NG Road Racing Race Report.....

Donington Park - 11th and 12th May

Both riders took wins in Sundays terrible conditions

In a weekend that tested everyone from riders and officials, to marshals and medics as weather conditions swung from perfect and fast to wet and slippery we had all four seasons in one 48-hour period. The suns shone, but we also had hail and freezing rain as well as gusts of wind that lifted awnings in the paddock. There weren't many riders that failed to taste Donigton tarmac or need assistance from the hard working NG / Racesafe marshals as the weather when it turned claimed some of the steadlest and most experienced riders out there.

When the conditions were good though, they were very very good, so good in fact that Josh Day on the WH Bond / Kinch Fuels ZX10 Kawasaki set a new outright NG circuit lap record for Donington's 1.95 mile National track. As Sunday morning saw Josh set the first NG 100mph lap, averaging 100.03mph for a stunning lap as he raced wheel to wheel with National 600 Superstock leader Jordan Simpkin in the **Phoenix Open** final. The previous afternoon in very wet conditions it was Chris Pope on his AFB Motorcycles R1 that set the pace winning by over 10 seconds as he revelled in the wet, as he found it easier than the dry due to tendonitis issues that often rear their ugly head. As Pope stormed (....no pun intended!!) to that wet race win he headed home Josh Day and reigning neither (....nor here!) champ Phil Bevan. Jordan Simpkin had been balked in the early part of the race on his AHR / Go Racing R6 and fought back up to 5th place, setting the fastest lap in doing so.

The willy-Welshman has not won 11 class titles for nothing and knows when to push and when to take points and after two podiums he then decided as most of his rivals had succumbed to the weather that it was now his turn for the big points. As the final open race came to the grid Bevan and Duncan Gibson on his JHP Panigale set about their bid for glory. Bevan led and Gibson stalked, but just as it looked as if Gibson would take up the running he lost 1.5 seconds as the leading duo hit the backmarkers.... Again the canny Bevan put himself in the right place at the right time and grabbed the 25 points for the win. Bevan and Gibson's pace saw them finish over 40 seconds clear of the rest.... proving there in no substitute for experience.

Josh Day and Phil Bevan shared Powerbike honours, but Chris Pope and Duncan Gibson kept them on their toes with a second and a third apiece in a weekend that saw the survival of the fittest. Liam Murtagh was unlucky not to be rewarded with a podium after a great weekend on his Corby ZX10 Kawasaki.....The weather was so bad on Sunday afternoon that only 6 riders finished from the 30 on the original entry list !!!

Wayside Garages 600cc

Be Wiser Kawasaki man Nick Anderson took the 600cc series lead away from Chris Hawkes with two fine rides. A win on Saturday over Sebastian Kelly and the hard charging Bryan Duncanson, followed by third in the very wet race on Sunday behind rain-maestro Peter Carr and Tommy Philp. The talk of the paddock though was Dale Thomas's charge through from the back row after falling in the qualifier. 19 year old Thomas took 14 riders between the start line and Redgate and another 16 before the end of lap one, but by then the leaders had opened up an advantage....but 4th from the back row was nevertheless a stunning spectacle.

125GP / Moto 3

Young Novice rider Mark Strudwick on the MTS Racing RS125 stunned everyone on Saturday by heading home the more experienced Paul Hedison, with the pair separated by just 0.30 seconds at the line. Strudwick, Jake Bayford, Mark Carkeek and Joe Thomas had a race long scrap for the points on Sunday as Hedison's bike fell foul to the wet weather, Although Strudwick's machine was visibly slower in a straight line, his corner speed kept him in the fight. As Carkeek crashed out on the final lap it was left to a drag race to the line for the win, that Bayford on his ABC Carriers RS125 nicked over the impressive novice Strudwick. For his efforts Strudwick now heads the points table.

Steve Lynham Formula 125

Liam Delves took victory in both F125 finals on his Delves Racing 80cc Metrakit.... But he had to fight hard with Jake Archer on the 80 Herbi. The pair were never more that a few bike lengths apart and Delves wins were by 0.47 seconds on Saturday and by just 0.05 on Sunday!!

Fraser's of Gloucester 500cc Open

Keenan Armstrong took a fine set of wins in the 500cc class on his Replicast Aprilia 450 heading home Daniel Williams on Saturday and Josh Owens on Sunday, in a class that saw a huge rate of attrition.... Young Keenan though, kept his head whilst his rivals threw away points in Donington's gravel traps.

