

KEN REDFERN

The primary object of this meeting today is to honour the memory of KEN REDFERN, a North East Motor Cycle Racing Club Member who rose from the ranks of ordinary Clubman to become one of the established stars in National and International Road Racing before he met his death in a road accident on Saturday, 30th June, 1973.

Ken's rise to fame was achieved in an incredibly short space of time, with his first taste of real success coming in 1969 when he finished second to Giacomo Agostini in Cadwell and again at Mallory, beating the best in the land to do so.

These two achievements, the first of many to follow, brought him into sharp focus as a potential International Star of the future if ever there was one, and it was not long after this that the promise he had evinced was fully realised with a series of wins and record laps second to none at all major short circuits throughout the country.

Abroad, he competed successfully in Sweden, France and British Guiana, especially Guiana where by his personal charm, politeness and artistry made him a celebrity overnight to a degree seldom achieved by anyone in the world of sport.

In conclusion I would like to say that in my association with motor sport in general, stretching back over half a century, I have seldom met anyone more fitted to the title of 'Gentleman' than Ken Redfern, and for those who knew him his passing has left a void which will never be filled.

TRIBUTE TO MAC HOBSON

It still seems hard to believe that Mac Hobson, the Fastest Geordie on Three Wheels, is no longer with us.

When he and passenger Kenny Birch were killed in last year's Sidecar TT in the Isle of Man, the sport lost two of its greatest characters, and the North-East Motor Cycle Racing Club one of its best-liked sons.

Although Mac never won a World Championship, it was never for want of trying. He put everything into the sport during a long and chequered career that started in the 1950's on a solo BSA Gold Star, and was a founder member of the Club.

For me, Croft holds special memories of Mac. I remember him on the bright yellow Cowie BSA in the late 1960's, when even then he was the fastest man on the circuit. I remember him standing in pouring rain, selling programmes here for a North-East Club meeting. I remember the moments of his greatest triumphs in the Isle of Man on the Ham-Yam outfits. I also remember the quiet and not-so-quiet evenings with Mac, Cathy and the children at their Gosforth home, and I still can't believe that those happy days are now gone for ever. But What I and many others will remember mostly about Mac was his quiet modesty. He never had a high opinion of himself, and the stardom he worked so hard to achieve never affected his friendly, quiet-spoken manner.

When the magnificent Mac Hobson Trophy is presented today, I would like the fans gathered here to spare a few quiet moments to think of the many times Mac rode at this circuit, and the pleasure and pride he gave to so many.

In a way, he is still with us all: in our hearts.




