How to find Canada Heights: Postcode for Sat Navs: BR8 8DZ (& keep going!)
From M25 (Essex) Leave M25 at Junc 3, signposted Swanley (the SECOND slip road).

From M25 (Surrey) Leave the M25 at Junc 3, signposted Swanley.

From M20 (Kent) Leave the M20 at Junction 1, signposted Swanley & M25 South.

From A20 (London) Leave the A20 on the slip road towards the M25.

From all the above: Leave the traffic-light roundabout on A20 towards Brands Hatch
(NOT the M20 or you will have an 18 mile round trip to get back!).

Straight on at the Teardrop Centre roundabout, then next Left into Button Street, signpost
"Swanley Village".

PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY down the narrow second half of this road - there are blind
bends. Canada Heights is on the right, a mile from the A20 end of Button Street.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Tyres: For all classes, front tyres can be of any pattern. **REAR TYRES MUST BE FIM ENDURO pattern or TRIALS PATTERN.**

Helmets: Read pages 88 to 89 of the 2019 ACU Handbook. The scrutineer will retain non-acceptable helmets until the end of the meeting.

Numbers: We will be giving all riders stick-on numbers on the correct coloured backgrounds for their class, which **MUST** be affixed to your bike. There is therefore no need for any riders to put numbers on before the day.

ACU colours for Front and Side plates are:

CHAMPIONSHIP:	WHITE numbers on RED background
EXPERT:	WHITE numbers on GREEN background
CLUBMAN and EVO	BLACK numbers on YELLOW background
SPORTSMAN:	WHITE numbers on BLACK background
VETERANS:	WHITE numbers on BLUE background

Time Schedules: These are different for each class and we will endeavour to show lap times for all riders at the start to save you working them out!

Signing On: 8:30am to 10:00am. You **must show your 2019 ACU Licence**, unless you automatically bought and paid for a 1-event licence on-line – if so, there's no paperwork to do at the event.

The ACU Licence (or proof of identity) of all Sidcup members will be kept until all clearing up is done at the end of the meeting.

You will be LOANED a wristband transponder (to be worn on your RIGHT wrist during the event).

You will also be given one coloured wristband, which when worn by your mechanic, will be the only way he/she will get into the refuelling area.

Important Note: If you have paid for a 1-event licence on-line, or you buy one on the day, you must show some form of ID with your photograph – a driving licence will do. This is to check that the person signing on is the same individual who entered the event.

Riders' Briefing: This will be at the signing-on building at 10:10am.

Scrutineering: 8:30am to 10:00am. Please get scrutineered and signed on as soon as possible. PUSH your bike to the Parc Fermé (the motocross start hill) immediately after scrutineering. NO ENGINES TO BE RUN IN THE PARC FERMÉ until the official 'warming-up' period. Protective clothing as ACU Enduro Regulations. Bikes do not need speedo or horn.

Free camping: From Saturday (and stay till Monday if you like) on Canada Heights – no need to book!

Facilities: Mobile catering and portaloos will all be at Canada Heights all day.

Special Tests: This will be timed and may or may not be part of the course. All riders will have two tests. Stop at the Test Start on early laps before your time schedule tightens. You will be told at the riders briefing if you can ride your second test immediately after your first. **You should arrive early to walk the test.**

Afterwards: All Sidcup members must help with a bit of clearing up after the enduro – and help from non-Sidcup members will be appreciated as well!

Disqualification: ACU Enduro Regulation Appendix B (2019 ACU Handbook, page 186, and worth looking at!). To be especially enforced (and NO WARNING WILL BE GIVEN):

- Course cutting (any that do will never ride in a Sidcup enduro again);
- Exceeding walking pace in Blue Tape Areas, including the refuelling area.
- Missing the Special Test(s);
- Refuelling without stopping the engine;
- Smoking in the refuelling area (MECHANIC smoking = his RIDER is excluded)
- Excessively noisy machine (you may rectify and continue).

Penalty Points (i.e. seconds): 20 marks penalty if you fail to cross a line 20 metres past the start one minute after your start time **under engine power**. 60 penalty points for each minute LATE or EARLY, except your LAST lap, when you may finish **EARLY** without penalty. [At ALL ACU enduros you may come in early on the last lap]

NOTE: Do not stop between the yellow flags (20 metres before the time check) and the time check. If you do, the time you passed the yellow flags will be your clock-in time.

General: PLEASE, PLEASE do not leave litter on Canada Heights. We have all the track to clear up after the event, so we don't want to have to clear up your rubbish as well!

The refuelling area is for riders, bikes, petrol, tools and **MECHANICS with pass (in the form of a wristband)**. No children, chairs, hangers-on – no exceptions!

RESULTS: will be on www.sidcupmotorcycleclub.co.uk, within 24 hours.

Special Note for Enduro newcomers – An information sheet is on the Sidcup website. If you have any further questions or you are unclear about anything, please phone or email the Sec of Meeting before the day of the event. It's too late to ask on the day – I'll be too busy before the start!
