Formula Fords go down to the wire, with Steven Jensen facing a difficult, but not impossible, task.

This time, it's Adam Higgins with the points advantage, having taken the last 4 wins in his family run Van Diemen. In theory, the task for Higgins is simple. He needs to score one point to deny Jensen the title, regardless of where his rival finishes. But even that seemingly straightforward achievement cannot be taken for

granted, with an infinite number of things which could go wrong. Jensen on the other hand has only one goal - he must win the race and clock fastest lap, hoping Higgins fails to score.

The problem for both is the other drivers equally hungry to win and well aware neither Jensen nor Higgins can afford a 'DNF'. Even within Jensen's own 'Kevin Mills Racing' team there is considerable pressure, as Jensen's current points disadvantage is partly as a result of the coming together with his team mate, Ashley Crossey, at the last round. Roger Orgee is another in the same garage, as determined as anyone to take those victory points. Additionally, a resurgent Ed Moore will be keen to add to his last round win.

Class B has already been decided in favour of Nathan Ward, despite a strong challenge from Richard Higgins, another of the Higgins family clan. Able to beat both and everyone else if it rains, is Luke Cooper in the Swift SC10.

Class C is also as close as it gets, with lain Houston and Stephen Bracegirdle level on points, but the former with two extra fastest laps.

Many of those drivers will also appear in the traditional end of season 'Carnival' race, with the addition of the likes of Olly White in the Van Diemen 2001. And yet more Formula Ford action comes from the Keyline pre' 1982 Classic championship.

There are a host of interesting points permutations for the Sports and GT championship.

Josh Smith, in his Radical PR6, has the possibility to take the title from Perry Waddams in the class D TVR, though if both win their respective classes, then Waddams will be champion. If Waddams fails to score, then Smith needs at least a 4th in class to take the title, whilst if Smith wins and gets the point for fastest lap, then Waddams either has to win or take second and fastest class lap.

Making this all the more difficult for Smith will be Andrew Shanley, likely to be very fast in his Radical Prosport.

Like last year, Will Di Claudio is already champion elect of the Castle Combe Saloon Car championship, but will still be looking to beat everyone in his class B Peugeot 106.

Perry Waddams has one hand on the trophy.

The main battle is for class B honours, with Mark Wyatt in the Astra and Tony Dollev in the Peugeot 206. level on points. With only 8 rounds counting, Wyatt has the potential to score a maximum of 77 points, whilst Dolley can only reach 72, so the latter must outscore the former by at least 6 points to take the title.

Others likely to be at the fiercer end of the grid include Rob Ballard in the SEAT Leon and Charles Hyde-Andrews-Bird in his Dad's Renault Megane, having already won class D. Bird senior will drive the car in the 'Open Sports v Saloon' race which rounds off the day, joined by a number of others from our 'home' championships as well as two of the Nissan Playstation GT Academy 370Zs.

The Quaife Intermarque championship brings something different, catering as it does for 'Silhouette' saloon and kit cars. On its last visit here, Nick Williamson was strong in his Escort Cosworth.

If you're a fan of the 'E30' type BMW, then there are plenty to see in the two 'Project 8 Production BMW' championship races. For the driver, the accent is on value for money, hence its popularity and huge grids.

And if today doesn't provide enough of a motor sport fix for you, then come along for tomorrow's 'Carole Nash Insurance and Bristol Forklifts Autumn Classic' which rounds off our 2013 season with a day of pure nostalgia.

Castle Combe Formula Ford 1600 Championship

The Castle Combe Formula Ford 1600 Championship is for competitors driving 1600cc Ford 'Kent' engined Single Seater Racing cars which comply with current Formula Ford 1600 regulations issued by the Ford Motor Company. Cars are split into four classes according to their age.

The Championship also includes a Karting Graduate Challenge for competitors who were under 21 years of age on 1st January 2013, had previously competed in Karting events, and are now undertaking their first single-seater championship/series.

Overall finishing position - 1st 12, 2nd 9, 3rd 8, 4th 7, 5th 6, 6th 5, 7th 4, 8th 3, 9th 2, 10th (plus 1 point for fastest lap)



Having already lost its saviour earlier this year, with the death of Howard Strawford, the circuit has to bear another loss in around a month's time. with the retirement of another 'fixture', its long serving Sales and Marketing Director, Rodney Gooch.

Rodney began his career with Castle Combe on a part time basis, back in 1991, after a distinguished motor sport related career with Aerosigns and Brands Hatch circuit. By 1995, he had become indispensable to Howard Strawford and took the plunge to move here from Kent, where he has been ever since.

Over the last 22+ years, Rodney has been an integral part of the growth and transformation of the circuit, his job title belving his imagination, hard work and passion in all areas of the circuit's activity.

Of all his many achievements, perhaps his proudest will be his instigation and organisation of the Superbike Grand National meeting in 2004, perhaps the biggest event in the circuit's history, attracting more than 30,000 people over that September weekend.

Always a motorcycle man at heart, Rodney was a talented and well regarded racer in his own right in the 1960's and 70's and competed regularly at Castle Combe, finishing 3rd behind Barry Sheene in the ACU British championship meeting here in 1970.

So at his last race weekend (on the 'organisers' side of the fence anyway!), everyone at Castle Combe wishes Rodney a well deserved retirement, enjoying life with Janet, Jess and Daniel.
