How to find Canada Heights:

From M25 (north) Leave M25 at Junc 3, signposted Swanley (the SECOND slip road)

From M25 (south) Leave the M25 at Junc 3, signposted Swanley.

From M20 (Kent) Leave the M20 at Junction 1, signposted Swanley & M25 South.

From A20 (London) Leave the A20 on the slip road towards the M25.

From all the above: Leave the traffic-light roundabout on A20 towards Brands Hatch (NOT the M20 or you will have an 18 mile round trip to get back!).

Straight on at the Teardrop Centre roundabout, then next Left into Button Street, signpost "Swanley Village".

PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY down the narrow second half of this road - there are blind bends. Canada Heights is on the right, a mile from the A20 end of Button Street.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS (side line = different from 2005)

Numbers: Correct ACU colours this year! Front plates are:

WHITE numbers on GREEN background (White on Red is **EXPERTS:**

OK if you are a National Championship class rider).

BLACK numbers on YELLOW background CLUBMAN A and B: SPORTSMAN:

WHITE numbers on BLACK background.

Side plates for all classes are BLACK numbers on YELLOW background.

Tyres: For all classes, front tyres can be of any pattern; REAR TYRES MUST BE ENDURO (i.e. Maximum tread depth of 13mm) or TRIALS PATTERN.

Helmets: Read pages 63 to 65 of the 2006 ACU Handbook. We will retain nonacceptable helmets until the end of the meeting.

Time/Punch Cards: You will be issued with a coloured punch card, which must be attached to the LEFT side of your handlebars; and a time card that must be carried by the rider throughout the event, but not taped to helmet, tank or mudguard. The Time schedules (different for each class) will be shown at the start.

Signing On: 8:30am to 10:00am. Ensure you collect a Time Card and a Punch Card when you sign on, and you must show your 2006 ACU Licence, or else buy a 1-event licence for £15.00 - NO EXCEPTIONS THIS YEAR!

Scrutineering: 8:30am to 10:00am. Please get scrutineered and signed on as soon as possible. PUSH your bike to the Parc Fermé immediately after scrutineering. NO ENGINES TO BE RUN IN THE PARC FERMÉ. Protective clothing as ACU Enduro Regulations. Bikes do not need speedo or horn, but must have lights fitted and working.

Special Test(s): This will be clearly marked. On any lap DURING THE FIRST TWO SESSIONS you must stop and have your Special Test timed - standing start, STOP at the end. You have to decide when to stop for your Special Test(s) - you will not be called. EXPERTS WILL DO TWO TESTS, all other classes will do one.

Late Arrival Allowance (LAA): The finish time of each of each session is also the start time of your next session and is recorded on your time card. However, your first minute LATE at the end of each of the four sessions will not incur any penalty points. There is no allowance given if you mistakenly check in EARLY - 60 points for every minute early (apart from the end of the FINAL session when you may check in early without penalty). Sportsmen have to check in and out of their one-lap third session.

Disqualification: ACU Enduro Regulation 3.16 (2006 ACU Handbook, pages 130 & 131, and worth looking at!). To be especially enforced (and NO WARNING WILL BE GIVEN): -

Course cutting (any that do will never ride in a Sidcup enduro again);

Exceeding walking pace in Blue Tape Areas, which includes the refuelling area. Missing the Special Test(s);

Refuelling without stopping the engine;

Smoking in the refuelling area (THIS INCLUDES MECHANICS, FAMILY, ETC.) Excessively noisy machine (you may ride to the paddock, rectify and continue).

<u>Penalty Points</u>: 60 penalty points for each minute LATE (after LAA) or EARLY. NOTE: Time taken when you pass the yellow flags (20 metres before the time check). Points per lap NOT done = 2000.

<u>General</u>: PLEASE, PLEASE do not leave litter on Canada Heights. If you can't take it home with you, deposit it in the 50-gallon oil drums in the paddock.

You must hand in ALL time and punch cards, even if you retire. We like to know that you are not lost in the woods somewhere. The results sheet will include your score up to when you retired (not simply RET like some enduros!)

The refuelling area is for riders, bikes, petrol, tools and MECHANICS WHEN ATTENDING RIDERS. No children, chairs, hangers-on. If in doubt – KEEP OUT!

<u>FULL RESULTS</u> will be on the Club Website <u>www.sidcupmotorcycleclub.co.uk</u>, within 24 hours, and posted to you within 2 days.

Facilities: Mike Weaver catering and portaloos will all be at Canada Heights all day.

Special Note for Enduro newcomers – Please phone the Sec of Meeting before the day of the event if there is anything about riding this enduro that you are unclear about. It's too late to ask on the day – I'll be too busy before the start!
