



The stage is set for a superb final round of the North Glos Club's championship. The venue, Castle Combe, is the West Country's top motor sports circuit which during its history has seen all the greats of British motor cycle racing. Geoff Duke, Mike Hailwood, Phil Read and Barry Sheene to name just a few.

In recent years the North Glos club has produced many good riders, and it is interesting to look back to 1982 when Roger Burnett won his first Castle Combe race. He now rides for the 'Rothmans Honda' works Grand Prix team. The man who finished runner-up in the championship to him now rides works Formula One machinery for Yamaha and that's Trevor Nation.

At this meeting many riders undoubtedly have the ability to follow in their illustrious foot-steps and only a lack of sponsorship will hold them back.

One of the lucky riders, Tom Hutton, has backing from Save and Prosper. He takes a break from European and British championship events to compete on both 250cc Yamaha and 125cc MBA. The 1986 overall club champion takes on Welshman Gordon Daniels and Bristol pair Chris Lelong and Roger Martin in the 125 and 250 singles event. Roger Martin must be wondering what he has to do to win on his tiny 125cc British BINDY having finished second at each outing but being beaten by a different man on each occasion.

There are four class championships already settled. Romsey's Tom Blackwell has secured the 1000cc Open and 1300cc Fourstroke titles, Braunton's Richard Wright has tied up the 500cc Fourstroke and Minchinhampton rider Robert Prince has the Battle-of-the-Twins under his belt.

Mathematically the overall club championships can still be taken by one of six men, they include the three men above, plus Reading's Mike Hodges and two TT Motorcycles of Bristol backed riders, David Ball and Jon Clayton.

Looking onto the individual classes the 250cc should see a four way clash between Bristolian Tom Hutton, Chippenham's Tim Salveson and Barnstaple's Alex Buckingham who is just one point behind current championship leader, Paul Northcliffe from Reading. Alex prefers the Austrian Rotax power unit to the much more common TZ Yamaha as used by the other top title contenders.

350cc racing has been some of the best of the season and this is reflected in the points table, just 8 points covering the top five riders. Bradford-on-Avon rider Barrie Middleton who makes his return after injury takes on Bath's Mark Farmer on his very quick F2 350cc Yamaha and Londoner Ian Lawton in what promises to be a very competitive event, especially when you consider there are at least half-a-dozen other riders capable of beating any of these men on their day.

The larger capacity classes are being dominated by South Coast rider Tom Blackwell, he leads four classes on his GSX-750R Suzuki. His biggest threat comes from Reading's Michael Hodges on his GP Motorcycle Accessories backed machine and Bristol's Paul Gardiner aboard a TT Motorcycle's FZR 1000 Yamaha. Paul has got the better of Tom on two occasions recently, as has Michael. Tom's nine final victories though shows that he has truly made his mark on this season.

Last year's 500cc fourstroke champion, Calne's Brian Williams makes a rare outing this season on his 500cc Honda. It has been a 25 year ambition of his to ride a winner at Castle Combe, to achieve this he will first have to beat Devon pairing of Richard Wright and hard charging Alex Buckingham and recent Colerne victor John Armstrong.

Sidecars make a return at Castle Combe with Dennis Guppy and Chris Turner from Yelverton heading the line-up. Welshman Roy Lawrence is still doubtful though due to a nasty injury received earlier this year when he broke both ankles, but with a new 'worm' outfit ready to race the Combe record holder at 93.73 mph will be anxious to get back on the grid.




