One-Event Licences and Sidcup 'Day' members: If you have no 2011 ACU Competition Licence you must complete an ACU One-Event Licences form at signing-on. Please bring £10 unless you have paid for it with your entry. Sidcup 'Day' Membership is £5 - please bring this when you sign on if you have not paid for it with your entry.

Tyres: Motocross, Enduro or Trials tyres are acceptable for all machines.

Numbers: Any CONSTRASTING colours of numbers and background will be accepted (i.e. NOT blue numbers on black or white numbers on vellow)

Helmets: Read pages 90 to 91 of the 2011 ACU Handbook. We will retain nonacceptable helmets until the end of the meeting.

Mechanics wristbands: You will be given a coloured wristband for your mechanic. One mechanic per rider and only those people will be allowed in the refuelling area.

Riders' Briefing: This will be on the start line 15 minutes before each event. Engine warm up from the end of briefing to five minutes before the start, then all engines must be stopped. When the flag drops FOR YOUR CLASS, you start your engine and GO!

Scrutineering: For Event One: 8:00am to 9:30am. For Event Two: 10:30am to 12 noon. PUSH your bike to the Parc Fermé at least 20 minutes before the start. NO ENGINES TO BE RUN IN THE PARC FERMÉ. Protective clothing as ACU Enduro or Motocross Regulations. No machines require speedo, horn or lights. these will not be tested

Disqualification: ACU H&H/Cross Country Regulation 3.16 (2011 ACU Handbook, page 181, and worth looking at!). To be especially enforced (and NO WARNING WILL BE GIVEN):

Course cutting (any that do will never ride in a Sidcup event again);

Exceeding walking pace in Blue Tape Areas: this includes the refuelling area.

Refuelling without stopping the engine:


