PERSONALITY PAGE.
PAUL ALLEN (NO. 100)

One of Paul's Christmas Presents in 1972 was a Honda 50 with the frame cut down and 12" rims fitted in place of the 17" which were on it.

Paul rode this for a few months until he saw the BBC film of the Corsham Club on t.v. early in 1973. This was the turning point. Paul's father, who you all know as Don, located the venue of the next Meeting which happened to be Bradenstoke, and along they went. They both enjoyed the day so much they completed the Membership Form on the spot, and Paul was given his treasured Number '100.'

After a lot of searching Don located a Suzuki TS 90, and with some modification work, Paul rode his first Meeting at Calne Carnival in June, 1973, as an Intermediate. At this time there were still some BSA Bantams and Triumph Tiger Cubs being ridden.

The seasons of 1974 and 1975 passed with Paul usually somewhere in the middle of the pack. When 1976 came Paul had to move up to the Seniors, and this meant a change of machinery. A Kawasaki 125 was used with reasonable success, and it was during 1976 that Paul won his first Trophy, an 8th place at the Two Day Meeting at Whitham Friary.

At the end of the 1976 season it was decided a new bike was necessary and Paul started 1977 with the Honda 125. He had a reasonably successful season winning several Trophies but decided he would not ride in the B.M.S.A. rounds as this meant too much travelling.

At the start of 1978 it was agreed between Paul and Don that the Honda would be retained, unless Honda brought out a new model.

As most of you know this has not been without its problems. None more so than at two of the four B.S.M.A. qualifying rounds, when mechanical problems sidelined Paul, and he finished with enough points to ride in the B.S.M.A. Experts Support Championship. Lucky for Don, who had got most of the preparation work right, (except for the exhaust falling off in one race), Paul won the 1978 B.S.M.A. Experts Support Championship.

A final decision on 1979 depends on the machine Honda intend to bring out, and if this comes in time for the start of the season.

Paul is now working as an apprentice panel-beater in a Bristol Garage. His hobbies other than scrambling are badminton, swimming and vintage cars.

Paul would like to thank everyone for the help and friendship they have given him over the years.