GP45

Teenage sensation Keenan Armstrong totally eclipsed the opposition in the GP 45 class on his Replicast RRV450 Aprilia. He really has clicked with the 450 twin this year after having stepped up from the 80 Metrakit, and lapped every other rider in his class..... in both races. In a return to the grids Martin Thrower took two runner-up spots on his immaculate PDQ Precision Aprilia. Series leader Mark Carkeek had been unbeaten until this meeting, but and the wiring loom burned out whilst doing some repairs on his 450..... So no points..... But still the series lead.

A and R Racing Formula 400

Simon Gates brought out his GNG / RB Racing ZXR400 for a run at one of his favourite circuits and promptly took the race win on Saturday over reigning champion Shannon Hale who was having a nightmare weekend with a series of mechanical issues on her ZXR. Sunday came and Gates was looking for the double, but on the last lap trying to get the better of Daniel Williams on his super fast Gecko Imports TZR he fell at McLeans. Williams won, with Hale once more second, grabbing more valuable points.

MPH Bikes Mini Twins

Championship leader Kevin Davies was in great form again on the NPMC / UK Aerial Media SV 650 and took a steady win on Saturday over Mark Labudek after lap one leader Justin Garret fell at Coppice. Come Sundays final we were expecting more of the same, but Davies pressing on hard in the latter stages to stave off the hard charging Sean Montgomery succumbed to the wet track and parted company from his SV at McLeans. Montgomery on the Preston Power Steering SV took no second invitation and took the win over Nick Anderson and Garrett, to add to his third place the day before. It was all the sweeter as it was on his second-string bike after the number one SV suffered gearbox problems.

Peter Hammond Motorcycles Sound of Thunder

The timekeepers had to fine tune the electronic systems to go to another decimal place to split Oliver Hill on his Fastline Superbikes / Alpha 675 and Paul Willis on his Willis Developments KTM as they crossed the line together. Hill got the nod after out breaking Willis in the final corner... and there are not many people able to do that. Willis was in no mood for another second spot on Sunday as he took a convincing wet race win over Shane Smith (675) and Byron Beckett (848).

Metzeler and DTR Streetstock

Tom Cook took two fine wins in the 1300cc class on his TPC R1. It looked like Paul Dawson who got pushed out onto the grass on lap one could make up the ground but after doing most of the work he got clattered by a backmarker bending his front brake lever making it unusable for the last two laps. Meanwhile after doing his rain dance in the morning Murray McConnachie was very happy and splashed round in impressive style to take two wins in the 700 class on his Cabot / Bob Harvey 675. In the 400 class it was a familiar story with former BSB 125 rider Corey Lewis and Luke Collins sharing the wins, but with a no score on Sunday for Luke, Corey heads the points table on his KR1S 250 Kawasaki.

TPC Construction Pre Injection

Tom Palmer the reigning Pre-injection champ had a tough race on Saturday from the back of the grid, but managed to squeeze the win on his Palmer Plastering R1, but Paul Harlington regrouped on Sunday to pick up the 25 points with his F11100. Despite some very close attention from Mark Labudek, Kevin Davies on his NPMC / UK Aerial Media SV took a fine pair... And set a new class lap record on Saturday.

Dutch Ducati Dealer 3D Cup

This Donington meeting saw over 30 entrant's travel from Holland to compete in the 3D Cup. There was a host of exotic 848's... 996's... 198's as well and a raft of Panigales. Andre Niemantsverdriet set pole in Saturday's dry qualifying but unfortunately both finals were in the wet and Andre was not so happy as he managed just 10th and 7th positions. The experienced Harold Kock stormed through the field and on the last lap took over 3 seconds out of the fading race long leader Jan De Boer to steal his first ever 3D cup win. The taste of victory was obviously to his liking as he following it up with another on Sunday in a super race that saw Harold, along with both of his racing brothers Marcel and Johnny along with Chris Van Thiel fight it out for 8 laps before the red flag halted the race..... but Harold was once more at the front, making the dash for the ferry back home seem so much shorter I am sure..... and he got family bragging rights.

TSGP

Mark Reeves and Daniel Williams shared a win apiece in the Classic two stroke GP class that were having a run out with NG this weekend. There was some lovely machinery on the grid including Paul Allender's TZ750 and Stuart Jones's Spondon RG500.....although to be fair the wet conditions probably favoured the 250's

CSC Racing Sidecars

Ben Holland and Ashley Hawes wheeled out their Finning Cat backed LCR Suzuki in preparation for the upcoming British round and fired a warning shot to their rival by setting a new lap record in Sunday mornings sunny conditions....come the wet in the afternoon they still romped home at the front ahead of Simon Gilbert and Nathan Robinson. Top F2 pairing was Dean Nicholls and Ashley Moore on the newly liveried Certain Exhibitions 600 Lumley Kawasaki.

