Postcode for Sat Navs: BR8 8DZ (& keep going!) How to find Canada Heights: From M25 (Essex) Leave M25 at Junc 3, signposted Swanley (the SECOND slip road).

From M25 (Surrey) Leave the M25 at Junc 3, signposted Swanley.

From M20 (Kent) Leave the M20 at Junction 1, signposted Swanley & M25 South.

From A20 (London) Leave the A20 on the slip road towards the M25.

From all the above: Leave the traffic-light roundabout on A20 towards Brands Hatch (NOT the M20 or you will have an 18 mile round trip to get back!). Straight on at the Teardrop Centre roundabout, then next Left into Button Street, signpost "Swanley Village".

PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY down the narrow second half of this road - there are blind bends. Canada Heights is on the right, a mile from the A20 end of Button Street.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Numbers: ACU colours for Front and Side plates are:

CHAMPIONSHIP: WHITE numbers on RED background. WHITE numbers on GREEN background EXPERT: CLUBMAN: BLACK numbers on YELLOW background WHITE numbers on BLACK background. SPORTSMAN: WHITE numbers on BLUE background VETERANS:

Tyres: For all classes, front tyres can be of any pattern. REAR TYRES MUST BE ENDURO (i.e. Maximum tread depth of 13mm) or TRIALS PATTERN.

Helmets: Read pages 90 to 91 of the 2011 ACU Handbook. The scrutineer will retain non-acceptable helmets until the end of the meeting.

Timecards and Wristbands: You will be issued with a time card that must be carried by the rider throughout the event, but not taped to helmet, tank or mudguard. If you haven't bought (or brought) a SE Enduro Combine transponder wristband, you must hire one at signing-on. It must be worn on your RIGHT wrist throughout the event. The time schedules (different for each class) will be shown at the start.

You will also be given one 'Maxxis' wristband, which when worn by your mechanic, will be the only way he/she will get into the refuelling area.

Signing On: 8:30am to 10:00am. Ensure you collect a transponder wristband and a timecard, and you must show your 2011 ACU Licence, or else buy a 1event licence for £10.00 - NO EXCEPTIONS THIS YEAR!

Riders' Briefing: This will be at the signing-on container at 10:10am.

Scrutineering: 8:30am to 10:00am. Please get scrutineered and signed on as soon as possible. PUSH your bike to the Parc Fermé immediately after scrutineering. NO ENGINES TO BE RUN IN THE PARC FERMÉ. Protective clothing as ACU Enduro Regulations. Bikes do not need speedo or horn, but must have fitted front & back lights.

Special Tests: This will be timed and will be part of the course. All riders will have two tests. All riders must stop at the Test Start on laps ONE and TWO. The test will be somewhere round the course (probably in the back field) and you are advised to arrive early to walk the test.

Free camping from Saturday on Canada Heights - no need to book!

<u>Disqualification</u>: ACU Enduro Regulation 3.18 (2011 ACU Handbook, page 166, and worth looking at!). To be especially enforced (and NO WARNING WILL BE GIVEN):

Course cutting (any that do will never ride in a Sidcup enduro again);

Exceeding walking pace in Blue Tape Areas, which includes the refuelling area Missing the Special Test(s);

Refuelling without stopping the engine;

Smoking in the refuelling area (THIS INCLUDES YOUR MECHANIC)
Excessively noisy machine (you may ride to the paddock, rectify and continue).

<u>Penalty Points</u>: 20 marks penalty if you fail to cross a line 20 metres past the start one minute after your start time <u>under engine power</u>.

60 penalty points for each minute LATE or EARLY, except your LAST lap, when you may finish EARLY without penalty.

NOTE: Time taken when you pass the yellow flags (20 metres before the time check). Points per lap NOT done = 2000.

<u>General</u>: PLEASE, PLEASE do not leave litter on Canada Heights. If you can't take it home with you, deposit it in the 50-gallon oil drums in the paddock.

You must hand in your time card and (hired) wristband, even if you retire. We like to know that you are not lost in the woods somewhere. The results sheet will include your score up to when you retired (not simply RET like some enduros!).

Penalty for a hired wristband not handed in is loss of the £10 deposit.

The refuelling area is for riders, bikes, petrol, tools and MECHANICS with pass (in the form of a 'Maxxis' wristband). No children, chairs, hangers-on.

<u>FULL RESULTS</u> will be on the Club Website www.sidcupmotorcycleclub.co.uk, within 24 hours, and posted to those who sent a results s.a.e. within 2 days.

Facilities: a mobile catering unit and portaloos will all be at Canada Heights all day.

Special Note for Enduro newcomers – Please phone the Sec of Meeting before the day of the event if there is anything about riding this enduro that you are unclear about. It's too late to ask on the day – I'll be too busy before the start!

RIDERS:

If your details are incorrect in this programme, or you wish to change bike or class, please phone the Secretary of Meeting BEFORE the day.

No changes of CLASS will be accepted on the day of the event.