April UK Newcomers

All three newcomers race went to the formbook with Dave Mackay (KTM RC8)... Mark Reeves (RS250 Honda.... and Sean Montgomery (SV650) all winning and ending the day at the top of the Open... 500cc and Mini Twin points tables.

Donington Park Rounds 5 & 6

Qualifying

Qualifying started in dry conditions then turned wet and most riders pulled in and sat out the last few minutes. Christopher Martin on his Phil Harvey backed R S 250cc Honda followed on his form from Cadwell park and was fastest in a time of 1 minute 21.28 seconds and a speed of 86.67 mph. Defending Champion Daniel Jackson slid off his machine at McLeans in the closing stages as the rain came down but walked away unhurt and was second fastest. Darrell Higgins was third fastest with N G Cup competitor Simon Hunt in fourth, who also came off his machine at the top of Craner Curves.



Round 5

The race start was delayed due to hailstones but when the nine lap race started it was still in heavy rain and a very wet track which tested all the riders skill. Simon Hunt made a great start on his James & Spencer Racing T Z 250cc Yamaha and led off the line. Christopher Martin on his Phil Harvey backed T Z 250cc Yamaha soon took over the lead and was in a class of his own and with his smooth and stylish riding soon built up a good lead over the chasing pack. Ant Hodson on his FC L Racing backed T Z 250cc Yamaha worked his way up to second place ahead of Darrell Higgins on his Dennis Trollope backed T Z 250cc Yamaha who was in third place and ahead of defending National champion Daniel Jackson on his Team Sigie T Z Yamaha. These top four remained the same until the flag with Christopher Martin winning 25.05 seconds ahead of Ant Hodson in a time of 13 minutes 22.25 seconds and a speed of 79.03 mph. Christopher Martin also set the fastest lap of the race in a time of 1 minute 27.27 seconds and a speed of 80.72 mph. Ant Hodson said afterwards that he was lucky to finish because with a couple of laps to go he had a very big slide down Craner Curves and nearly went over the handlebars. Despite the very wet weather conditions there were still some great dices further down the leader board Lee Goddard on his L L G Racing R S 250cc Honda had a great dice with N G Cup championship leader Mark Reeves on his R S 250cc Honda for fifth and sixth places with Goddard getting fifth at the line and Reeves

had to settle for sixth but won the N G Cup class. Afterwards Reeves said he was very pleased with his result due to the difficult conditions. Simon Hunt finished tenth overall despite having to repair his machine after his qualifying tumble and second in the N G Cup class Hunt also picked up the Dunlop performance award for this race. Meanwhile Paul Metcalfe on his R S 250cc Honda and Rhys Hardisty on his T Z 250cc Yamaha had a great dice for 11th and 12th overall but third in the N G Cup class with Metcalfe getting the better of Hardisty at the line.

Round 6

Sunday's ten lap race was again held in very wet conditions and it was again won by Christopher Martin who led from start to finish. His race winning time was 14 minutes 25.85 seconds and a speed of 81.36 mph he again set the fastest lap of the race in a time of 1 minute 24.94 seconds and a speed of 82.94 mph. Christopher said afterwards that he felt comfortable throughout the race and the bike felt fine. He also won the Ken Walker 250cc trophy which was first won by Rob Orme back in 1988 and presented to Christopher by Brian Bennett. Christopher is currently second in the championship just one point behind championship leader Ant Hodson who finished runner up in Sunday's race and picked up the Dunlop performance award. Darrell Higgins again took the final step of the podium in third place but said he was lucky to finish because he had a very big slide as he went through the Starkey's Bridge section of the circuit and was nearly high sided off his machine just a couple of laps to go. lan Gardiner on his T Z 250cc Yamaha was up to fourth place and catching Higgins when he made an error and dropped to sixth place. The N G Cup class again went the way of Mark Reeves who won the class and was tenth overall in a time of 15 minutes 13.69 seconds and a speed of 77.10 mph. Reeves also set the fastest N G Cup lap in a time of 1 minute 29.14 seconds and a speed of 79.03 mph and leads the championship. Simon Hunt finished 11th overall and second in the cup class and wished to thank the fellow competitors who helped him out with parts after his qualifying crash. These included current National champion Daniel Jackson who lent him an exhaust pipe to enable him to compete over the weekend and Hunt is currently second in the N G Cup championship. Rhys Hardisty on his T Z 250cc Yamaha and Paul Metcalfe on his R S 250cc Honda had a race long dice with each other and changing places throughout the race for the final step of the podium in the N G Cup class. Rhys Hardisty got the better of Paul Metcalfe on the last lap and finished third in the N G Cup class and 12th overall with Paul Metcalfe in 13th.

Castle Combe – Saturday 8th June Championship Round 7

This Meeting

Round 7 of the $2\overline{0}13$ championship sees us almost at the halfway point of the year-long fight for honours and silverware. This meeting will be vital for those after one of the coveted class titles.

For sure the Wayside Garages 600 race will be one to savour with Chris Hawkes on his Suzuki taking on, Oliver Hill, and Peter Carr along with young Welsh hot-shot Dale Thomas and local Calne resident Scott Pitchers. Pitchers put on a stunning display last year and the 19 year old will be out to impress again this term on his new 675 Triumph Daytona.

Phil Bevan will be out to bag more points in the King of Combe but will face tough opposition in the shape of reigning Michelin Power Cup Champ James Cox..... Simon Knowlson....Chris Pope... Jason Oakes... and Paul Shook. We can never discount Tom Garness on his rapid BMW or Duncan Gibson with the Ducati Panigale so it will be a hard race to win.

With full grids in all the supporting classes this mid term showdown for points in one not to be missed.....

The Circuit

Castle Combe as we know is one of the longest established short circuits in the UK with meetings dating back to the 1950's. All the greats on two and four wheels have raced here, from John Surtees, through Mike Hailwood to Carl Fogarty. Combe is fast... very fast... flat, and known to be bumpy in places, so a well-set-up bike is essential. Suspension and traction are key to a fast lap.... and that allied to bravery. Quarry is probably the hardest to get right, and most definitely the easiest to get wrong. Also the fast run through Hammerdown to Tower Bends takes effort to get right so everyone will be out to learn this track as quickly as possible. On a map it looks straightforward but it is far from it.

The Fastest

Dan Cooper on his Centurion Honda Fireblade holds the fastest NG Road Racing lap here with a time of 1min 12.96sec...that equates to an average of 91.28mph. Keep an eye on the Open or Powerbike classes for anyone to challenge that speed.

The 250GP ACU National Championship

NG Road Racing are once more hosting the prestigious 250GP ACU National Championship, we along with the series sponsors, Dunlop and The ACU are providing an outlet for these Grand Prix derived pure-bred real racing machines. This is the only place that you will see these machines competing in a full National championship anywhere in the UK, action is always guaranteed. There is also the 250GP NG Cup for the up and coming non-national licence holders, who are always out to impress. 2011 Ant Hodson leads the current standings by just one point over Chris Martin, who has been unbeaten in his last four rides.

The Phoenix Motorcycles Open

This is the big one for the NG riders. It's open to all riders on all bikes, so it really is the best rider on the best bike that comes out on top. There is dedicated timed qualifying....longer races...and more laps on offer than any other class as well as three points scoring races over a weekend. That's why it's the premier club class with big end of season money from Phoenix Motorcycles of Trowbridge, all the top riders want to win. Josh Day leads the title chase on his WH Bond ZX10 Kawasaki with defending champion Phil Bevan is hunting him down after a steady start to the year....but gaining momentum.

Keep an eye on..... Scott Pitchers - SP Racing 675 Triumph - Wayside Garages 600cc Open

Scott loves this Castle Combe circuit, and was the outstanding star here last year.....Scott who is just 19 years old has switched from an R6 Yamaha to a 675 Triumph for 2013 as he is competing in the Triumph Triple Challenge at all the BSB rounds. He has already tasted the podium at National level...... today is a fun day without the pressures of the BSB paddock....a happy rider is always a fast rider!!!

Wayside Garages Performance of the Meeting

As with every meeting there is the Performance of the Meeting Award. Open to everyone, this rewards one rider per meeting for his or her efforts. It is not all about winning races (.... although that really helps!!!!), the judges take all classes and all riders into consideration. Last time out at Donington Park it went to Tom Cook on his TPC Construction R1 Yamaha

Bardahl Top-Oils Newcomers Performance Award (www.top-oils.co.uk)

This is a new award for 2013 from Bardahl Top-Oils and rewards a newcomer for his or her efforts on track. This can either be for a good weekend result, or a one off performance against more experienced opposition. Last time out at Donington Park it went to Mark Strudwick on his MTS Racing RS125 for mastering the really tricky conditions.


